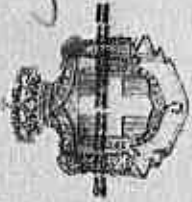

1. The above named Officer was tried by ECOM on 8 Mar 46 and found guilty inter alia on charges involving illegal disposal of public property. From the proceedings of the trial it appears that PRICE was assisted in these transactions by an Italian woman, Beatrice SOLARI, of 6 Via Rovereto, ROME.

2. PRICE was convicted in respect of the following transactions:-

- (a) The illegal disposal of fourteen tons of copper wire for which he and SOLARI received the sum of £3,625.
- (b) The illegal disposal of five hundred and twenty tins of insulating tape for which they received the sum of £65.

It appears, in addition, that there may well have been other 'deals' made by PRICE and SOLARI, involving the fraudulent disposal of PD property.

3. According to the proceedings of the trial, PRICE has a sum of 500,000 lire standing to his credit in an account in Barclays Bank, ROME. However, it appears that, as this sum was received by him from SOLARI in connection with a business which they had made an agreement to form no action can be taken in respect of it until such time as action is taken against SOLARI by the Italian authorities. Furthermore, SOLARI admitted in evidence that she had thirteen saving accounts, containing about 14,000,000 lire and several bank accounts.

4. In view of the fact that a considerable proportion of this money appears to be the result of the transactions referred to above, it is requested that you press the Italian authorities for legal action to be taken against SOLARI as soon as possible, with a view to recovering such money as has been acquired by illegal means.

5. It is also requested that you will inform this H.q. whether it is possible under Italian Law to obtain payment from Societa' Roma Elettrica, the firm which received the goods, mentioned in para 2, or alternatively, whether it is possible to recover the goods in question.
