SUBJECT : Assignments - Officers.

TO : Administrative Section.

1. The proposal submitted to me shows two legal officers for H.Q. Region 3 at Naples, three for Naples Commune and one for Bari.

2. On the basis of the situation as it obtains today, and is likely to obtain in the immediate future, there should be two legal officers at Region 3 H.Q. at Naples but with the Allied Military Courts still in session there, although their scope is being constantly reduced, it will be necessary to have five legal officers for use in the Naples Commune and also for Salerno for obvious reasons. With regard to the suggestion of having one legal officer at Bari I would propose to keep three officers there to deal with the genuine troubles which are constantly arising in connection with the sea-ports of Taranto, Brindisi and Bari and which arise in connection with the airfields at Foggia. I consider three the present minimum.

3. I am removing at this time four officers from Region 3 which will leave the seven above referred to. I think it likely that in the course of another month one or two more may be moved from Naples Commune but as a result of recent discussions there entered into with the Regional Legal Officer, Region 3 it seems plain that there can be no further reduction at the present moment.

SUBJECT : Legal Officers.

TO : Executive Officer.

1. This memorandum has been prepared with the object of summarizing a considerable number of requests recently put to the Establishment Branch concerning legal officers and of making clear our present position and future requirements.

2. General. There are, according to our records, 62 officers assigned as legal officers to Hq and regions as shown in the schedule attached. Of these, 2 (Col U. John and Col Grayman) are at present engaged on other duties, and 3 are ill for indefinite periods, leaving an effective strength of 57 officers as of today. Of these, 7 are at Hq and 50 in regions.

3. Legal Sub-Commission Hq. Is at present operating with 7 officers, as compared with its regular ceiling of 9.

4. Italian Government Territory (other than Region III).

a. Notwithstanding the virtual suspension of AMI Courts, the responsibilities of legal officers in this territory are numerous and varied and include supervision of all Italian judicial activities, with particular reference to anti-allied offences.

b. Particulars of legal officers assigned are as follows:

c. It is evident that so long as our present responsibilities remain, no reduction of staff is conceivable in this area.

5. Region I.

a. Italian Government Territory in this region now comprises four provinces (excluding Naples Comune) with a population of 2,807,272. One officer is at present assigned to each of the four provinces of Naples (at Caserta), Avellino, Benevento and Salerno. It is hoped that it may shortly be possible to release two of these officers for forward areas.

b. Naples Comune, which remains military government territory, is, as is well known, the source of more anti-allied offences than any other part of Italy; and so long as Naples remains our principal Mediterranean base port, there is small reason to anticipate improvement. Including the 4 officers mentioned in a above, but excluding Col Chapman now acting as IC, Region III, and Lt. Sabatino, whom I have asked to be transferred to RMG Region, Region III is now left with 11 officers. I am hoping shortly to be able to release a further two officers from this region.

6. RMG Region: Frosinone and Lattoria Provinces (Region IV).

a. These areas, at present military government territory, are due for restoration on 15/8/44.

b. Frosinone and Lattoria Provinces (Region IV) have at present one officer assigned to each. One of these should be available for release after restoration, about the end of August.

c. RMG Region has at present 6 legal officers available (including Lt. Sabatino). It is difficult to forecast what the requirements will be after restoration, but in view of the anticipated calls on Region IV staff (see para 7), and a large number of prospective spy trials, I am not now prepared to say that any RMG Region officers will be available for release at any early date.

7. Military Government Territory (not already dealt with above).a. Region IV. Present staff consists of:

- (i) RMO and DMO (as to whom see sub-para b below);
- (ii) PLOs Frosinone and Lattoria Provinces mentioned above (para. 6 b);
- (iii) 5 PLOs for the remaining 5 provinces.

b. RMO and DMO, Region IV, have been earmarked for Region 2; and it is intended that RMO, RMG Region, shall as from 1/8/44, take over responsibility for legal work in Region IV, retaining for that purpose his present staff and most of the other officers already in Region IV. Apart from the one officer to be released from restored territory (para. 6 b) above) it may be possible to administer the RMG Provinces with 4 officers instead of 5. Region IV and RMG Region combined may therefore be able to throw up 2 officers in all (apart from the RMO and DMO), and these I shall wish to have assigned to Region IV.

c. Region V. Apart from Campobasso Province, already restored, the whole of this region (which comprises 8 other provinces) remains UN territory. The recommendation of the SIO (with which I agree) is that the present strength of 9 officers will be an essential minimum. In my letter 4023/L of 29/7/44 I did ask Major Levit to be assigned from this region to go as SIO, Region IX; but that request had to be cancelled when another legal officer, Major Walsford, was hospitalized following a heart attack.

d. Region VIII has also 9 provinces, 6 of which are already wholly or partly occupied, and will require a minimum of 10 officers, as compared with the 8 so far assigned, though two officers not classified as legal (Capt. Miller and Hill) are performing legal services entirely at this time. I hope shortly to let you have my final recommendation as to legal personnel for this region.

e. 5th and 8th Armies have up to date each had one officer assigned to them, but it has been agreed that an economy in personnel can be achieved by returning these officers to regions, leaving the regions to supply army requirements as necessary. In my letter 4023/2/L of 29/7/44 I have already asked that Wing Commander Dickie, SIO, 5th Army should be assigned as SIO, Region IX and that Lt Col Mercer, SIO, 8th Army should be assigned to XII Region. My intention would be shortly to have Lt Col Mercer assigned to Region X.

8. Requirements for future regions.

a. Region IX, now in process of activation, has 8 provinces and should require 8 legal officers in addition to SIO. To date Wing Commander Dickie is the only officer earmarked and 6 more must be found, two of whom should be available from Region IV and probably four from Region III.

b. Region X. For either of regions I, II or XII, about 10 officers will be required. At present only 3 are earmarked. (See para 7 b and c).

c. Military government of Regions I, II and XII will necessitate at least 30 legal officers, but the following summary is prepared on the basis that Regions IX and X are the only new regions requiring immediate provision.

9. Summary of requirements.

a. From the foregoing it appears that requirements are as follows:

3. It is therefore essential for some 11 additional officers to be provided or earmarked for use when required.

10. Officers performing legal duties.

It comes to my knowledge from time to time that officers not assigned as legal officers are performing legal functions in regions. The Executive Officer has already agreed that Capt. Gilbreath, RME Region, shall be assigned as legal officer. Other examples are: Capt. W. J. Julisi in Region IV (see my letter 1023/2/L of 17/7/44); Lt. Scanlon, Region VI (see my letter 1023/2/L of 20/7/44); and Capt. M. H. Hill and Capt. Miller in Region VIII (see para 7 (d) above). I repeat the request, which has been made on many previous occasions, that all officers so employed should be definitely assigned as legal officers; as they are performing these functions why not actually give them the classification of legal officers so that this sub-commission may consider them as such for future planning?

11. Possible new Assignments.

Following are the names of officers with legal experience (some already with AGC) whom it is thought could be added to our legal strength. May it please be arranged for as many as possible of them to be assigned as legal officers:

a. Now with AGC but not carried as legal officers:

- (i) Maj Earl Garrett, now on other duties with RME Region;
- (ii) Maj P.E. Rayolds, under assignment to Region I (see my letter 1023/2/L of 20/7/44);
- (iii) Lt Gliberti, now with Region I;
- (iv) Maj Monk, now with Region V.

b. Not with AGC, but possibly available if transfer permitted:

- (i) Lt Col Lawton, who has been offered to Executive Commissioner by AGC HQ (see cable RMEC of 20/7/44);
- (ii) Lt O'Meara, whom the Executive Commissioner has recommended for legal duties with AGC (see his letter 1002/21/EC to me of 5/7/44);
- (iii) Maj V. Lupton, JAG, U.S. Claims Commission, RMEC;

- ✓ (iv) Maj E. M. Clasky, AUS, Specialist Reserve with CBS, Coastal Base Section, Naples;
- (v) Lt. J. L. Barnes, MACC, at present with Hq AAI Ordnance Branch whom I understand Brigadier Crawford (his CO) is willing to consider for attachment or transfer to AOC;
- ✓ (vi) Lt. M. A. Miller, 6689th Signal Hon. Co. APO 464, whose transfer to AOC would have to be arranged through 9th Personnel Center.

12. As regards the 300 additional British officers who it is understood are to be added to APO strength, I would like to have the opportunity of considering qualifications of any officers with legal experience. If there are not sufficient qualified legal officers among them, may it please be arranged for them to replace officers with legal experience now serving as JAGs or on other duties with AOC, and for the latter officers to be assigned as legal officers?

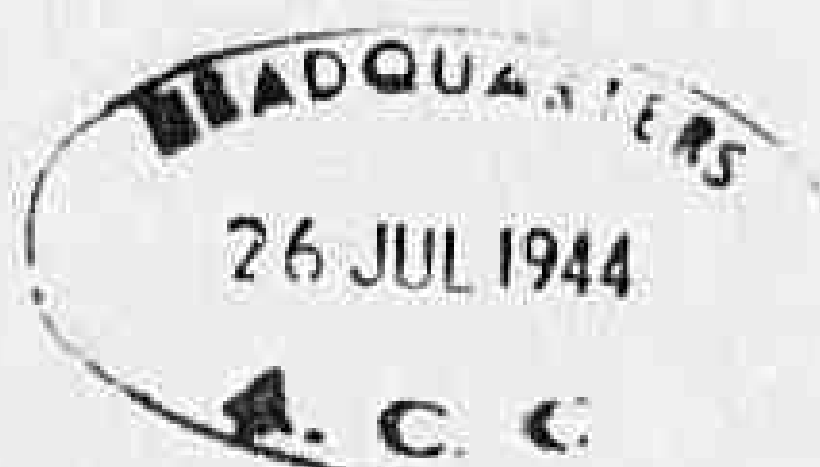

1. Lieut. Sebastino has completed his prosecution of an important case in Rome and should by now be on his way back to your headquarters. I am given to understand that he performed his services in an excellent manner in the prosecution of this case and to the satisfaction of everyone concerned. This was particularly important as the case had great local significance and the court was crowded at all times with local inhabitants--as much as 400 or 500 of them.

2. Because of the fact that the legal officer who had been doing prosecuting work here was ordered to return to the U.K., Lieut. Sebastino's services were urgently required for this one case. At the present time there is ⁸² no prosecuting officer in Rome Region to appear before Superior Courts. As you will have noted in the recent press announcement, it is expected that this region will be turned back to the Italian Government administration on 15 August. It is, of course, important that as far as it is possible, pending cases be completed at that time, although of course, any not completed then can be completed after the restoration date. I am wondering whether it is possible for you to lend to Rome Region a prosecuting officer for the intervening period up to August 15th. I know what your own situation is in a general way and I will leave it to your own judgment as to whether or not you can furnish an officer. I will not require it but would like to have one if possible.

1. In reply to your ACC/4023/2/L of 15 July I consider that Major LEVIT is fully capable of performing the duties of D.R.L.C. As you know I have recommended him for promotion.
2. I had arranged on the hand-over of FOGGIA Province to move Major LEVIT to another part of the Region. We shall still have 8 provinces (or 9 if we keep CAMPOBASSO) and only 9 legal officers in all including Major LEVIT.
3. At the moment CHIETI is working at very full pressure: AQUILA is fully occupied: PESCARA, TERAMO and ASCOLI do not look like being busy. MACERATA and ANCONA are not under Regional control although out officers are used there.
4. It is impossible to say how much work there will be in ANCONA but I shall be agreeably surprised if it can be run with less than 2 legal officers particularly if the port can be put into operation at an early date. I had intended to put Major LEVIT in charge of ANCONA and PESARO Provinces with one or two others to help him.
5. I have had to give Major BOYD CARPENTER to FOGGIA Province and I feel that it will be very difficult to run the rest of the Region (even excluding CAMPOBASSO) on less than a minimum of 9 Officers. Thus

6. I would point out that when the allotment of legal officers was originally made at the R.L.C.'s meeting I pitched my demands as low as possible, and I only limited my claim to 10 officers on the basis that we should never in fact have 10 provinces in operation at once. It now appears that we shall have 8 or 9 actually in operation and I have lost one officer for the one province I have given up.

7. I do not wish to stand in the way of Major LEVIT and do not oppose his transfer to a new region but I appeal with all the force at my command for a replacement.

8. I have in fact here at the moment Major P.E. REYNOLDS. He is an experienced Canadian barrister. He has recently come from a fighting unit into A.C.C. and he is officially recorded as "surplus to establishment". He is attached to Region 5 being assigned as C.A.O. to Region 9. I regard this as a complete waste of a valuable officer and I would request that if you take Major LEVIT you use all your efforts to replace him, preferably by Major REYNOLDS.

1. I desire to have assigned as quickly as possible to Region IX, Major W. R. Levit (A) now in Region V. Colonel Mehrens, MIO, Region V, states that he is willing to release Major Levit to be MIO, Region IX if a replacement can be sent. It is, of course, impossible to send any replacements to Region V as no legal officers are yet assigned to Region IX and it is essential that this be done as quickly as possible for obvious reasons.

2. The MIO, Region V, also asks that Major P. E. Reynolds, a Canadian barrister who recently joined Region V, as surplus to the establishment, be retained by him as a legal officer. It appears that Major Reynolds, who has been performing the duties of a legal officer in Region V, is under assignment to Region IX as a CIO. If Major Reynolds is assigned to Region IX, I request that he be assigned as a legal officer to meet the immediate emergency.

3. I have been advised by your office that Lt. Sengdon, now in Region VI, while not assigned as legal officer, has nevertheless, been doing legal work. It seems to me that if officers are performing specialist services they can best be utilized if they are assigned as specialists. If Lt. Sengdon is so designated I have no present intention of moving him, but it would give the sub-commission one more legal officer to use in the case of emergency.

4. Relative to an arbitrary ceiling of 61, it will be recalled that that ceiling was established for a certain military line while all of Region IX and parts of Regions V and VIII lie above such line.

1. I request that Capt. Gilreath, Rome Region, and Capt. Julini, Region IX, be definitely classified as legal officers. Capt. Gilreath is a lawyer and teacher of law in civilian life. At present he is engaged solely in dealing with legal matters in his region. The HQ, Rome Region, has advised me that if requested by you he will agree to this shift. Capt. Julini has been doing solely the work of a provincial legal officer in Region IV for some time.

2. With reference to my letter to you, ACC/4023/2/L dated 16 July 44 concerning Capt. Joseph F. Levy now in the Transportation Section of Rome Region, the HQ, Rome Region advised me that he is quite agreeable to having Capt. Levy assigned as a legal officer so long as he can be left in his present position for two weeks more. I request that you secure such consent direct and then make the assignment suggested in the above letter, subject to Capt. Levy not being moved for two weeks time.

3. I have to build up the legal side of Region IX. At the present time there is not one officer who can be assigned to that region although I am working on plans and am selecting legal officers. 1. It is necessary that a S.L.O. for Region 9 be designated at an early date. In going over the list of legal officers who might properly fill such position, I have come to the conclusion that Wing Commander HESTER (S), now S.L.O. 5th Army, should be so designated. He was S.L.O. Region 1 before becoming S.L.O. 5th Army. I regard him as one of the outstanding legal officers from the standpoint of ability and experience and feel that with the limited number of legal officers who will be available to new regions it will be particularly necessary to have the best available officers as S.L.Os for these regions.

2. It has been reported to me that neither the S.L.O. 9th Army nor Lt.Col. Meyer (A) S.L.O. 8th Army have sufficient legal matters to occupy anywhere near their full time. In order to conserve legal personnel I seriously suggest that there be one S.L.O. for both armies and that he be attached to Advance Headquarters A.A.I. so that he can perform the present duties of the S.L.Os of the two armies. If this can be worked out, Wing Commander HESTER assigned as S.L.O. Region 9, it would still leave an experienced legal officer, Lt.Col. Mercer, to carry on the work for both armies, which he can do adequately.

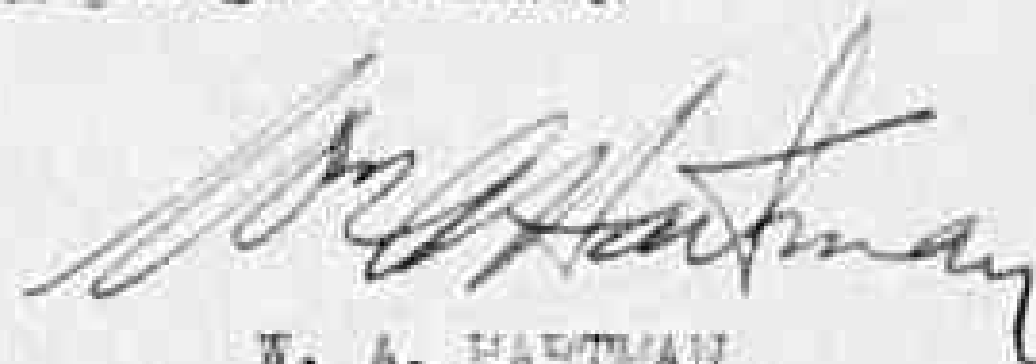
1. It is hereby requested that a qualified legal officer be attached temporarily to this Sub-Commission for the next 30 or 60 days for full time work in connection with enforcement phases of amassing law and decree.

2. This Sub-Commission has assigned Major J. G. Sutherland to assume immediate responsibility for riding hard on a full time basis throughout occupied Italy on all aspects of amassing program. One of the several limiting factors to make this program as successful as possible is involved in legal and enforcement aspects. Numerous suggestions have already been documented and others continue to reach this Sub-Commission with particular reference to legal and enforcement phases of the program. Although all of these suggestions will be typed, mimeographed, and distributed to proper Allied officers throughout occupied Italy, we are sadly in need of a legal officer to work directly with Major Sutherland with specific reference to legal enforcement items.

3. A survey of existing laws and penalties in connection with production and distribution of food products revealed that penalties extended from ^{to} ordinary fines to the death penalties but that the laws are full of loop holes and consequently worthless unless we succeed in ^{getting} Prefects and others to establish court and other procedures commensurate with the importance and peculiarities of the different areas respectively represented.

4. Our tentative conclusion is that we do not need new legal regulatory legislation covering all of Italy but that we do need to make practical interpretation of the law and secure enforcement of such interpretations through local directives signed by proper local Italian authorities and/or AMB officers.

5. It is hereby requested that you approve this request and expedite assignment of legal officer for work directly with Major Sutherland.
