The widow can not receive any compensation from the Italian Authorities, unless the Claims & Hirings Directorate makes a statement that up to date no money at all has been given to her by them.

In the meantime her case can be dealt with by the Claims and Hirings, and the copies can be sent one one.

TO : The Ministry of the Interior

1. On 7 October the Ministry forwarded to this Sub-Commission an application for compensation from the above-named, widow of Lt. of OC.RR. Rodolfo RUOCO killed in an accident with an Allied car.

2. The claim is in course of settlement. For this purpose it is necessary to have particulars of the earnings of the deceased at the time of his death and of the pension paid to the widow. The Allied authorities have endeavoured to obtain these particulars from OC.RR. Headquarters Rome but without success.

3. Would the Ministry please see to it that these details are supplied so that the case can be settled without further delay. The information should be sent direct to "D.A.D. Claims & Hirings, 53 Claims & Hirings, RAC"

Investigations of the case are still proceeding with a view to determining liability and it is anticipated that some time will elapse before a decision is ultimately reached.

TO : DD Claims and Hirings. RAAC.

1. Reference your OH/41/C/28 of 4th January, copies of the papers constituting the claim have now been obtained and are sent herewith. Would you kindly acknowledge receipt.

2. It has been represented to me on behalf of the Carabinieri that Signora Flagiello is practically destitute as a result of her husband's death and has applied to the Carabinieri authorities for an allowance of some kind. The rules of that service however do not permit (I am told) the Italian Authorities to make any payment to Signora Flagiello without a certificate that the Allied Authorities have not made any payment to her on her claim.

3. Would you be good enough therefore to let me have a short statement to the effect that Signora Flagiello's claim is still under examination by you and that you have not made or authorized any payment to her. This would assist the lady without I suggest in any way prejudicing the subsequent examination of her claim; and if you can see your way to issue such a statement I shall be very grateful.
