1. This confirms our conversations of Saturday, 20 October.

2. It is requested that the circular of the Ministry of Industry and Commerce which appears on page 1452 of Official Gazzette N. 115, dated 25 September 1945, should not be implemented in AMG territory. This circular is entitled "Riassunto dei provvedimenti prezzi n.26 del 17 Settembre 1945, riguardante i prezzi degli oli" and appears over the N.1619.

3. The presence of this circular was overlooked in view of the fact that circulars are not listed in the reference lists Legal Sub-Commission attaches to the Official Gazzettes. However, it was understood Saturday that there was sufficient time to prevent implementation in this case.

4. A copy of the circular in question is now in the hands of the North Italy Price Fixing Board for checking and if the circular is not in conflict with any orders issued by the Board, implementation will be authorized at some time in the future.

SUBJECT: Grant of autonomy to Valley of Aosta.

5 October 1945

TO : Economic Section.

1. In the Official Gazette No. 113 of 20 September 1945 is published the Italian Government's Decree No. 545 of 7 September, constituting the Valley of Aosta as a separate local government area and providing for its administration and powers. The same issue of the Gazette contains a supplementary Decree (No. 546) of which a copy is annexed.
2. Decree No. 546 appears to relate exclusively to the powers of the newly constituted authority as to water power and mineral rights and to questions of customs and excise. It would seem, therefore, to be the concern of Public Works and Finance S/Cs as well as to this Section.
3. Will the appropriate S/Cs please consider accordingly whether or not the Decree should be excepted from implementation and notify Legal S/C accordingly.
4. It is proposed to except the main Decree No. 545 from implementation and we advise that Decree No. 546 should also be excepted.

MINISTERIAL DECREE 20 JUNE 1945Augmented price of synthetical products Italchina and Ateorina.-

The Minister of Finance in
agreement with
the Minister of Interior

In consideration of articles 3 and 5 of the Royal Decree Law 8 March 1934 N° 736 regarding the use of synthetical products for fighting Malaria and the instructions for establishing the sale price to the Administrations and Public Bodies that by Law must distribute them free of charge.-

In consideration of the Interministerial Decree 30 August 1939 that fixes the sale price to Administrations and Public Bodies, of the anti-malaria synthetic drug "Italchina" at 2.500 lire.-

In consideration of the Interministerial Decree 30 August 1940 that fixes the sale price to Administrations and Public Bodies of the anti-malaria synthetic drug "Atebrina" at the same price of "Italchina".-

Recognising the necessity of augmenting this price to adapt it to the present market rates.-

Considering the advisability of selling these s.m. drugs, that were reserved for Administrations and Public Bodies, also to the general public.-

In consideration of the legislative decree 5 October 1944 n. 300 that establishes the Administration Board of the State Monopolies, and delegates its competence to the Minister of Finance.

HEREWITH DECREE:

- 1.- The sale of antimalaria synthetic drugs "Italchina" and "Atebrina" previously reserved to Administrations and Public bodies, is extended also to the general public.-
- 2.- Beginning the 1st July 1945 the sale price of each of these drugs is augmented to 15.000 lire per Kg. for Administrations and Public bodies, and 18.000 lire per Kg. for the general public. The discount due to the detail sellers for the distribution to the public of these synthetical drugs is established at 5% on the sale price.-

The present decree will be registered by the Accounting Court.

1. Mr. Stauffer requested that I refer the following to you for information.
2. The Italian Government has passed a decree fixing the price of two medical drugs.
3. Mr. Stauffer has requested in the attached memo that this decree be excluded from implementation in North Italy for the reasons stated.
4. In view of the imminent turn-over of territory to the Italian Government, I am doing my best to implement all Italian legislation as a matter of course. The mere fact of the existence of the North Italy Price Board does not seem to me to be any reason for excluding implementation unless that Board has already established a different price for these drugs. On the other hand, the moment territory is restored to the Italian Government this decree will automatically come into operation and the price fixed by the Italian Government to become operative notwithstanding the existence of the North Italy Price Board.
5. I suggest that in order to avoid confusion this decree might be implemented and I shall be glad if you would reconsider the matter and give a decision as early as possible.

- a. This Decree is not applicable to North Central Italy since only real half-share tenancy is found and share-cropping is not used. However, to avoid political parties making arbitrary use of the Decree by attempting to extend its application to other types of contracts and thus causing trouble and dissatisfaction in AMG territory, it would seem best not to approve its use in forward areas.
- b. This Sub-Commission has stated its objection to the Decree in letter AGR/146, 18 October 1944. We feel that those points are still applicable.

SUBJECT : Implementation of D.L. No. 303.

TO : Civil Affairs Section.

1. The attached memorandum from Labour Sub-Commission proposes that the above decree be partially implemented in a portion of territory now under Regional control. Apart from this partial implementation the Labour Sub-Commission request non-implementation of the decree in occupied territory.

2. It is not possible from a legal point of view to implement the decree with the exclusion of Article 10. There are at least two reasons for this :-

(a) Article 11 of the decree specifically refers to Article 10.

(b) The decree will become operative in full in any territory which is restored hereafter to the Italian Government with effect from the date of restoration. A partial implementation during the period of military government may raise difficulties as to the effective date of the commencement of the decree.

3. While theoretically possible it is undesirable to implement the decree in a portion only of occupied territory. This is contrary to the existing practice and may lead to confusion. It is suggested that the decree should be implemented over the whole of the usual territory or excluded from implementation.

4. It appears from the letter that the objections to Article 10 of the decree are :-

(a) that it provides for a compulsory attempt at conciliation and
(b) that its provisions are not in conformity with General Order No. 28.

5. In my opinion there is no substance in the objection that it provides for a compulsory attempt at conciliation. Article 10 reads "that individual and collective disputes affecting only one provision if they are not settled by conciliation of representatives of the interested de facto labour organizations are referred to an Arbitration Board.....". This does not involve compulsory conciliation.

6. The real complaint of the Labour Sub-Commission as contained in the letter and as explained to me in conference is that the decree is considered to be an attempt to overthrow the arbitral jurisdiction of the Provincial Labour Offices. Article 10 does provide that for the purposes of arbitration there shall be three arbitrators, one selected by each party and the third to be nominated by agreement between the parties. In default of agreement the nomination is made by the Provincial Labour Office. It will be observed that the jurisdiction of the Provincial Labour Office can be excluded if agreement is reached on the nomination of the third arbitrator.

7. It is, of course, a matter of policy whether this element of the decree is of sufficient importance to warrant its non-implementation. I did, however, bring to the attention of the Labour Sub-Commission the fact that the decree is correctly described as providing for "economic improvement of workers" and that I thought it would secure unfavourable publicity to refuse to implement it.

TO : Legal Sub-Commission

1. With respect to the Legislative Decree of the Lieutenant General, No. 303, signed 2 November, 1944, which increases wages for workers in private industry, it is requested that all the provisions contained in this Decree be excluded from the Provinces of Emilia, Liguria, Venezia, Lombardia and Piemonte.

2. It is further requested that in its application to A.M.C. areas in Toscana, Marche-Abruzzi e Molise, and Umbria-Lazio, Article X be specifically excluded.

3. Objection is raised to the provisions contained in Article X:

A. On Juridical Grounds

The article indirectly provides for a compulsory attempt at conciliation - the responsibility for which is made to devolve on the "de facto" associations. In consequence of this provision, a citizen who is legally claiming a right would be obliged, in the event of a dispute, to submit his case for compulsory conciliation to associations which have only a "de facto" existence and are devoid of any legal status or juridical existence. The legal is therefore subjected to the "de facto" - an untenable juridical concept.

B. On Practical Grounds

As a result of the situation outlined above, the following difficulties are likely to arise:

- (1) The citizen claiming a legal right which is being denied to him in the application of the present law would not be in a position to know if "de facto" Syndical Associations exist - there being at present no provision for registration of the Associations;
- (2) Similarly, he would not be in a position to know the official seats of the "de facto" associations, their jurisdictional activities, and the legitimate representatives to whom the dispute would be referred to conciliation;
- (3) In order to obtain redress of a legal right, he might have to submit his case to a "de facto" Association which for its political character or for its lack of seriousness he may regard as unacceptable or not worthy of trust;
- (4) He would, moreover, have no definite guidance wherever there might come into existence two or more "de facto" associations.

4. The provisions made by Article X are not in conformity with General Order No. 28, which devolves on the Labor Offices all attempts at conciliation and arbitration. General Order No. 28, therefore, already provides the proper machinery for the solution of these problems. Therefore, in making the Italian Decree applicable, it will only be necessary in A.M.G. territory to substitute General Order No. 28 for Article X.

5. When the text of this draft law was discussed with the Labor Sub-Commission, the provisions for arbitration were not those contained in the law as finally promulgated. In fact, this text of Article X was never submitted either to the Labor Sub-Commission or to the Allied Commission. This raises the question as to whether the Italian Government is bound to consult A.C. with respect to any draft legislation. No directive has been issued to this Sub-Commission on this point since A.C.C. became A.C.

Art. 1 - Cav. Uff. Rag. Adm to PETTINARI of late Guglielmo is appointed Vice-Commissioner of the Bank of Italy for the liberated territory;

Art. 2 - The Vice-Commissioner cooperates with the Commissioner in the exercise of his functions, he takes care of the internal organization and close relation between branches and has authority to sign for the Institut in matters relative to the branches.

Art. 3 - The Commissioner of the Bank of Italy, with own decision, may entrust the Vice-Commissioner with the authority to sign also in matters pertaining to public offices and others, for deeds of ordinary administration.

Art. 4 - The present decree will be published in the Official Gazette of the Kingdom - Special Serial.
