TO : Finance Sub-Commission.

1. Reference your 13052/P of 14 May 1945 and as discussed (Brig. GRAFFNEY SMITH - Col. REEDER), it is considered to be undesirable to alter the complicated order which has already appeared in the supplement to Gazzetta Ufficiale No. 51 and been put into effect in the north.

2. Although perhaps not ideal from a legal point of view, it is considered to be better from a practical point of view, should you wish to reduce the price of tobacco, salt, matches etc. to arrange for the publication of a Regional Order along the following lines:

" I,....., Regional Commissioner, hereby order:

1. Within the Region of.....maximum prices are hereby established for the undermentioned items as follows:

Tobacco	
.....	

2. This Order shall come into effect throughout all territory subject to AMG within.....Region from the date of its first publication therein and with effect from that date all provisions of Italian law and all decrees, or orders of the Italian Government which are inconsistent with such maximum prices are suspended until further notice of the AMG".

SUBJECT : Special Courts of Assize.

TO : Regional Commissioner (Attn: Regional Legal Officer),
LOMBARDIA Region.

1. Your HQ/5020 of 12 May 1945 is acknowledged.

2. Every effort will be made to procure additional Grade V personnel to form separate sections for the Special Courts. It is assumed that personnel sent from the south will be acceptable in view of the prevailing shortage in the north. A conference has been arranged with the Minister of Justice tomorrow morning when the whole subject will be discussed, and he will be asked to remove suitable personnel from the south and to appoint them on a temporary basis to the north. I have very little doubt that he will disapprove, as frankly I do myself, ~~to~~ the appointment of vice presidents of Grade VI. Such an appointment is not authorized by the decree and I feel that an official of Grade VI would not be sufficiently experienced for this work. I intend to press for at least six Grade V officials.

3. I have already written a reply on the special section of the Court of Cassation. I of course appreciate your problems but I do not approve Lt. Col. Hannaford's suggestion for the following reasons;

a. Of the personnel proposed for the court, only one is the required grade. While it would be possible to regularize the promotions made by the Brescia Government, the Minister of Justice states that he does not feel justified in doing so in the case of the particular officials mentioned in the letter. I sympathize with his point of view and so long as he is ~~keeping~~ bona fide I do not see that I can compel him to change his attitude. *why?*

b. All personnel named are from the Milan area. I know that the court will sit in Milan and that if it is not permanently engaged in hearing appeals the judges appointed to it can be occupied in other work at other times. On the other hand, it is essential that the court should at least have the appearance of being a section of the Court of Cassation at Rome and not a section of the Court of Appeal at Milan. I have requested names of possible nominees from Venice, Turin, Genoa and Bologna. So far

X The Minister just said this
but later doubted it.

I have had ~~no~~ reply from Venice giving me one nominee who has been promoted to the required grade by the Brescia Government. I have had no replies from any of the other regions. I appear to be out of touch with these regions so that if you can communicate with them and press them to submit nominees, it will be to advantage. In any event I propose to visit Turin, Genoa and Milan at the end of the week when I may be able to achieve something.

4. A request has been made to the Procuratore Generale Militare to furnish forthwith personnel for military courts in your area and I hope that they will come as soon as possible.

5. MG can in no circumstances countenance any departure from the formula contained in MIL 164 of 1944 unless and until such departure is agreed by the Italian Government.

6. Economic Section state that it is the intention that General Order No. 41 should be posted forthwith. Please therefore take immediate steps to post it.

7. Five extra sets of the Gazettes have already been sent to your Hq in reply to your previous request for a few copies; the extra 15 are being prepared and will be forwarded.

8. The supplement to GU No. 51 is not attached to the copies of that Gazette. It is bundled separately and the full number of copies have already been delivered to your Hq as part of the supply which you have already received.

SUBJECT : Extraordinary Courts of Appeal.

TO : HQ, ALLIED SUBCOMMITTEE - Legal Sub-Commission.

1. All Provincial capitals within this Region have now been visited and the provisions of D.L. 142 explained to the magistrates and other parties concerned.

2. Orders have been signed by the First Presidents and the Procureurs Generals of the Milan Court of Appeal appointing the Presidents and Public Prosecutors for one Court in each Province in the District and three for Milan itself (copies attached). Similar orders have been signed for the Brescia Circuit.

3. The number of cases awaiting trial is estimated to exceed 20,000. It is obvious therefore that one Court per Province will be unable to cope with the work involved and it is urged that separate sections be established where required e.g. Vigevano, Porto Ceresio, Lecco, Voghera.

4. The difficulty to be faced is the lack of sufficient personnel of Grade V in this area. It is therefore requested that either the First President be authorized to nominate an official of grade VI to act as Vice President and sit as head of a Section or that additional personnel of Grade V be sent North at once.

5. A reply to Lt. Col. HANK FORD's letter on the setting up of a special section of the Court of Cassation is urgently required.

6. In certain districts e.g. Como and Pavia, the local authorities are of opinion that the procedure of the Special Courts will involve too long a delay before results appear, especially in the cases of well known fascists charged with tortures and brutalities. Arrangements are therefore being made for Military Courts to be started in this area forthwith under D.L. 66 for which purpose personnel from Rome are urgently required. General Cadorna is also being approached on this question.

7. A delegation from CIMA representing each of the constituent parties yesterday stated that all the parties were agreed that the formula contained in D.L. 142 ("Umberto di Savoia" etc.) was not acceptable in Northern Italy and that

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the use of this formula by the President of a Special Court of Assize would meet with public disapproval and might even lead to disorder. The delegates suggested that the formula "In the name of the law" be used instead.

8. It was pointed out to the delegation that this was a question of Italian Law and that the delegation was not in a position to alter legislation which had been accepted by the heads of all the parties in Rome. The delegates were directed to put forward their recommendations on this subject to the Italian Government, if they so desired.

9. G.S. No. 41 arrived at this HQ yesterday. Authority to post it is still awaited.

10. Certain Provincial Legal Officers are without supplies of the Official Gazette, since these have apparently been lost or mislaid between Rome, Chianciano, Rome, Siena and the various Provincial Capitals. Can 20 extra sets of the Raccolta and subsequent issues be forwarded to make up these deficiencies and to provide additional copies for certain of the magistrates?

11. Supplies of the Gazzetta Ufficiale for delivery to the Prefects have been received, and the Supplement to G.S. 51 came to hand yesterday. As soon as the situation regarding the appointment of Prefects is clarified, the legislation will be implemented in the normal way.

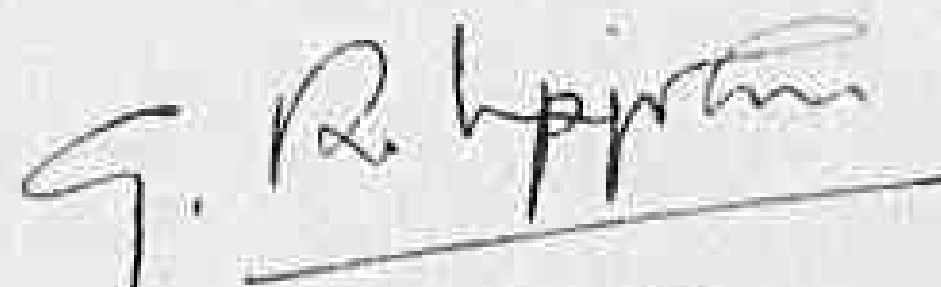

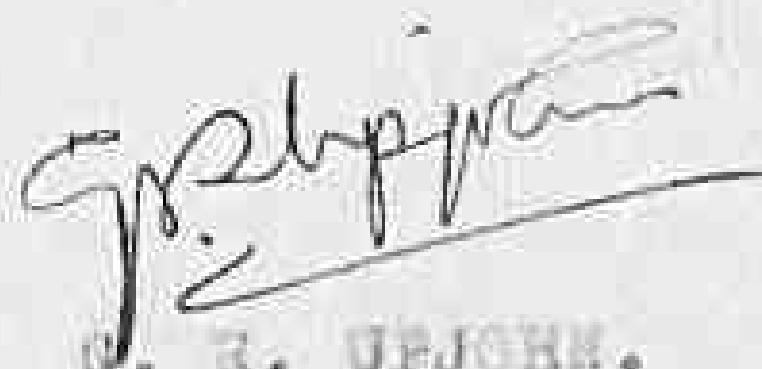

1. Your monthly report of 3 May 1945 was no doubt written before you received the directive on economic decrees of 1 May 1945. In case this should not have arrived a copy is attached.

2. You will see that special supplement to Gazzetta Ufficiale 51 excludes (temporarily) all the "undesirable" economic decrees. There is therefore no objection to the immediate application of the implementation procedure, and indeed I hope that this has already occurred.

3. You will also see that Order No. 2 in that supplement tabulates in a convenient form all excluded decrees within the limits mentioned in the order.

4. On the subject of the implementation of D.L. 159/44 in relation to D.L. 142/45 discussed in your earlier letter I have discovered that D.L. 159 has been implemented in EMILIA, LIGURIA, LOMBARDIA and almost certainly in PIEMONTE. Any how it will be implemented in PIEMONTE very soon. I gather that it will be implemented in most of your Region also.

5. I do not therefore intend to issue a further implementation order which would probably only confuse other Legal Officers who had not seen the point. I have discussed the question with Brig. Upjohn and made the following recommendation. If there is any province in VENETIE in which the Special Court of Assise will be ready to proceed to trial before the General Expiration decrees are implemented will you please issue for that province a Regional Order substantially as follows: -

I, hereby order that for the sole purpose of D.L. No. 142 of 22 April 1945 and without prejudice to further implementation of D.L. No. 159 of 27 July 1944, and eventual modifications thereof by virtue of another order of the Allied Military Government, the provisions of Arts. 3, 5, 6, 7, 9 and 42 of D.L. No. 159 of 27 July 1944, published in C. U. No. 41 of 29 July 1944, shall become operative and shall have full force and effect of law in the Province of _____ on the day of _____ 1945.

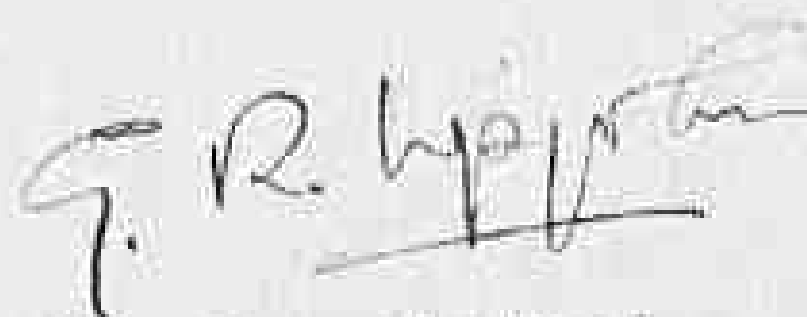

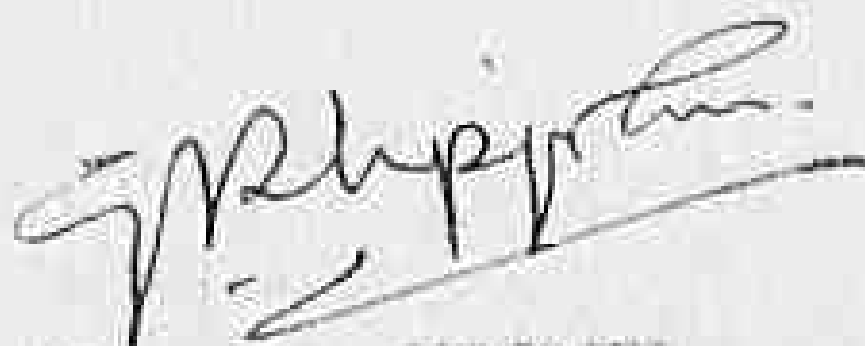

1. Your RXII/LB/Reg/C/04.1 of 30 April 1945 is acknowledged.
2. Copies of the supplement to Gazzetta Ufficiale No. 49 were despatched to your Region Hq last week on a sufficient scale to make an effective implementation in all provinces, but not of course on the usual distribution scale. It is hoped that they have now arrived.
3. The normal G. U. for implementation in the provinces you mention are being forwarded as early as possible and should arrive about 9 May. For the remainder of the region they can be left at Region Hq or Padova for future distribution.
4. Para. 6 of your letter has led to a heated argument among legal opinion in Rome, in which I am glad to say that my own view was confirmed by H.E. Casati, First President of the Court of Cassation. He says that the jurisdiction conferred by Art. 1 and Art. 2 of DLL No. 142 is purely legislation by reference to a particular document and that it is immaterial whether DLL No. 159 is effective law or not since, according to accepted Italian drafting (e.g., by the incorporation into municipal law of foreign law), Arts. 1 and 2 of DLL No. 142 must be read as if they contained in themselves the relevant portions of Arts. 3 and 5 of DLL No. 159, which are thereby implemented ad hoc by the implementation order. H.E. Casati has therefore no doubt that the Courts have jurisdiction to operate.
5. There is, however, a further point. Arts. 3 and 5 of DLL No. 159 may be regarded as creating either new crimes or new punishments for old crimes. In so far as they create new crimes, the conference of jurisdiction upon the Special Courts of Assize to try such crimes, obviously confers the right to apply the specified punishment, since no other punishment is elsewhere specified. In so far as they create new punishments for old crimes, H.E. Casati feels that the point is open to an element of doubt, for the removal of which it would be desirable to implement Arts. 3 and 5 of DLL No. 159 before an actual sentence is passed by a court.
6. In practice this implementation will, as you say, almost always have occurred automatically. In order to avoid any possibility of doubt,

however, a further special implementation order is appearing in the G. U. in the near future which can be implemented by itself and will clarify the position. If in any province the Special Courts are ready to deliver a sentence in any case before the general implementation procedure is introduced, this special supplement will have to be specifically rendered operative.

2. So far the copies addressed to this HQ have not arrived, but I have received a copy from S.C.A.O., AMG, 8th Army, who has instructed me to take immediate action to have the decrees contained in the Special Supplement of the Gazzetta Ufficiale implemented in the Provinces in 8th Army Area.

3. As the necessary copies of the Special Supplement have not yet arrived, I sent you a signal yesterday, as under :-

4. The Provinces in 8th Army Area now occupied, in which immediate implementation is required, are those of Rovigo, Padova and Venezia. It is expected that implementation in further provinces will be required at an early date.

5. I have not yet received instructions from S.C.A.O., AMG, 5th Army, and owing to other commitments it has not been possible yet for me to make contact with him. I expect, however, that he will desire the same policy to be followed in the 5th Army Area, and I shall certainly so recommend. The Provinces in 5th Army Area immediately concerned are those of Verona and Vicenza, and it is expected ~~that~~ implementation in further Provinces will be required at an early date.

6. Your advice and assistance is urgently requested on the following point. The decree setting up the Special Courts of Assize, by Section I, confers jurisdiction on the Courts to try offences under Art. 5 of D.L.L. 159 of 27 July 1944. This being so, and the Courts having no other jurisdiction, I am at a loss at present to understand how these Courts can ever possibly

function unless and until D.L.L. 159 has itself been implemented; However, if D.L.L. 159 is to be implemented, it will obviously be necessary to implement at the same time all the subsequent decrees on the subject of "Epurazione" because some of these contain amendments to the provisions of the original decree.

7. So far as 8th Army Area is concerned I do not expect any difficulty on this point because when I conferred with him yesterday the S.C.A.O. intimated to me that in the situation now existing he saw no objection to the early implementation of all Italian legislation in the newly liberated provinces. If this policy is followed, it seems that D.L.L. 159 will in all probability have been implemented in the provinces in 8th Army Area by the time the Special Courts are ready to try any cases.

8. I do not at present know whether the S.C.A.O., A.M.G. 5th Army, desires to follow the same policy. If he does not, the difficulty mentioned in paragraph 6 hereof will arise in an acute form in 5th Army Area.

9. 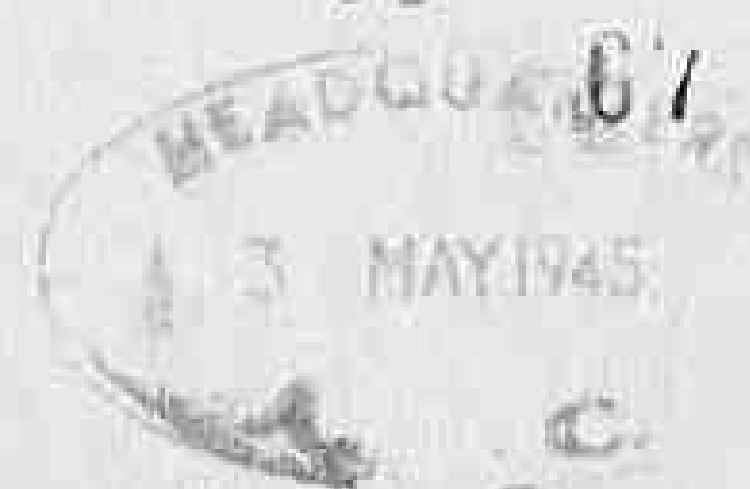

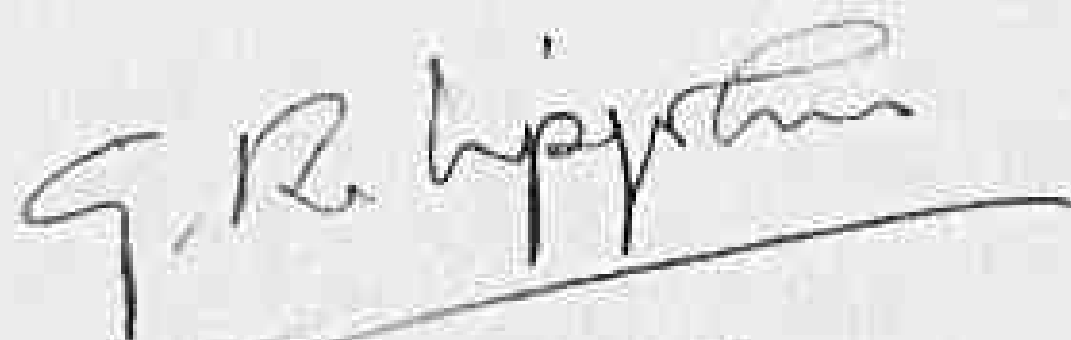

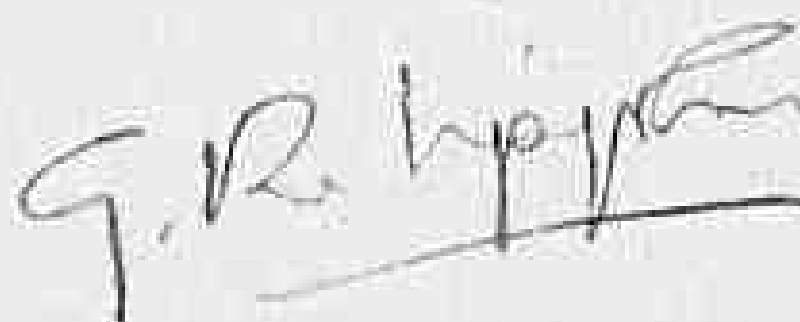

The only truthful answer to your questions about the Official Gazette is "I don't know".

My letter of 12th March was designed to discover what plans Thackrah was making for distributing the bundles to the Northern Provinces when the time came. Parma (or Piacenza) was merely a suggested central depot as I understood that there was to be a food warehouse located in that area, but I assumed that he would work out the details.

I am told that the setting up of this warehouse is the responsibility of the Transportation S/C and that Major Robert Klein is in charge at HQ. It would be more satisfactory if the arrangements could be made there as the Transportation people can see what they are dealing with and issue the necessary orders to Major Hardley, who is to be i/c the depot when it is moved from Ancona.

Once the bundles reach the depot, they would have to be despatched to Provinces on orders to the Depot from the appropriate A.L.O. If an Italian clerk, who knew something about the job, could be sent to the Depot with the bundles, he could control the further distribution.

Parma and Piacenza are not on the route to Venezia, and there might be difficulties about transport in that direction.

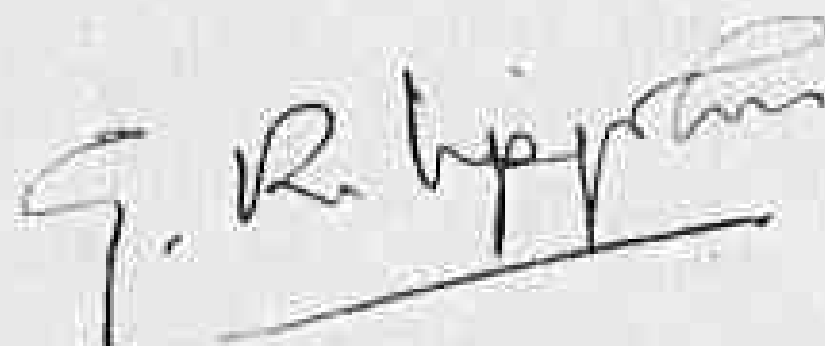

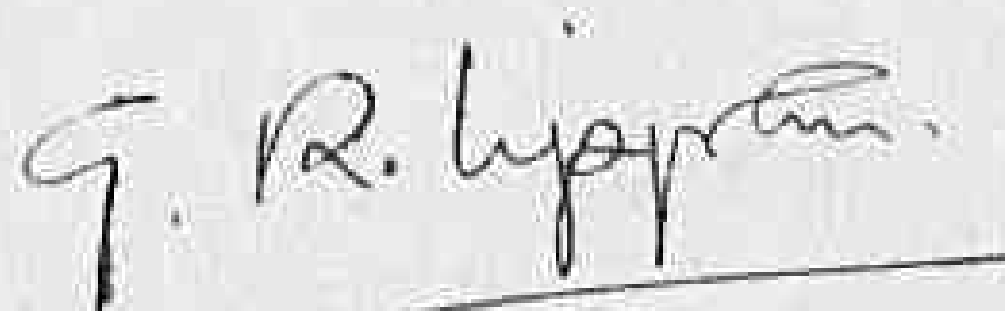

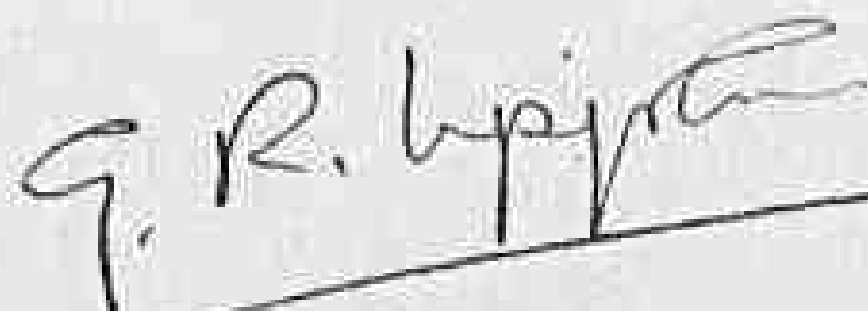

2. On reference to attached file AC/4010/2/L at Flag "A", folio 26 A it is noted that the request of RLO, Southern Region was for retroactive application to 25 Jan 45, date of the original implementation order which was rendered effective in the Commune of Naples on 7 Feb 45.

3. Although subsequent correspondence at Flag "B", folio 34A, makes it clear that retrospective suspension is undesirable on account of the possibility that some rights might have been acquired in the interim under the DLL, nevertheless the practical result of subsequent suspension is to sweep away the mechanism for the substantiation of such rights as might have been so acquired. Moreover, in point of fact the DLL has not been acted upon so that no injustice will be done, therefore it seems unnecessary to make any reserve as to the safeguarding of such hypothetically acquired rights in the endorsement.

TO : Regional Commissioner (Attn: A. R. S.) LIGURIA Region
VENETIA

1. In view of the present policy to implement Italian legislation within each province liberated as soon as a Prefect has been appointed and the Provincial Administration has commenced to function, a decision as to the best method to be adopted for the distribution of the published collections of the "Gazzetta Ufficiale" held in readiness by this Sub-Commission has now become a matter of urgency.

2. The R. Lombardia Region has suggested that in the event that the occupation of the North West takes place under "collapse conditions" making it possible to effect distribution and implementation in a large number of provinces more or less simultaneously, the following plan might be adopted.

3. This would consist of the sending by this HQ of the ready prepared packages of the "Gazzetta Ufficiale" to a central point from which they could be rapidly distributed to the three North Western Regions. Parma is proposed as the most convenient center for this area, and could also serve the same purpose for the Venetia Region.

4. However, distribution from a center other than those R. raises the following points : (a) who will be responsible for the holding and proper selection of the packets destined for Liguria, Piemonte, Lombardia and perhaps Venetia (or parts thereof), and (b) who will supply the transport?

5. On the other hand, if the situation envisaged at para 2 does not materialize and provinces are liberated with varying delays, distribution through this R. message center would have to take place in the normal way by courier. The rate of distribution by this means is estimated at one or two provinces per day, but if groups of provinces are liberated these can be speedily dealt with by special track delivery.

6. The actual facilities being such as they are, it is questionable whether the suggestion at para 2 might not involve too many complications.

7. Your comments and suggestions are invited, it being requested that the matter be treated as urgent.

TO : Local Govt S/C.

1. Your attention is drawn to the wording of DM of 12 Mar 45 appearing in G. U. No. 41 (Examinations for Communal Secretaries) indicating that this decree shall also "be operative in provinces which are or may become subject to Allied Military Government."

2. You are referred to VP's instructions AC/4010/2/L of 1 Mar 45 by which all sub-commissions were requested to ensure that all decrees which are intended to apply to AMG Territory should contain the words set out in paragraph 4 of the said instructions.

3. The contention that the wording of DM of 12 Mar 45 has been expressly authorized by your letter AC.4/5/2/10 of 24 Feb 45 does not alter the fact that the Italian Government has no authority to enact legislation in AMG Territory and that legislation enacted by the Government remains inoperative in such territory unless expressly implemented by order of AMG.

4. Please arrange for the DM to be amended in accordance with VP's instructions above mentioned.

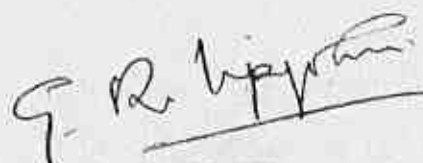
