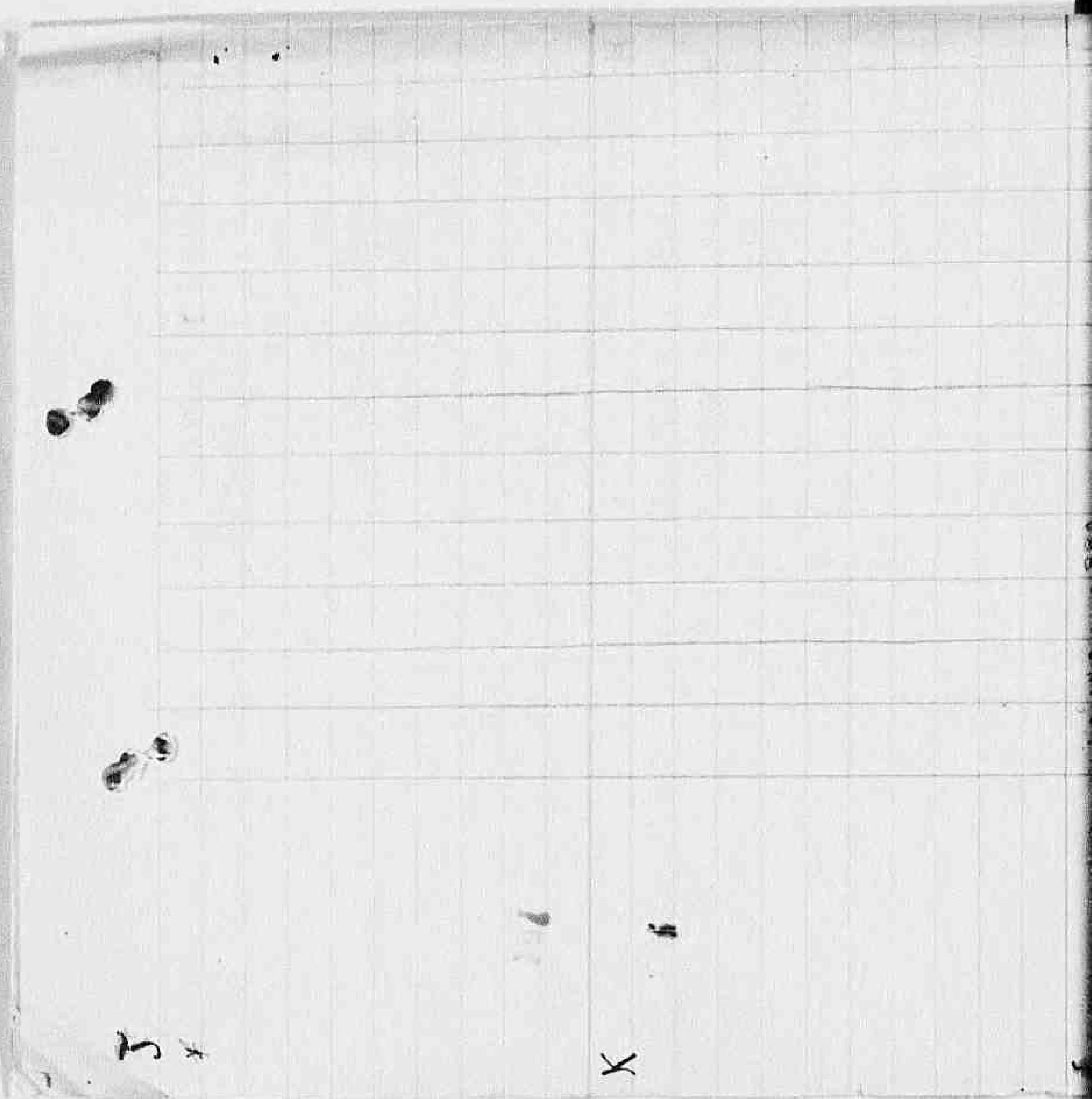

Thank you for your letter of the 3rd November.

I am extremely sorry to find that you have no work to do. Unfortunately there are many others in the same situation and at the moment it is a difficult question to solve. I am thinking of having an S.I.C. meeting at the end of the month and one of the problems which might well be discussed is the future employment of legal officers if the lines remain static during the winter.

However, for the moment I am engaged in establishing military courts in Bari and for that purpose I am taking Lipton, Cotes-Freedy, Bates and Aulisi on temporary attachment from your region. I have spoken to Brigadier Dunlop who agrees.

As far as your own personal proposition is concerned I doubt whether we could find useful employment even here at the moment. Everything is much quieter here than it has been for months and Ian Campbell is only working at half pressure. However I have written to Brigadier Carr and suggested to him that he might like you to make a survey of the Italian Courts in Sicily. Things are not too happy there and Matthews being the only legal officer on the island has not got time to get about. I will let you know Carr's reply when I get it.

Apart from any definite attachment to this HQ why do you not come to Rome for a few days leave. We should be very happy to put you up in the villa and could see whether any arrangements can be made in the future.

1. Reference is made to letter 22nd Oct 44, HQ Abruzzi-Marche Region, and letter 26th Oct 44, HQ Lombardia Region, both directed to you.

2. This Region strongly objects to the request of Abruzzi-Marche that the above officer be detached from Emilia Region and attached to that Region.

3. The facts recited in the letter from Abruzzi-Marche Region are incorrect in two respects:

a. This officer has never been detached from Emilia Region. He was assigned as P.L.O. of Ferrara Province, and when that province took up its headquarters at Fano, was temporarily loaned to Pesaro Province pending the need for his services in Emilia.

b. Major Clasky is not a "replacement" for Major Reynolds, but is merely a legal officer new to A.C.C. who was temporarily assigned to Ferrara Province under Major Reynolds, to acquire experience pending permanent assignment as a P.L.O. in Emilia.

4. Substantial portions of Emilia have now been occupied, and all legal officers assigned or attached to the Region are urgently required. Eighth Army AMG is calling Major Reynolds forward for service in the Region, replacing him with a Region Venezia officer in accordance with the normal program and policy.

5. Occasion is again taken to point out that efforts of this kind to retain permanently officers temporarily loaned by other Regions, particularly without any contact with the lender, tend to weaken confidence in all loaning arrangements, and impair the morale and operational efficiency of all concerned.

Your note concerning Major Setton was received. I will be very glad to have this excellent officer join us. In view of his background, I plan to place him in charge of Italian Courts, so long as he stays with us.

We now have Headquarters at Saltino (5th Army area) and Riccione (8th Army area), and my jeep and I have been shuttling back and forth between the two Headquarters. We now have some 15 communes in Forlì Province, and Major Gilchman is busy getting Summary Courts functioning in a manner compatible with the high standards of AOC military justice.

I relieved Judge Laccisotti from Foggia last week, over the rather vociferous protests of Major Rolfe, PLC. His main objection seemed to be that the loss of Laccisotti would leave him without an interpreter or anyone familiar with his office files. Since the Judge was not assigned to Foggia for either purpose, and since the Minister of Justice had ordered his transfer to Emilia Region, I felt justified in taking him with me.

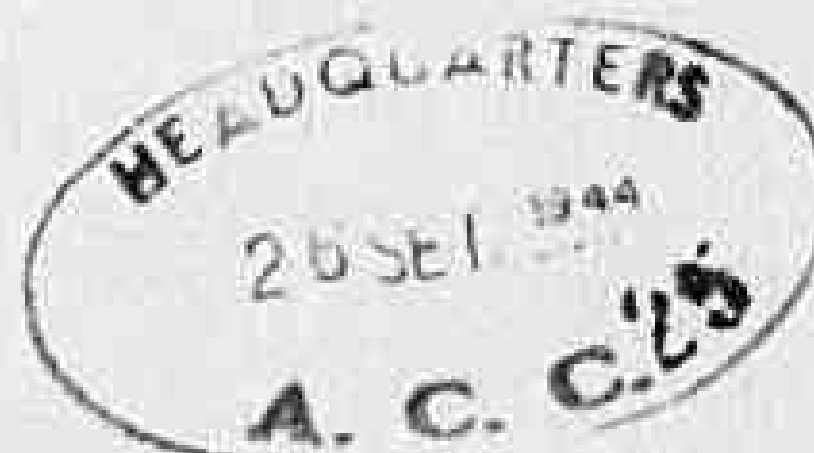

Major Alexander has talked with Brigadier Upjohn and myself concerning two matters - (1) that ~~he~~ is doing Public Safety as well as Legal work in Region 6 and (2) the possibility of his being assigned elsewhere as a legal officer.

It is the definite feeling of both Brigadier Upjohn and myself that a legal officer should not endeavour to combine with his legal duties those of a Public Safety officer even though he might have time to perform both duties, for the reason that Public Safety is a matter of training which requires certain skill and knowledge which legal officers as a rule do not possess. For instance if there was a riot an average legal officer would not have the faintest idea what to do until there had been an arrest made and then he could go to the local courts and arrange for a trial and so forth. 21

As to the second item, we are extremely short of legal officers to man the northern regions. I would appreciate it very much if Major Alexander could be released from Region 6 after October 15 and that Lieut. Scanlan be made Regional Legal Officer in Major Alexander's place, in addition to his other duties as Company Commander which do not appear to be onerous. Lieut. Scanlan has worked with Major Alexander for so long a period as to be familiar with the various legal problems which are likely to come up in your Region. I would appreciate a word from you that you agree to this. If so I will arrange with G-1 (A) as to conferring the necessary additional title upon Lieut. Scanlan.
