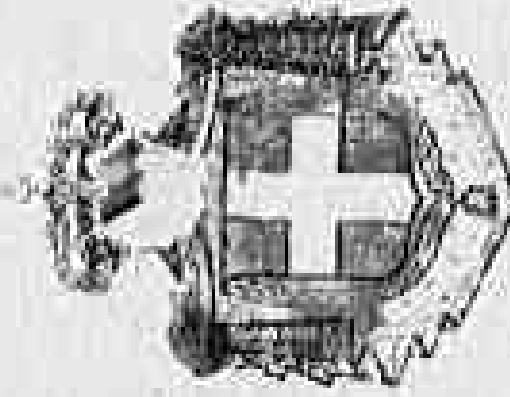

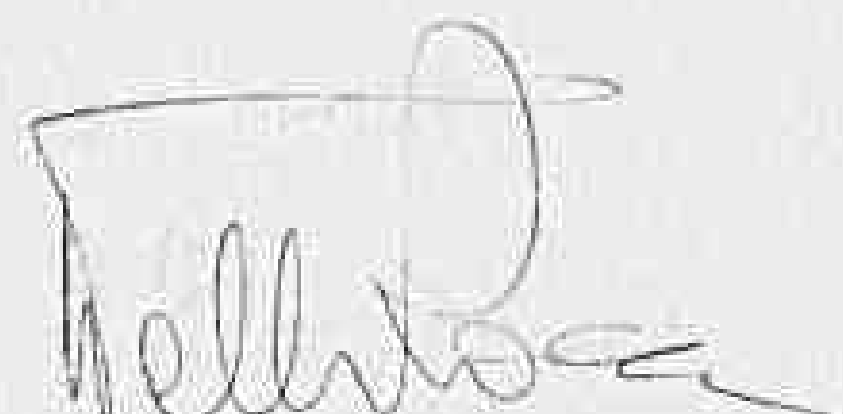

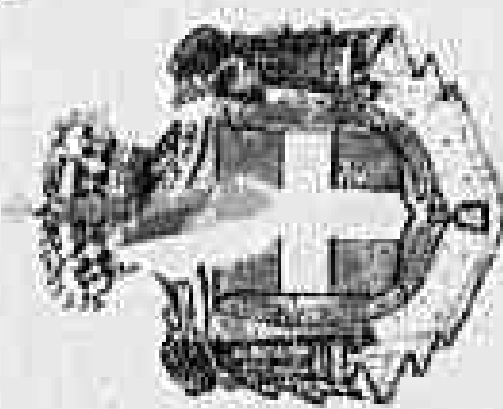

1. This office has received a letter from one SAGNOLI Dino who alleges that the Italian Authorities have been arbitrarily keeping him in jail for eighteen months. Because at one time he presumably worked for the Allies, he contends that he "belongs to the American Army."

The undersigned, Sagnoli Dino, appeals to you so that justice may be done to him. For 18 months, the Italian Authorities have been arbitrarily keeping me in jail. I wrote a postcard to Ambassador Kirk on October 13th, 1945 - as from enclosure 1 and it was returned to me by the Italian Minister of Justice with the herewith enclosed letter, dated 22nd December 1945 (encl. 2). I was always an anti-fascist as can be seen from my trips to England and to the United States and I waited for the American landing in Sicily in Gelat presented myself to the American Authorities as soon as the landing took place, on July 5th 1943, and was taken as a volunteer in the American Army and destined to C.I.C. and A.M.G. - Hq. - Polic. Int. Sect. I always did my duty. I reached Palermo and I went on with my difficult job. Among other things, all by myself, I made prisoner a German officer of the Intelligence Service, dressed as a woman. In Palermo, I became aware of the need to have documents, and in agreement with the head of the office, Major Raffa, I was given a letter dated September 1st, 1943, not in my name, but under the name of Sagnoli Dino, appointing me police officer of A.M.G. - Hq. - Polic. Int. Sect. depending from the Allied Military Command; a pass was also issued to me (visiting card of an American officer, Lt. De Luca, of the same office) with the office stamp (A.M.G. - Hq. - Polic. Int. Sect.). This document didn't bear my real name for, according to Italian laws, I was working for the enemy (this was before the Armistice) and I could be sentenced to death. This the Italian Government and the Italian magistracy can still do, not now, because they don't dare as long as the Allies are in Italy, but to-morrow, or whenever Italian policy changes. The Italian magistracy is trying to find out who I am so that they may be able to try and condemn me to-morrow. I beg for your intervention and I am willing to prove who I am, but the Italians must never know anything about it.

The Italian Legal Authorities charged me with acts which were necessary for the carrying out of my functions in the Polic. Int. Sect. All will be well if an American officer comes to see me.

I still consider myself as a member of the American Army Force, in A.M.G. Hq., and I claim that the Italian Authorities are violating the Armistice.

I beg you to intervene without delay to put an end to my sufferings.

I beg you to save me from the danger that threatens me if the Italians get to know who I am. They will try me and condemn me, may be not today, but tomorrow for helping the enemy (July 5th, till September 8th, 1943) during the time when the American army was still considered as an enemy. The letter appointing me is dated September 1st, 1943, before the Armistice.

I could be released if you write to the Italian Government that I belong to the American Army.

I am in prison at present, but I shall have to get out. What I have to say is of great importance and interest for the United States and I cannot waste time.

Therefore, the Minister for Foreign Affairs returned the letter sent to him, for he didn't deem it advisable to contact the American Embassy on such a matter.
