I feel that recent correspondence between us has tended, most unfortunately, to become acrimonious. I have no intention, on my part at least, that this should continue.

However, for the purposes of record, I must reply to your L-1030 of 14 Feb 1945 on the subject of the Bari courts.

The remarks of which you and Boyd-Carpenter complain were (with the exception of the words "and possibly should") made officially by Brig. Dunlop to the Chief Commissioner in the presence of myself and Brig. Upjohn. Brig. Upjohn agrees with my recollection of what was said.

No criticism of anyone was intended by the addition of the words "and possibly should."

It is true that I also discussed the question with certain other officers with more immediate knowledge than Brig. Dunlop. They certainly confirmed the view expressed by him.

I have no wish or intention to pursue this matter further, but I feel that in the circumstances the remarks were perfectly justified.

1. It is requested that the following personnel be made available for the Legal Sub-Commission:

a. Capt. E. R. LEBURY (B).

This officer is a solicitor of many years experience. He has had practice in criminal courts in England and has held several military courts in Italy. He would be most useful for the Legal Sub-Commission. He was posted by the War Office to Civil Affairs, Legal; he was originally assigned for work with the Legal Sub-Commission; for some reason which is not entirely clear to this sub-commission, he was deflected from the path of virtue into the coils of Food and Supply. May he please be returned to his proper station. He is now in Abruzzi-Marche Region.

b. Lt. J. J. Scanlan (B).

This officer is now in Sardegna where he combines admirably the functions of Regional Officer of the Region as well as those of Company Commander of the American Contingent. In view of the proposed changes in organization, it would appear that fewer company commanders are likely to be required for the American troops whereas it is well known that the number of legal officers required has increased. Moreover, it can be pointed out to G-1 American that they have undertaken to provide a substitute for Lt Col CHES who they have insisted on withdrawing on the Legal Sub-Commission. It is therefore suggested that they might profitably assign Lt. SCANLAN to legal work.

2. It is requested that Lt. F. B. LEAHING (B) be assigned to Venetia Region and attached on temporary duty to Abruzzi-Marche Region.

3. Strenuous complaint has been received from Lombardia Region of the allocation of 14 legal officers to that region. COLA previously stated that 16 officers were necessary for Lombardia and does not now retract from that view. At the same time the agreement made between COT and Lombardia planning representative was for 14 officers and that a number of officers have not been assigned. It should be pointed out that in none of the

Northern Regions is the number of officers really adequate for the work in hand and it is not possible at this moment to provide additional strength to Lombardis Region. If and when the number of legal officers allocated to the Legal Sub-Commission is really sufficient for the work in hand, extra officers should be assigned to Lombardis Region.

1. A very strongly worded letter has been received from P.C. Ancona stating that Capt. Boone, who is still without full-time assistance in that Province, is tired and overworked. Furthermore it is stated that this Officer's A.M. Court work leaves him too little time to attend to general advisory duties. Whilst no such complaint has ever been received from Capt. Boone personally and whilst, indeed, he went out of his way to assure me in writing a month ago that he was not overworked I have always considered that he was most definitely in need of assistance. Major Carlake has been giving him some part-time assistance recently but owing to the distance between Ancona and Ascoli and to transportation and other difficulties this arrangement has not proved very satisfactory.

2. There is still no sign of Major Cotter - Freedy and I feel it is really necessary that something should be done. It occurs to me that Col. Willmer might be in a position to lend the full-time services of an officer. If so and if he is willing to do so have I your authority to arrange with him accordingly? Failing this is it possible for (a) Major Cotter-Freedy's immediate return to be ensured or (b) a temporary loan of an officer to be made from some Region other than Region XII?

1. Ref your AC/4023/2/L received on my return to this HQ. today may I suggest that Major Backhouse's recall to Piemonte Region be deferred if possible for some weeks?

2. On my recent visit to Pesaro I found that this officer although on duty and not technically 'sick' had not been well for the last week or two and I concluded, in agreement with the P.C., that it was desirable he should be relieved at Pesaro by another officer and brought to Aquila or Ascoli for a time where working conditions are not so trying.

3. It is important that there should be an experienced P.L.O. at Pesaro. Major Cotes-Preedy has not yet returned from Southern Region and in any event will probably require to assist Capt. Boone at Ancona where 2 officers are essential. It has been decided to send Lt. Col. Cohen to Pesaro in exchange for Major Backhouse. Major Glerum (A) at present P.L.O. Chieti will accompany Lt. Col. Cohen so as to obtain instructions in AMG work which he has not yet had.

4. If Major Backhouse is to go at short notice it will not be possible to find an experienced substitute to take over supervision of the Abruzzi Courts and train Major DERHAM on his arrival sufficiently to enable him to carry on when left alone. Major Carslake is at present dividing his time between Ascoli and Ancona in order to relieve the pressure on Capt. Boone during Major Cotes-Preedy's absence.

Dear Major Welsford,

Thanks very much for yesterday's letter - which, as you can see, reached me in almost record time. It was handed to me as I opened my first eye this morning - and when I saw the envelope I knew it must be from you. Naturally - I wasn't in time to make today's courier - so Col Robertson has most kindly consented to deliver it in person.

My answer to the offer of the position in Rome is a most emphatic affirmative. I hope that it does turn out. However, if the work has been assigned to some one else, I would appreciate it very much if you would convey to Colonel Beckhrens - my willingness to accept some other work of a legal nature. I agree with you that the experience I'd get - as well as the interest - is well worth while. You spoke truly when you said "messing about." It appears that such will be my future unless something turns up.

Our stay at Viareggio lasted for exactly

ten days after you left. We were quite comfortable at 'our house' until they started shelling. Not heavy - but every night for a while. It was considered too dangerous - inasmuch as we were not busy. So on Friday - 24 Nov - we left for Lucca - we stayed at the hotel for about a week and then moved into a grandiose apartment - formerly the home of a Fascist Advocate who according to reports is north of the German lines. My job, as I mentioned before, will be to take care of the mess - for the three officers - and five O.N.s. Our Italians have left us - so I shall have to find me some others to help me with my Italian. Und wie geht's ohne Deutsch. Gut, ich hoffe. Als (wenn) ich ~~nicht~~ richtig geschrieben habe - schicken Sie mir Ihre Beantwortung.

Thanks again for your assistance. How about your job - I hope you're enjoying it. If I don't see or hear from you before - I'll wish you a Merry Christmas - to which there are only 18 more shopping days. Keep well

2. Whilst my letter to which yours is a reply was not intended to convey that another officer in addition to Major Coates-Preedy was necessary there is no doubt that an additional officer could be usefully employed.
3. In a recent conversation with P.L.O. Pesaro he informed me that there is only one Police Officer in that Province and that an extra legal officer could be of great assistance to him in prosecuting as well as in taking occasional Courts. The number of cases in Pesaro Province is small compared with Ancona Province but communications are exceedingly bad, as you are no doubt aware, and a great deal of time is wasted in travelling.
4. If, therefore, you have a spare officer who could be attached to P.L.O. Pesaro there is no doubt that he would gain useful experience and would certainly not be wasting his time. I would suggest a younger man for long walks are sometimes part of the job.
