Ref. your AMU/A/36 of 23 Nov. 45 with enclosures.

The Pretore of San Benedetto del Tronto was only the tenant and not the owner of an apartment at Via Luigi Dori No. 10 San Benedetto.

This was occupied and requisitioned by the Military in 1944 and the requisition has continued. In June of this year when the majority of the tys left this area - the Pretore commenced reconstructions and repairs without any permission from this office: the address was given to the Polish tys when they moved into this area and was duly occupied by them.

The Pretore visited this office in Oct 45 to ask for the derequisition of the apartment: I agreed to do so if the Sindaco could provide alternative accommodation for the tys. concerned; he did not then give any information about his being head of the Electoral Commission for that area and gave as his principal reason the fact that he is a Southern Italian it was not "natural" for him to be separated from his wife for long!!

I understand that he has since visited H. Pol Corps armed with a letter from his Ministry and the former without asking about the position instructed the Comd of tys in San Benedetto to release his apartment to him.

The fact that this has been done has worsened my position in this area because I am now receiving innumerable demands for the derequisitioning of properties without regard to facts: especially in view of the large no. of tys here.

In my opinion this man is one of the worst types of official with whom I am in contact and is thinking only of himself and not his work. The least he could have done was to report that he is now actively engaged in being absent from his duties for several days to bring his furniture from "down country".

SUBJECT : G. Benedetto del Tronto (Ascoli Piceno)
Requisition of the Pretore's House.

1. The Prefect of Ascoli-Piceno has informed this Ministry that the Command of the Polish troops has, in June of this year, requisitioned the house of the Pretore of the Comune of G. Benedetto del Tronto.
2. The Prefect, the Sindaco and the Procura Generale have put the matter up to the Town Mayor of Macerata in order to obtain the derequisition of the house of the said magistrate, but so far without any result, although the Prefect had sent a cable on the 26 Oct. urging a solution.
3. The said Pretore is, since June last living in a hotel, away from the family and affording high expenses. We therefore kindly beg your Hon. Commission to examine the possibility of taking the matter up with the Polish Command and obtain the derequisition of the house of the said magistrate, also considering that he cannot attend his delicate duties with the Electoral Commission and the commissions for lodgings and taxes, of which he is chairman, with the necessary clearness of mind.
4. While waiting for a kind reply we thank you.
