Nella mattinata di sabato, 23 corrente, la Commissione ha fatto visita al Prefetto e si è poi recata all'Ufficio Provinciale Elettorale ove ha avuto agio di constatare l'accurata preparazione delle elezioni che hanno avuto luogo ieri in 28 Comuni della Provincia, ripartiti in N.88 Sezioni elettorali, con un totale di N.67.739 elettori iscritti.

Sono stati ieri visitati i Comuni di Albano Laziale e Velletri.

ALBANO LAZIALE (Consiglieri da eleggere N.30) - Popolazione (censimento 1936) N.11469 ab. - Elettori iscritti: uomini n.3385, donne n.3148 = totale n.6533 - Esclusi per delitti o cariche fasciste = nessuno.

Sezioni N.9, situate le prime quattro nel fabbricato delle Scuole Elementari di Via Propaganda, civico n.10; la 5a e la 6a rispettivamente nella nuova sede municipale ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ di Via Plebiscito n.64 e nella vecchia sede municipale (ex Palazzo Savelli) nell'aula d'udienza della R.Pretura; la 7a nello stesso Palazzo Savelli, al piano I; infine l'8a e la 9a nella campagna, rispettivamente nella tenuta "La Vittoria" e borgata "Cecchina". Tutte in locali idonei, ampi e bene illuminati, con ingresso unico per uomini e donne. I seggi completi di arredamento, secondo le disposizioni di legge.

A presiedere le nove Sezioni sono stati chiamati Magistrati e Funzionari dell'ordine giudiziario.

La scelta degli scrutatori è stata fatta ripartendo equamente in ciascuna Sezione i rappresentanti dei vari partiti.

Sono state presentate ed approvate tre liste di candidati :

Il servizio d'ordine è diretto da un Commissario Capo di P.S. e da un Ufficiale dei CC.RR. con numerosi agenti e carabinieri.

Fuori delle Sezioni elettorali attendono numerosi elettori, in file distinte di uomini e donne.

Il Sindaco ed il Funzionario di P.S. ci hanno assicurato che i comizi, nei giorni che hanno preceduto la manifestazione elettorale, si sono regolarmente svolti, senza incidenti, con libertà di parola per tutti e rispetto tra i singoli partiti. Non risulta che siano stati fatti tentativi di corruzione, minacce o manovre ostruzionistiche a danno di elettori.

La Commissione ha solo raccolto lagnanze di un numeroso gruppo di cittadini, i quali hanno lamentato la mancata loro iscrizione nella lista elettorale. Molti hanno asserito di risiedere fuori del Comune per sfollamento e di non aver, però, tutelato, nei termini di legge, il proprio diritto.

Il Sindaco ed il Segretario comunale ci hanno, in proposito, confermato la veridicità delle lagnanze, asserendo, però, trattarsi di cittadini di Albano sfollati in altre città, non iscritti perché, distrutti completamente dai bombardamenti i registri di Stato Civile e l'anagrafe, il Comune mancava dei necessari elementi per una completa formazione degli elenchi e, successivamente, della lista. Né gli interessati avevano chiesto, in tempo utile, la iscrizione, nonostante tre avvisi a stampa al riguardo affissi nel territorio del Comune, ma eransi presentati a richiedere tale diritto solo qualche giorno prima della data stabilita per la votazione. A tale tardiva iscrizione si era anche giustamente opposto il Capo dell'Ufficio elettorale provinciale presso la Prefettura di Roma.

Alla Commissione si è anche presentato un locale rappresentante del Partito Democratico Cristiano, asserendo che in una Sezione quattro cittadini avevano votato al posto di altrettanti nominativi notoriamente deceduti e che, in proposito, avrebbe presentato regolare ricorso.

Sindaco e Segretario comunale ci hanno, invece, esibito numerosissimi certificati elettorali non consegnati dagli agenti distributori perché in-

tentati a nominativi inclusi nella lista elettorale, per quanto probabilmente deceduti, a seguito dei bombardamenti subiti dalla città, e per i quali nessun atto ufficiale di morte era stato dal Comune raccolto per la mancata denuncia da parte dei familiari.

SUBJECT: Observation of Local Elections held on 24 March 1946 at Albano and Velletri (Province of Rome).

TO: The Director of Local Government Sub Commission.

1. Accompanied by Dott. Giulio Cesare Rizza, Inspector-General of the Ministry of the Interior I paid a visit to the Prefect of Rome the day before the elections. Conversations were held with him, with Dott. Giovenco, Head of the Provincial Electoral Service and the Chief of the Cabinet of the Prefect.

2. The Prefect reviewed the situation of the Province and concluded that no trouble was anticipated. He stated also that the electoral certificates and other voting materials had been delivered to the Communes and that all precautionary measures had been taken to maintain order.

3. Dott. Giovenco mentioned to us that he had been to Albano a few days before to investigate about complaints made by people who were left out of the electoral lists. He said that the number of those amounted to 400. The result of his enquiry was that as the Central Registry of Albano was destroyed through enemy action and many people born and residing at Albano during the war had left without sending any notification as to their present address, it was almost impossible for the Sindaco to prepare a complete list.

4. The Sindaco had nevertheless notified the population to check with the list which was at the Municipio and apply for the inclusion of their names if they were omitted. Dott. Rizza had an opportunity to make an enquiry himself on the day of the elections and found that the statement made by Dott. Giovenco was correct.

5. On the day of elections, 24 March, accompanied by Dott. Giulio Cesare Rizza, Inspector-General of the Ministry of the Interior, I visited Albano and Velletri.

6. At Albano we met the Sindaco, the Secretary of the Commune, the Commissario of Public Safety and the Tenente of the Carabinieri. At the Municipio we saw some 200 people complaining that they had been left out of the electoral lists. Few of them expressed the desire to see Dott. Rizza. He spoke to them and they admitted that they had complained to the Sindaco only two days before the elections. He then replied that that was too late and consequently neither the Sindaco nor any other authority could add any names after the list had been finally approved by the electoral Commission.

7. There were 9 polling sections. They were located as follows; four at the elementary school; one at the municipio; two at Palazzo Savelli; two at Cecchina. Each section was presided by a magistrate or a judicial official. The "scrutatori" were equally divided among parties. Two cabins had been placed in each section.

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8. Three lists were presented as follows : Christian Democrats and Republicans with the symbol of the cross on a shield and the ivy leaf ; Socialists with the symbol of the hammer/sickle and the star on the book.

People were calmly waiting outside the polling stations their turn to vote. No disturbances took place.

24 seats won by the Christian Democrats and Republicans ;
6 seats won by the Communists.

9. VELLETRI

Velletri is the most populated town of the so called "Castelli Romani." It has been badly damaged during the war.

Here the system of proportional representation applies.

Ten persons have been excluded for fascist crimes from the electoral list by the Provincial Epuration Committee.

10. At Velletri we met the Commissario Prefettizio, the Secretary of the Comune, the Vice Questore and the Captain of the Carabinieri. They said that each party was able to hold its pre-electoral meetings and that no complaints were received about the compilation of the electoral lists. No trouble was anticipated.

There were 24 polling stations, of which 12 in town and 12 in the country.

11. All polling stations were located in school buildings.

12. The Presidents of 21 polling stations were either magistrate or judicial officials. Two polling stations were presided by representatives of the Ministry of Public Instruction and one by a lawyer.

The "scrutatori" were equally divided among the parties.

Two cabins were placed in each polling station.

13. Six lists were presented as follows:

Christian Democrats with the symbol of the cross on the shield (they presented 40 candidates);

Communists with the symbol of the Sickle-Hammer and the star (they presented 40 candidates);

Republicans with the symbol of the spade surmounted by ivy (they presented 40 candidates);

Socialists with the symbol of Sickle-Hammer and the book (they presented 16 candidates);

Democratic Labourists with the symbol of three entwined stalks of wheat; (they presented 40 candidates.)

Actionists with the symbol of the gear (they presented 40 candidates).

SUBJECT: Communal Elections - 24 March 1946

TO : Civil Affairs Section, Allied Commission, A.P.O. 394

1. Elections were held in 350 communes throughout the nine provinces of Lombard Region including the Provincial capitals Cremona and Bergamo. A copy of signal No. 2794 is attached hereto.
2. The percentage of voters is calculated to be even higher than that of last week as 85 to 90% of the eligible voters went to the polls.
3. Public order was maintained by CCRB, Public Safety Agents, Finance Guards and Forest Guards and there were no incidents anywhere, as everything proceeded in a most orderly manner.

On Monday a disturbance occurred at the small industrial town of Palazzolo sull'Oglio (Brescia Province). The Communal Secretary was on the point of leaving with the Ballot Papers, unescorted, to deposit them at the Prefecture, Brescia, when he was attacked by what are believed to be Communists, who took away the papers and burned them. Two arrests have been made and others are expected. As a result the election will be repeated on 31st March.

4. In other four of Brescia Province the elections were postponed owing to technical errors in procedure.

5. There is evidence of a growing tension between the parties of the left and the Demo-Christians but police arrangements with troops in reserve should be sufficient to cope with any disturbances which might occur.

6. At the moment in the provinces of Milan, Varese, Mantova, Cremona and Pavia, the Social-Communists are leading, while the Demo-Christians are ahead in Bergamo and Brescia provinces. In Bergamo itself the Demo-Christians obtained more votes than all the other parties put together. They also had the majority in the industrial towns of Iodi, Monte S. Pietro, (where one of the Caproni works is located), Rho and Inverigo. The result in this last town was a surprise.

SUBJECT: Incident at Palazzolo sull'Oglio, 25/3/1946

TO : Major J. B. FLEETWOOD, PSLO

1. The voting at Palazzolo sull'Oglio, Provincia di Brescia, was duly completed without incident on Sunday 24 March.
2. However at about 17,00 hours on Monday 25 March 46, the President of the Consiglio Elettorale Comunale was taking the "ballot sheets" and summary of the election to the Municipio when he was set upon, and the papers taken away from him by alleged communists, who then entered the Municipio, collected the documents from the other sections and burned all the papers in the courtyard. There was no Police escort as it was thought that any danger of an incident had passed on the Sunday.
3. The only fire damage was to the papers, none to the building or its contents.
4. The ballot had resulted in a definite Christian Democrat majority and the presumed reasons are either spite or the Communists' desire for a new ballot.
5. Two Communists have already been arrested and investigations continue. It was a well organized plot and several persons are thought to be involved. The two a/m prisoners will be brought to trial immediately.
6. New elections are due to take place next Sunday 31 March.

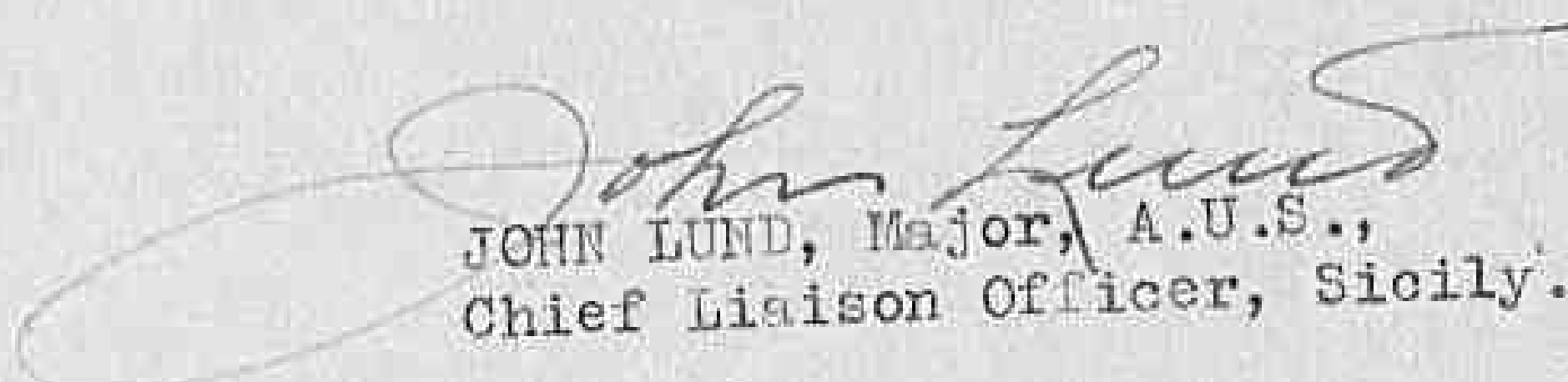

GALTANISSETTA, 22. Ieri e oggi si è svolto presso questo Tribunale per direttissima il processo contro i ventinove individui arrestati mentre uscivano dall'undicesima sezione elettorale di Riesi, imputati di devastazione della sezione stessa. Il P. M. dottor Matina ha richiesto il massimo della pena per tutti gli imputati.

La difesa rappresentata dagli avv. Emanuele Russo, Casarò, Angella, Ajala, Francesco Cali, Manuso, Misurata e Tricoma della Floresta ha chiesto l'assoluzione di tutti gli imputati. Tale assunto si basava sulle dichiarazioni di tutti i testi, fra cui il Presidente della sezione e degli scrutinatori, e degli stessi verbalizzanti che i devastatori erano muniti di bastoni, mentre nessun bastone fu sequestrato, né trovato nell'aula delle votazioni, né nelle vicinanze della sezione stessa; anzi fatto che si era proceduto a detti arresti solo dopo circa un quarto d'ora dall'avvenuta devastazione, mentre i devastatori, come risulta dalle dichiarazioni dei testi, avrebbero compiuto fulmineamente le loro azioni e si sarebbero subito allontanati; e infine sulla considerazione che, secondo le dichiarazioni degli stessi verbalizzanti, detti individui non sarebbero stati trovati nei locali della sezione ma nelle vicinanze. Subordinatamente è stata sostenuta

dagli avvocati l'applicazione di alcune attenuanti. È stata così sostenuta l'attenuante di avere agito per motivi di particolare valore sociale, per atti ingiusti altrui e per provocatione.

La reazione — secondo la difesa — sarebbe stata motivata da un particolare valore sociale, mentre il fare svolgere le elezioni, nonostante le riscontrate inesattezze nelle liste e l'ostruzionismo socialista, costituirebbero il fatto ingiusto e provocatorio.

La difesa ha infine fatto appello alle attenuanti di aver agito per agitazione della folla in tumulto.

Il Tribunale composto dal dott. Borsari che presiede, e dai giudici dott. Campo e dott. Cannata, ha creduto di risolvere undici degli imputati per insufficienza di prove e di condannare i rimanenti con pene variabili dagli anni due e mesi quattro di reclusione e novemila lire di multa ad anni quattro di reclusione e quattordicimila lire di multa.

Le elezioni amministrative nel Comune di Butera che avrebbero dovuto avere luogo domenica prossima 24, per lo stato di eccitazione in seguito al perturbamento all'ordine pubblico verificatosi domenica scorsa nella stessa Butera, sono state rinviate a data da destinarsi. TRANSLATION from "GIORNALE DI SICILIA" dated 23rd. March 1946.

THE FINAL RESULT OF THE TRIAL ON ACCOUNT OF THE INCIDENTS IN
THE COMUNE OF RIESI

EIGHTEEN OF THE PERSONS ACCUSED CONDEMNED TO PENALTIES VARIATING FROM FOUR YEARS TO TWO YEARS AND FOUR MONTHS OF IMPRISONMENT. ELEVEN PERSONS ABSOLVED DUE TO INSUFFICIENCY OF PROOF AGAINST THEM.

(Galtanissetta 22nd.) A trial was held yesterday and today in this tribunal - trying such case as a short cause - against the ~~thirty-nine~~ individuals arrested while they were leaving, after the eleventh electoral section of Rieti had taken place, on account of devastating such section. The Public Prosecutor, Dr. Mattina, requested a maximum penalty against the defendants. The defending body, represented by lawyers: Emanuele Russo, Cassaro, Augilella, Ajala, Francesco Cali, Mancuso, Mistretta and Trigona della Floresta, requested the absolution of all the persons accused. This was based on the witnesses statements, among them that from the President of the Section, that of the scrutinizers and that of the accusators, according to which the devastators were armed with cudgels, while no cudgel was seized, neither found in the voting room, nor in the vicinity of the same section; basing it also on the fact that arrests were made only a quarter of an hour after the devastation took place, while the devastators as it results from the witnesses statements, should have made their actions suddenly, leaving the place at once, and at last, in consideration that according to the statements of the accusators too, said persons should not had been found in the section, but in the vicinity.

On the other hand the defenders requested the application of some mitigatory circumstances, such as the accused acted for some particular social movings against some unjust acts of others, and provocation. The reaction, in the defenders opinion, was caused by a particular social value, while development of the elections, notwithstanding the inexactness verified in the lists, and social-communist obstructionism, would constitute the unjust and provoking act.

The defenders appealed to the mitigatory circumstances that they had acted under suggestion of the riot crowd.

The tribunal which was composed by Dr. Boscarini as President, and Dr. Campo and Dr. Cannata as judges, has absolved eleven of the defendants due to lack of proof, and sentenced the others with punishment going from two years and four months, imprisonment, and nine thousand lire of fine, to four years imprisonment and fourteen thousand lire fine.

The administrative elections in the Comune of Butera, which would have taken place next Sunday 24th., due to the state of excitation following the riots happened in Butera last Sunday, ~~are~~ have been disposed for a date to be fixed.

2. While there were the usual crowds of people standing about in these places, no public meetings were held and there was no particular excitement. No disorder occurred, although something of that nature was anticipated in Bologna itself.

Voters began to queue up at the polling stations at an early hour and at many places there were queues for the greater part of the day. From information received the procedure inside the stations was carried out in a proper manner and with complete secrecy. The arrangements appear to have been efficient.

A certain amount of electioneering was taking place but not in the vicinity of the polling stations; one report was received of Communist enthusiasts telling women on the way to the poll to vote for their party, but there was no threat or intimidation. No evidence of bribery.

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Some transport was obviously being used, trucks with red flags and emblems, or with cards of the Socialist Party. The Christian Democratic Party members are reported to have used private cars without party markings. The use of such transport is not considered to be excessive.

Polling was quite heavy, out of 227,000 electors in Bologna, 133,000 registered their votes. The attitude of all seemed to be that it was a duty to be performed.

SUBJECT: Observation of Administrative Elections
in Venezia Province on 24 March 1946.

1. Accompanied by Dr. Gaetano MASTROBUONO, Inspector-General of the Ministry of the Interior I observed the administrative elections that took place in the Communes of Venice and Chioggia in the Province of Venezia. The day before the elections we visited the Prefettura and Municipio of Venice and discussed the General situation with the Prefect, the Questore, Captain of the Carabinieri, the Head of the Electoral Service of the Province, the Vice-Sindaco, Segretario Comunale and the Head of the Communal Electoral Service. The Prefect said that he expected no difficulty in the Commune of Venice, although the 245 polling places were not guarded by the police as well as he would want it. Fortunately many polling stations were grouped together in the same building, so that the guarding part was therefore less complicated. The Prefect said that, as some trouble was expected at Chioggia, a small Commune south of Venice where there were many unemployed, he had arranged to send as reinforcements some army and navy personnel to act as police guards.

2. The Prefect and Questore said that they had uncovered no threats or bribery to influence voters.

3. The Vice-Sindaco at the Municipio pointed out that polling meetings held up till now had been calm. All the electoral material had been distributed.

5. On Sunday 24 March, the day of the election, the Inspector-General Mastrobuono and I toured the town, by means of a motoscafo put at our disposal by the Prefect. There was no display of burning of flags on the various boats of all descriptions that passed along the canals and the only party symbols which we observed in profusion stencilled along the walls of the Grand Canal were those of the Communist party. I observed one large boat with Communist flags which was carrying some potential voters to the polls. This was not usual ; the overwhelming majority came by their own means of transport and lined up in orderly fashion outside the polling stations. Everything was orderly and dignified. The general atmosphere could be typified by the enquiry made of me as I was walking on the bridge over a small canal, on each side of which was a polling station. A civilian, a young American, stopped me and pointing to

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6. Most of the polling stations had 4 voting booths each so that voting proceeded at a rapid pace. Representatives of the parties presenting lists were present in the polling stations pursuant to provisions of the electoral law which permits such representation in towns using the proportional representation system. Many of the representatives wore some symbol indicating the party affiliation.

7. The polling stations were all open, ready for business, at 8.00 a.m., preliminary operations having begun at 6.00 a.m. There was one exception: we found out that at Section No. 35 where one of the scrutineers failed to turn up the President of the Section designated an elector to substitute the absentee and polling in that section began at 9.30 a.m. In the poorer quarters of the Comune from 50 to 60% of the voters had cast their ballots by noon. Then we returned at 6.00 p.m. after a short visit to Chioggia, we observed that voting was still continuous but light. In some sections up to 90% of the electors had cast their ballot. All the Presidents of the polling stations and other people stated that very little difficulty was experienced by the voters in understanding the ballot. The counting of the votes did not begin until Monday, 25 March, the ballot boxes having been sealed and placed under guard during the night in each polling section. The Inspector-General Mastrobene asked the Prefect whether it was not advisable to increase the guards. In one school ~~there~~ 6 Sections but only 4 guards. However no disorder or incident was reported or any breaking in of the polling places. At this moment the results available in 246 sections out of 248 are as follows:

8. Chioggia Inspector-General Mastrobene and I paid a quick visit to the Comune of Chioggia south of Venice. This town which in 1936 had a population of 40,000 is principally a fishing village, but it is also important as an agricultural centre. There is great unemployment in the town. It was expected that the Communists would prevail. The trouble that was anticipated never took place and all was quiet and orderly. The captain of the Carabinieri to whom we spoke said that, so far as he knew, no money had been paid, nor other illegal means of influencing voting had been indulged in.

9. The proportional representation system was used in the town since it had over 30,000 people. Seven party lists were presented on the ballot: - Demo-Christian; Communist; Socialist; Action; Liberal; Veterans; Independent. The results in the town confirm what had been anticipated: -

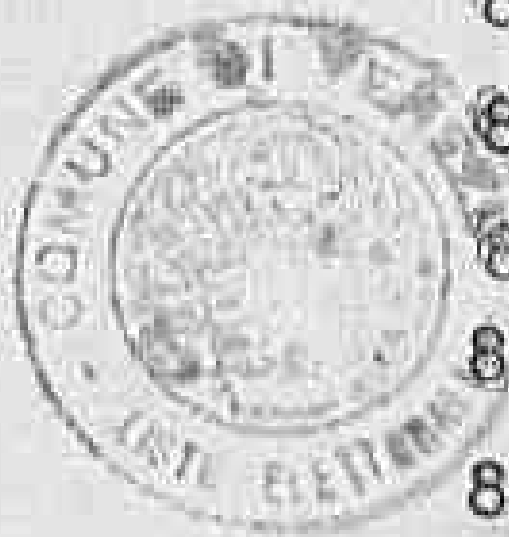

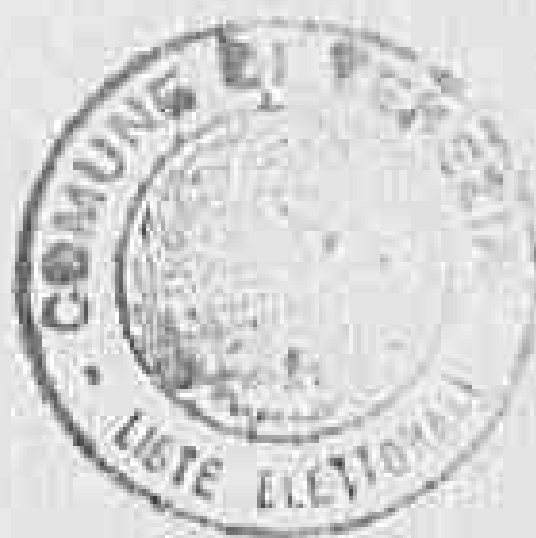

SUBJECT: Italian Municipal Elections 24 Mar 46 - PIEMONTE.

TO: Chief Commissioner, Allied Commission, A.P.O. 394.

1. I attach hereto a tabulated report of observations made by Liaison Officers of Piemonte in connection with the Municipal Elections held yesterday.
2. All officers of this Liaison Group were occupied on observation duties throughout the day.
3. All reports indicate that the elections were carried out in a dignified and orderly manner; there are no instances reported of any disorder or illegal electioneering. Voting appeared to be fairly heavy in all Communes with again a large number of women voters in evidence.
4. A few cases are reported of lorries bearing Communist signs and fitted with seats carrying voters (ostensibly sick and elderly people) to the polls and in certain communes vehicles were seen carrying large numbers of people but whether to the polls or to football matches is not known.
5. The decree of the Minister, forbidding the sale of wine during election hours was well appreciated by Carabinieri and Questore, and was probably very helpful in maintaining tranquility.

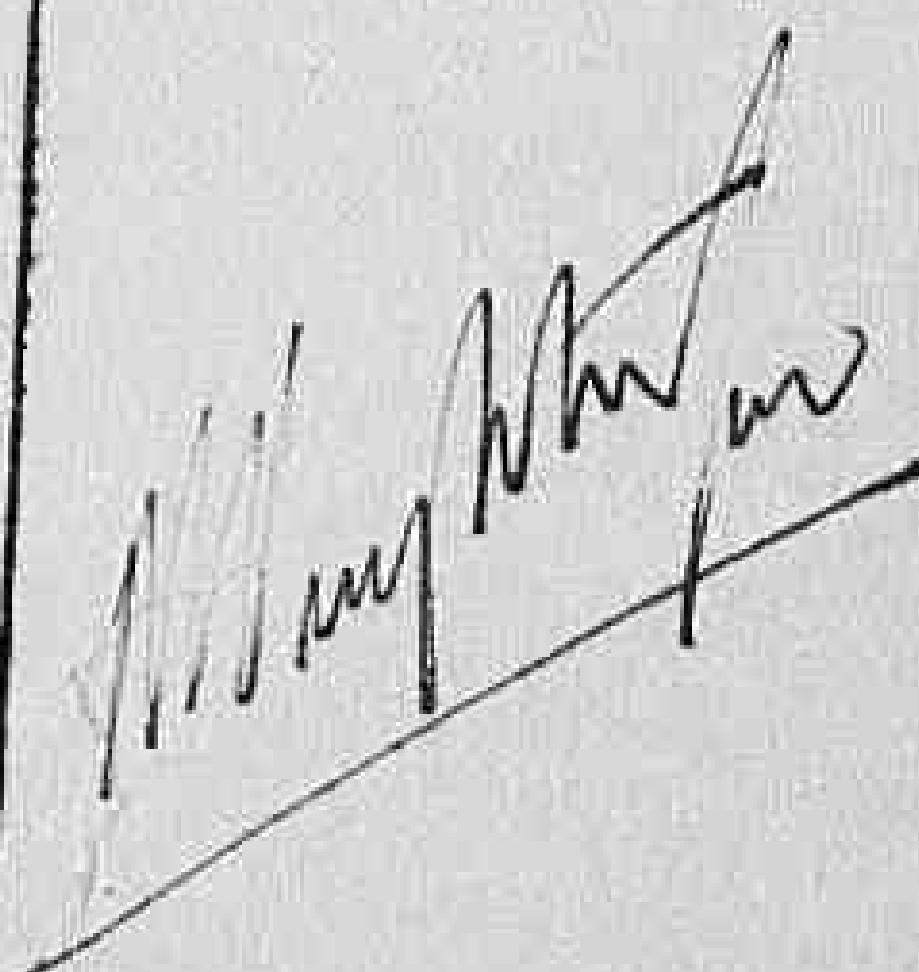

But it does not seem likely that the Sieneese will be able to keep their private paradise. First the Allies will probably see that the products of their soil are more fairly distributed. The Granai del Lovelo scheme has had a mixed reception; the poorer classes consider 900 lire for a quintal of grain a ridiculously high price (it was formerly 240 lire) which is bound to cause an increase in the price of bread; the "contado" though temporarily pleased, fear that it will cause inflation. A lot of cattle were carried off by the Germans before they left and this has caused a grave shortage of meat and fats. Through lack of chemicals the oil harvest will be poor this year.

To sum up, conditions in Siena and its surrounding district are momentarily fairly good; they will probably get worse, but it seems unlikely that there will ever become real distress.

stians and Communists in two Communes: in Formello as
opposed to a Socialist List and in Riano as opposed to
an Independent List.

1. Elections in all provinces of Venezie Region were observed by officers from this Headquarters on 24 March 46.
2. Reports from every province stated that no incidents occurred. Voting was orderly and no violations of voting regulations was observed. Throughout the region it is estimated that a minimum of 85% of the registered voters participated in the elections.
3. No difficulties are being encountered by election officials in counting and tabulating the election results. Nearly all tabulations are completed in each commune within 24 hours, and in no instance has any commune required more than 48 hours to make its final report to the Prefettura. These latter communes usually are isolated in rural areas.

SUBJECT : Observations of Communal Elections
on 24 March in Latina Province -
Communes of Cisterna, Cori and Sezze.

TO : The Director of Loc. Govt. S/C.

1. Accompanied by Dr. Tommaso BIVONA, Inspector-General of the Ministry of the Interior I made the following visits :-

- 23 March - Latina Prefecture and preliminary enquiries at Cisterna and Cori ;
- 24 March - Observation of electoral operations at Sezze and Cori ;
- 25 March - I visited Cisterna and Cori during the counting of the votes.

In all three Communes we conferred with the Sindaco or Commissario Prefetto, Segretario Comunale, Maresciallo of C.C.R.R. and the Commissario di P.S. and also some of the Presidents of the Sections, Secretaries of local political parties, etc. At Latina Prefecture we interviewed the Prefect and his chief officials (including the Vice-Prefect directing the electoral office) and the provincial chiefs of the Police.

2. Cisterna stands on the Via Appia about 8 miles south of Velletri and is one of the most heavily war-damaged communes. Its population is down from about 15,000 to 10,000. The other two communes are mountain towns of the usual type on the edge of the Pontine Marshes. The main interest is cattle farming.

3. The Prefect expected the mountain communes to go left on the ground that they looked to the left to get back for themselves their right of pasturing cattle on the lowlands, which they lost when the Pontine Marshes were reclaimed. At Cori the Sindaco (Communist) was certain of a victory for the Socialist-Communist list. At Sezze, however, as the two left parties had quarrelled and put up separate lists because the Socialists insisted on the inclusion of one or two candidates thought to be tainted with Fascism, the Demo-Christians expected to win by reason of the split vote. At Cisterna the local officials expected a Demo-Christian majority, though that party had also laid itself open to criticism by including candidates supposed to be tainted with Fascism. There is also a strong Republican Party club of long standing in Cisterna which was putting up its own list.

4. State of the Electoral Lists. No particular difficulty was discovered. Both Cisterna and Sezze had a fascist Ispettore-Federale excluded from voting by sentence of the Provincial Commission. The number excluded for ordinary crimes was not excessive. All communes expected a considerable number of electoral certificates to be applied for personally on the day of voting. At Sezze there was quite a queue for them. Cisterna with 6,257 electors had only issued 2,500 certificates, principally owing to the large number of electors who were refugees. The Communal Secretary actually went out personally to the D.P. Camp at Sabaudia to issue certificates there.

5. Preliminary operations. These all seem to have been done to time when the polls opened on the stroke of 08.00 hours. All the communes had done very well in fitting up sections (I was able to see something of them on the day before the elections), especially at Cisterna and invariably section No.1 (where the final count takes place) was at the Municipio.

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6. Propaganda. In all the communes the competing parties were having final meetings on Saturday evening, with a great display of banners, slogans and beflagged trucks bringing people into town for them. The law forbidding electoral propaganda on the actual election day seemed to be properly observed. Lorries bringing voters to the polls were in evidence everywhere, mostly flying the national and the red flags, except at Sezze where all the trucks I saw bore Demo-Christian manifestoes. There was no incident of any kind except one of an encouraging nature at Cori. On Saturday evening while the Demo-Christian meeting was being addressed by Cingolani, one of the

rational leaders of the party, he was greeted towards the end of his speech by a certain amount of whistling. Thereupon the local Communist and Socialist leaders stood up and publicly apologized for the disturbances. They then escorted Gingolani from the town among the cheers of the population.

7. Public order and attitude of the population. The police were well in evidence, mostly the CCR, all carrying Tommy-guns, two or three at every section. Extra police had been drafted in. They had nothing at all to do. The CCR Captain drove from commune to commune inspecting the electoral proceedings.

The political meetings on the evening before election day were well attended and perfectly orderly. Election day was like any other Sunday - neither great excitement nor indifference. The voters stood in queues at the door of every section patiently and obeyed the directions of the CCR promptly and without question. On the day after the election there were large crowds waiting outside the Municipio awaiting the results. The people then displayed more interest than on the day before, disputing and arguing quite excitedly among themselves, but all in quite a natural manner. At Cori on this day my hitherto successful efforts at being inconspicuous quite broke down. There were loud cheers, much handclapping and shouts of "Viva l'Inghilterra" on my going into and coming out of the Municipio. An alley was formed for the car and we departed in a roar of good will.

8. All the officials appeared to be regularly appointed. Some of the "scrutatori" were women. One or two did not turn up and had to be substituted at the last minute. Cisterco's president of the 3rd Section died in his place a few minutes after 06.00 hours when he was about to commence operations and a substitute was promptly found for him in accordance with the law.

9. Counting of the votes. The recent alterations in the polling hours whereby electoral sections were to open at 06.00 hours and polling to begin at 08.00 hours and to continue till 22.00 hours have had the result that no attempt was made to begin the scrutiny that evening. It takes almost the whole of the next day to get the results. With the majority system, however, the results in one or two sections indicate with practical certainty the final result. I gathered that practically everyone had voted a straight ticket and the number of spoilt ballot papers was surprisingly low.

10. Figures are given in the Appendix and copies of the official notices giving lists of the candidates are annexed.
