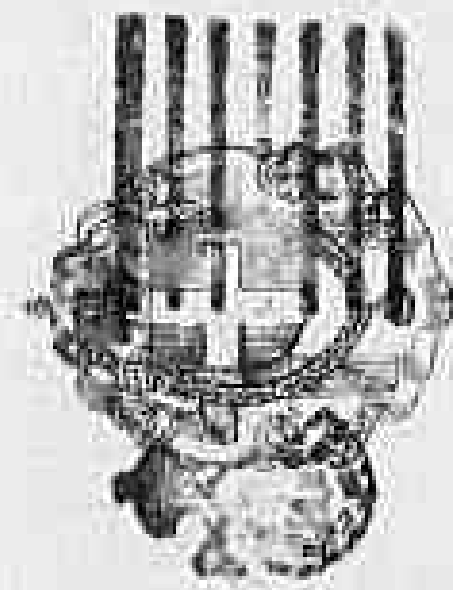

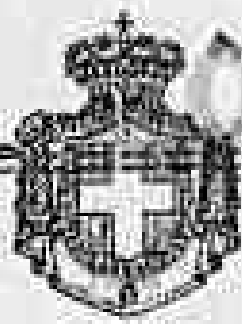

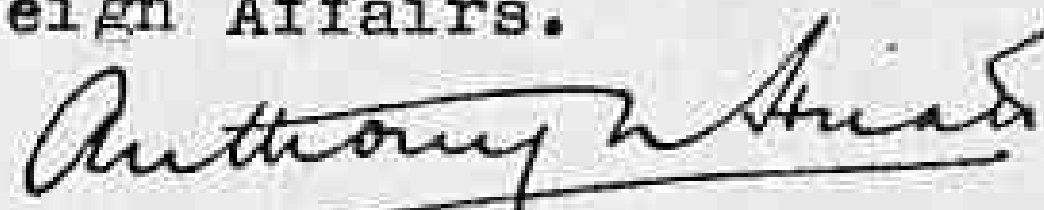

Reference to the request contained in the a/m letter and to my letter No.511 dated 13th May 1946, I have to inform you that from some previous records which have been recovered it appears that the position of RAPISARDI FRANCESCO is the following.-

a) with an order No.15 dated 12/4/1910- the then Governor H.E. Salvago Raggi commuted the punishment imposed upon Rapisardi Francesco (by judgment dated 19/10/1908 of the Tribunale of the Colony) to one of 6 days' work to be rendered in the Residenza Office of Cheren.

Therefore the fine of 60 lira was not paid, but was commuted as aforesaid.

The costs amounting to lira 23,50 have been paid, as it appears from the bill No. 9613 dated 3.8.1910, which settles all costs; ref.n. 391 of Penal Registry of this Tribunale.

B) Against the name of Rapisardi Francesco, it appears also at No. 392 of the Registry that the above named paid Lire 34,25(bill No. 9612 dated 3/8/1910) in respect of the judgment dated 20/4/1909 by the Penal Court of Appeal of Rome.

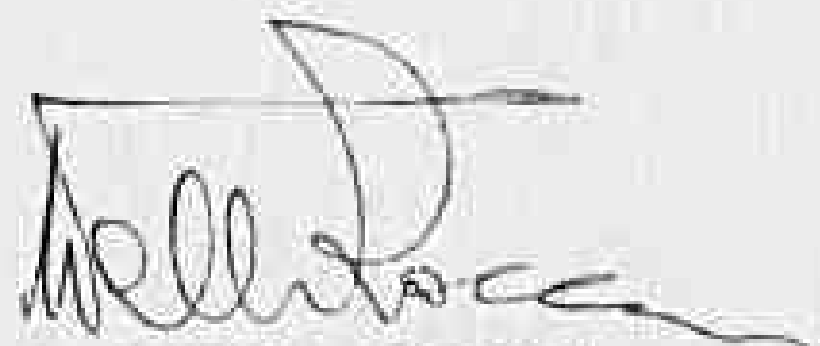

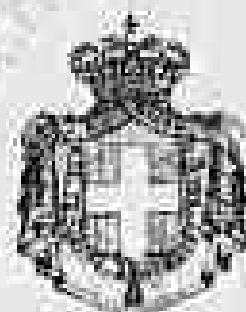

I, the undersigned Prof. G. Ferri, on behalf of Società CITAM, beg to submit to your Sub Commission, the following facts:

1.- On September 1944 a wreck of a truck Lancia 3RO, engine n. 3016, was salvaged by CITAM under regular contact with A.M.G. Authorities.

The wreck was estimated by experts appointed by A.M.G. and the Società CITAM deposited with the Banca Commerciale Italiana the sum of 150.000 Italian Lire, which was the value of the wreck as estimated by the experts.

2.- The wreck was sold by A.M.G. to CITAM, a new motorvehicle was rebuilt and obtained inscription to the P.M.A. under the name of CITAM with the number RIETI 2956.

3.- On October 1944 the Lazzi Firm, declaring to be owner of a truck n. PT 5276, and declaring as well that the wreck salvaged by CITAM was nothing else but the wreck of the same truck put through an "Atto di Citazione" against the CITAM for the restoring of its ownership rights. In the meantime the truck was put under judicial custody.

4.- A sentence of the Tribunale of Rome dated 15th February 1946, held that the CITAM was the lawful owner of the truck Lancia 3RO, rejected the claim of Lazzi Firm and revoked the judicial custody.

5.- The Lazzi Firm appealed to the Court of Appeal of Rome against the sentence; the proceeding is still in front of that Court and the inquiry is held by Cons. Pellettini.

- 2 -

6. - During the proceeding in front of the Court of Appeal the Lazzi Firm produced a requisition paper n. 6283 without a date and a letter of Rome Area Command, MTOUSA APO 794 dated 25th February 1946 to the Transportation Sub Commission of Allied Commission HQ where is declared:

a) that the bus Lancia 3RO, engine n.6916 was requisitioned by Rome Area Command on July 1944 to be used by American Red Cross ;

b) that as a consequence, the wreck had not been lawfully sold by A.M.G. to CITAM being the car already requisitioned by American Authorities and being therefore the Rome Area Command the lawful owner of said car;

c) that a letter had been written by A.C. to the M.A.C.T. declaring that the car had not been lawfully sold and that the car should be therefore derequisitioned through normal channels.

7. - On June 19, 1946, the Rome Area Command announced to the CITAM that on 21st June 1946 they should call on Capt. Maxwell for information.

On fault of managers of CITAM the meeting was attended to by Mr. Andreani, clerk of the Company.

Said meeting, which was presided over by Maj. Banigan of U.S. Claims Office, was attended to also by another Major of U.S. Army on behalf of the Provost Marshall of Rome, by Capt. Maxwell, by Mr. Morlacchi an official of Italian Police (Commissario di P.S.) for the questura of Rome, by Ing. Persia-bosco for the Ispettorato Generale della Motorizzazione, by the interpreter of the U.S., and by Mr. Lazzi with his lawyers <sup>18</sup> Serrao and Mr. Bonanni.

8. - Maj. Banigan declared:

a) that the bus had been requisitioned on July 7, 1944 to be used by the American Red Cross;

b) that the requisition had not taken place for the bus had been taken over by an American soldier by order of A.M.G. and subsequently it had been sold by A.M.G. to CITAM CO;

c) that the A.C. had no right to sell any goods belonging to the American Army;

./.

d) that the above points had been stated in a letter to the CITAM by the Chief of Transportation Office of A.C. (eventually the above letter never reached the CITAM for it had been addressed to 19, Via Saluzzo and not to the CITAM's office).

e) that the CITAM was to hand back the bus for the Rome Area Command wanted to take back possession of the same which still belonged to them, according to a valid requisition; later on the Rome Area Command was to derequisition the bus handing it back to Italian Authorities.

9. - On the afternoon of the same day, 21st June, the two Majors of U.S. Army, Capt. Maxwell and Signor Morlacchi, Commissario di P.S., called on the workshop of CITAM, in Via Crescenzo,. The Italian Police official was to take over the bus on behalf of American Authorities using the powers granted him by the Italian laws.

Mr. Morlacchi did not proceed to the taking over because he was informed that the bus was under judicial custody and the custodian declared he could not hand it over without an order of Italian Judiciary. therefore everything was postponed until such an order was issued.

10. - With reference to the above points the CITAM begs to submit the following:

(a) CITAM lawfully acquired from the A.M.S. the ownership of the vehicle when it was a wreck and reconstructed it at the total cost of some millions Italian Lire.

No vendor can cancel, only with his decision the <sup>16</sup> sale, not that can be done when the Italian territory is no more under Allied Military Government.

(b) Any right the Lazzi Firm, which was the former owner of the vehicle subsequently wrecked, may claim on the truck, must be asked for, as it has already been done, in front of Italian Courts.

This claim has already been put through in front of the Tribunale of Rome and, after the Lazzi's act of appeal, in front of the Court of Appeal of Rome.

./.

No interference of Allied Authorities may be therefore admitted in a controversy between two Italian private firms.

(c) There has never been a requisition by the Rome Area Command, for the vehicle (which moreover could not be operated) was never actually seized by said Command.

Under the rules of the International Law, the actual seizure is required to have a valid requisition, being the requisition allowed only under necessity and it cannot be declared that the use of a vehicle was necessary when the vehicle had not even been seized.

(d) The requisition should be performed now for the first time and that is allowed to the Allied Authorities only through the Italian ones. In any case the requisition could be performed only against the CITAM, for this Co. is entered as lawful owner of the bus in P.R.A. files.

All controversies between the Lazzi Firm and CITAM Co. should not be dealt with by requisitioning Authorities for they are not in a position, as such, to decide any question about the ownership of requisitioned goods. They can only seize the goods in the judicial situation they have at the moment the requisition takes place and it is of no importance for them who is the actual owner.

(e) In this case, on the contrary, the requisition aims to decide the controversy between the Lazzi Firm and the CITAM outside of the proper authorities.

The Rome Area Command actually wants to put into effect a requisition which is alleged to have taken place in July 1944 but never gone into effect, not with the purpose of using the vehicle but only with the purpose of derequisitioning it and hand it back to the Italian Authorities. It must be stressed that such a way of proceeding is not, most certainly, allowed by International Law.

II. - According to the above stated, the undersigned on behalf of CITAM Co., begs to ask your Legal Sub Commission to make clear to the Rome Area Command the opportunity of not proceeding on (against the war International Law rules) with the proposed seizure of the vehicle. And farther note the opportunity that all inquiry as regards the ownership claims of Lazzi Firm against CITAM Co., which are already dealt with by judicial authorities, should be left to Italian Law Courts.

After that moment more news has been heard expect rumours that he was caught on the mountains above Bologna (?)

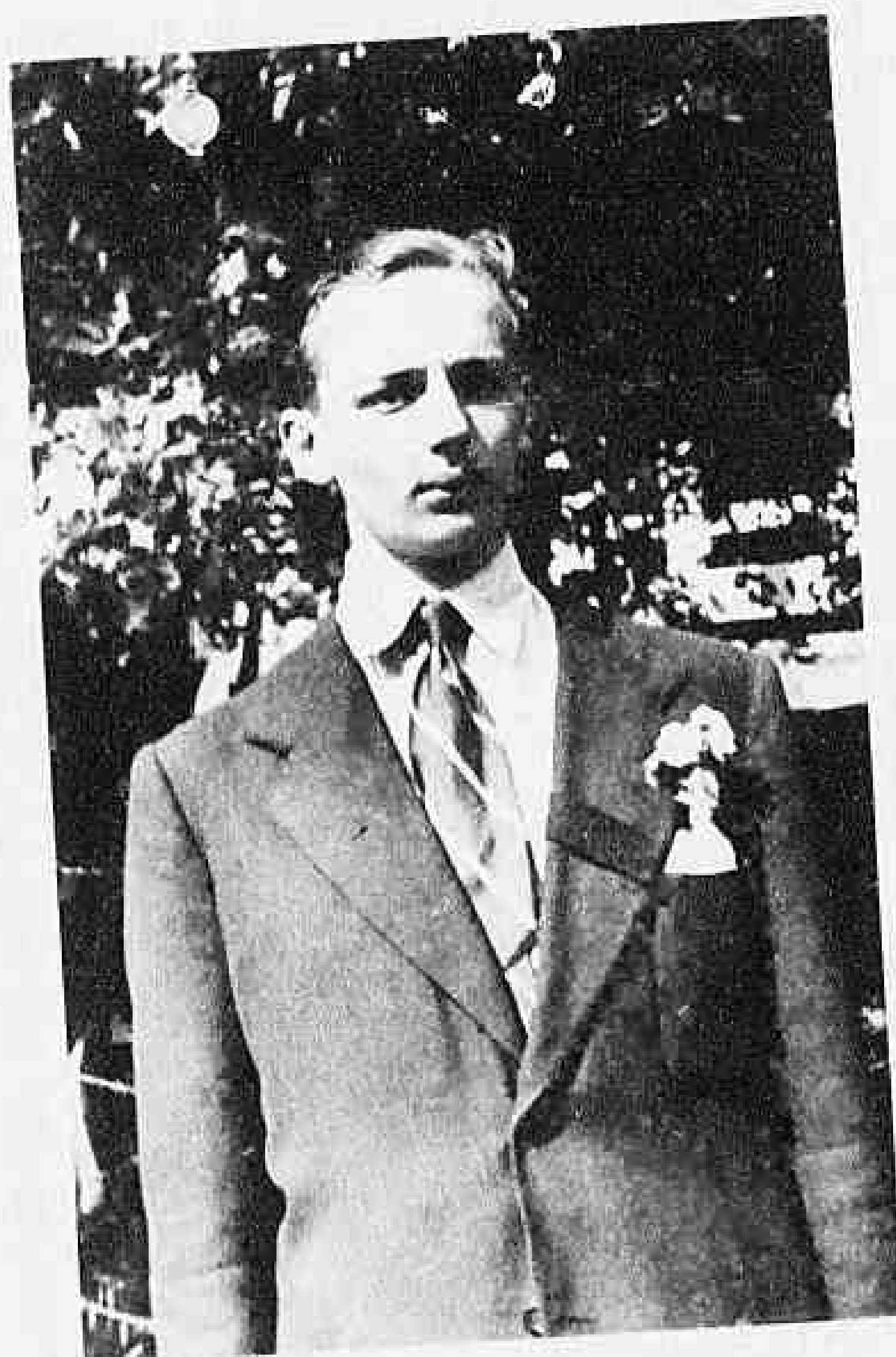

Reference your letter AG/4017/L dated 20 February 1946 enclosing translation of letter 163/46 dated 8 February 1946 asking for information regarding the penal case of Haanebeek Gerardo and others.

The following particulars are submitted as requested:

Haanebeek Gerardo, Dutch citizen was employed until 4th or 6th December 1945 by the Commerce Division, Liguria Region AMG in the capacity of Executive, one of the most highly paid posts open to civilians employed by W.D.

Basi Fabio, assistant Chief of ICE (Institute of Foreign Trade) organization in Genova.

Dt. Marchese Alessandro was Secretary (English speaking) to Major Myatt, Genova Province Supply Officer, AMG.

Boero Federico a paint manufacturer of Genoa.

Casali Dario, an agent paid by Boero for securing a release for oils used in the manufacture of paints.

There are two cases sub judice in both of which Haanebeek figures:

(1) Under suspicion of receiving a bribe from an Agent of Boero to secure the release of 12 tons of vegetable oils for the Boero paint factories.

(2) Under suspicion of promising in consideration of a bribe to secure the release of 450 tons molasses for Edoardo Boero.

Some time early in December 1945, on the 10th I think, the Secretary of the Comitato Olii e Grassi, Milano, came to see me at my office at the Headquarters of Liguria Region AMG where I was at the time Regional Industry and Commerce Officer, in order to

complain that releases of certain essential vegetable oils were being made in Genova on the authority of AMG whose competence in this matter was transferred to the above mentioned Comitato towards the end of September or beginning of October. I asked him for particulars and he produced copies of invoices from the firm of GASLINI for approx. 12 tons of different oils sold to Boero together with a copy of a letter dated 6 October 1945 from the firm of Boero addressed to Liguria Region H.Q. AMG, Commerce Division applying for release of the oils in question.

This copy of Boero's letter had two visas on it one from Genoa Chamber of Commerce or UPIC and the other from an AMG Officer. I telephoned the Gaslini Company and asked for the original of Boero's letter and studied it carefully on receipt of it. I could not remember having seen this letter before, it had not been registered in the Registry maintained by Commerce Division Liguria Region H.Q. and it bore the approval and visa of Major Myatt, former Supply Officer Genova Province AMG as well as a visa from Genoa UPIC.

I next called up the firm of Boero and in a short while Boero himself and his partner came to my office. Their story was that the letter had been handed by Boero to an Agent to take along to AMG for a visa and that in due course it was returned to him visaed.

He could not satisfactorily explain why he employed an Agent to do this, why he did not do it himself or send an employed with the letter, the agent he said was not available that day but he would bring him to my office the following day.

During the first interview with Boero the impression was gained that the matter had been carried out in an irregular fashion but there was nothing to indicate a criminal act and the Secretary of the Comitato Olli e Grassi was willing to regard the affair as an unfortunate intrusion by AMG on the powers assigned to him and was prepared to regularise the transaction by issuing the necessary official release order on his return to Milan.

On the following day Boero and his partner again came to see me bringing with them the agent he had employed, this agent said he in his turn had employed another agent and the letter was sent for and in the course of giving an explanation of the part he had played he mentioned paying a certain sum of money to obtain a visa. )

Where upon I passed the whole business over to Lt. Col. Hefford the Regional Public Safety Officer for further investigation. I later learnt from Col. Hefford that as a result of admissions made by Boero, he had taken into custody, Boero, the two agents, Basi, Marchese, Haanebeek and his secretary and that he had instructed the Guardia di Finanza to carry out an investigation in the matter.

The second case refers to an attempt to secure the release of 450 tons Molasses.

Some time in November Haanebeek brought in to me a letter from the firm Edoardo Bovio asking for authority to import into Genova from Emilia 450 tons Molasses brought from the Eridania Sugar Combine. The letter bore Major Wyatt's visas as well as a visa from the Genova Chamber of Commerce or UPIC and had been forwarded by my predecessor Col. Stephens to the Commerce Division of Lombardia Region of their approval.

Mr. L. RV White head of the Commerce Division of Lombardia Region AMG had replied that it was not a matter for Commerce but for the Food Authorities.

I asked Haanebeek why he had brought it into to me since it was no concern of Commerce and he replied to the effect that Eridania would not deliver the Molasses because they were selling their molasses on the black market and so were getting a higher price than that at which they had agreed to sell to Bovio and asked if I could not take some action to force Eridania to deliver to Bovio.

As I could not see what concern it was of Commerce Division I passed the letter to the Chamber of Commerce requesting an explanation of why they had put a visa on it. Some time later I received a reply from the Chamber of Commerce to the effect that as sugar was scarce in Genova if molasses could be brought in and distributed it would relieve the shortage of sweetening materials.

I then sent for the Eridania Manager and asked if they had sold molasses why they refused to deliver it, and received a reply to the effect that they had not sold any molasses and could not do so without a release from the appropriate Food Department in Milan.

I then sent for Bovio and asked him to explain, he said he had made the application to the Chamber of Commerce in the first place for a friend who was interested in getting hold of 450 tons Molasses and who was not a member of the Chamber of Commerce. I sent for this man and from the information given two other people had to be sent for the last of whom a man named Taranto who admitted that he was interested in the matter because he had been promised 450,000

lire if the permit were secured and that one third of this was to be paid to Haanebeek. On this admission I placed the matter in the hands of Col. Hefford, Regional Public Safety Officer who ordered the arrest of everyone involved and an investigation by Agents of the Guardia di Finanza.

With regard to the specific enquiries set out in the letter from the R. Tribunale di Genova to the best of my knowledge the information requested is as follows:

1) In October 1945 the Comitato Olii e Grassi, Milan was authorised to issue the permits for the release of vegetable and animal Oils, and the Food Officer in Milan for Molasses. I cannot recollect at what date these powers were transferred from AMG to the Industrial Committees but precise information can be obtained from Mr. L. VR White attached to Chief Liaison Officer, A.C., Milan.

2) Haanebeek was employed by Commerce Division, Headquarters Liguria Region, AMG.

Dt. Marchese was employed in the office of the Supply Officer, Genova Province, AMG.

3) Major Myatt left Genova Province for Trieste some time in November.

4) See 1 above.

5) This should be brought out in the evidence, Boero confessed to paying 400.000 lire to his Agents for securing a permit to buy 12 tons of Oils from Gaslini.

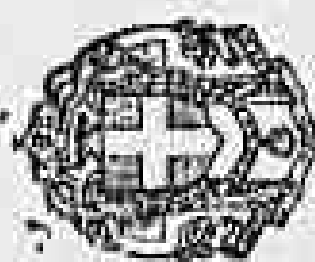

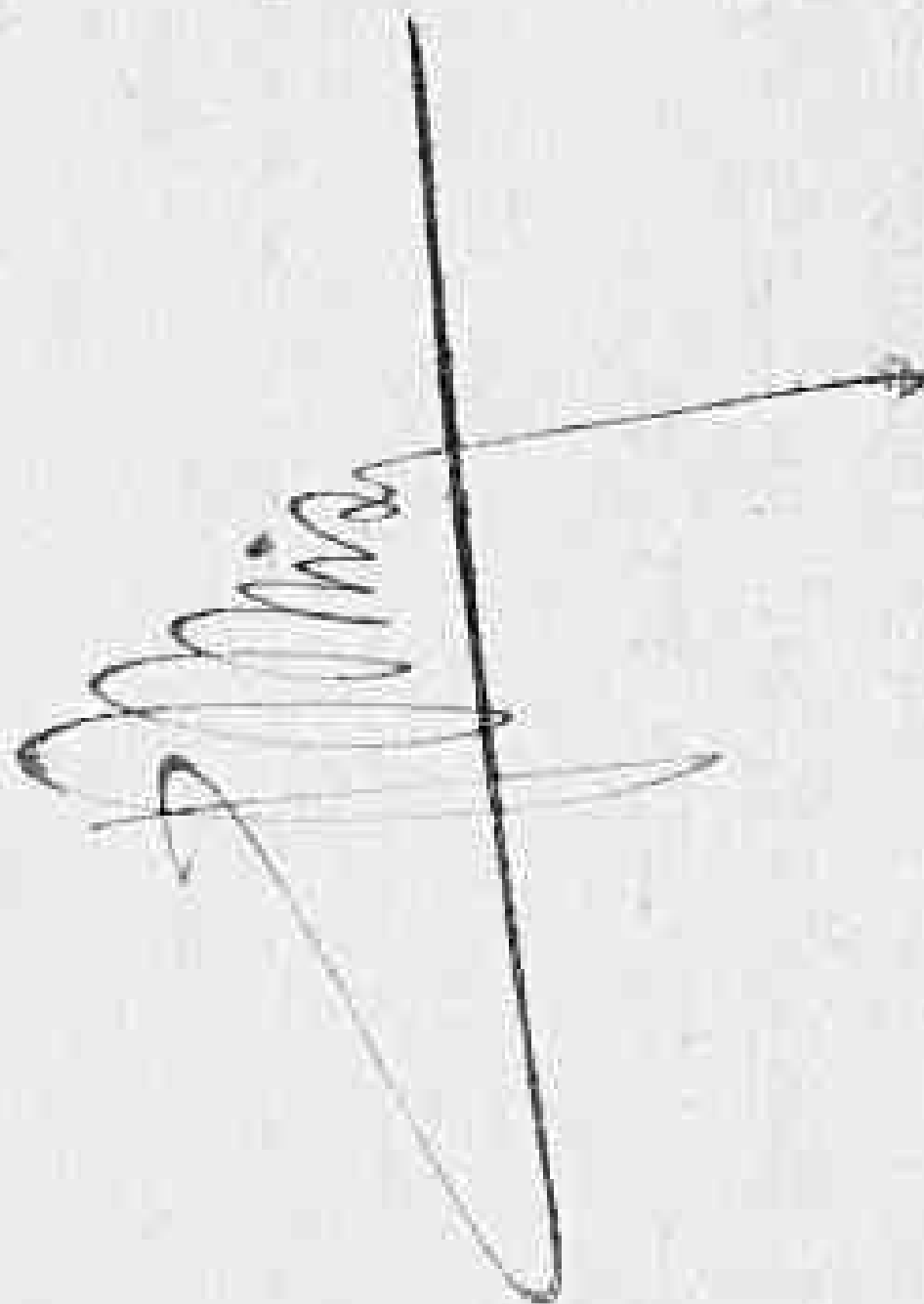
