1. For reasons entirely beyond the control of this Sub-Commission Major E. L. Palmieri now acting as Chief Counsel is to be withdrawn from the Sub-Commission. It is obviously essential that he should be replaced by an officer of rank and experience. The office is an American appointment and owing to the limited number of American officers at Headquarters of the Legal Division it is most desirable that he should be replaced by an American officer.

2. I am selecting Major A. P. Nugent of Lombardia Region to fill this vacancy.

3. Wing Commander Dickie, Regional Legal Officer, Lombardia Region, while recognizing the necessity for this selection points out that the loss is a severe loss to him more particularly as Major F. G. Bader is seriously ill and will have to return to the U.S.A.

4. Wing Commander Dickie has asked that in these circumstances you might be willing to let him have either Major E. K. Matthews or Major D. D. McCain to make up for these losses which seriously reduce his legal talent of field rank.

Dear Bill,

I hear that fighting has flared up again on the "personnel" front, so you had better know that Rader has gone into hospital here with suspected bleeding ulcers. He has not been told what is the matter and the medics won't be sure until they can take X-Ray photos in four or five days time, but if the diagnosis is correct, it will mean a trip home. Even if things are not as bad as they think, he is likely to be away for some time.

I have regarded him all along as one of the main props of the Lombardia team and am very much concerned at the prospect of losing him. If he does go, I hope you will be able to give me some experienced officer in his place. Cox for example, or Mathews. The Milan area is going to produce a lot more headaches than Mercer's Mountains ever will, and our numbers are already short enough, so that if the lists are to be revised, I don't want claims to go by default.

Hancock phoned today that 15th Army Group require a Lombardia Legal Officer sent at once for liaison duties with IV Corps. What he will do there, goodness only knows but I suggested either Carlslake or Vogel, as they are both earmarked for the Milan area and can presumably be more easily spared from their present assignments than any of the officers now working in Toscana Region. I trust this has your approval.

✓ Oates tells me that his services are needed for Courts at Pesaro, but no orders have yet come from his region recalling him. He is clearing up some of his outstanding cases here and will be ready to move at the end of the week.

When deciding how overstuffed this area is, please bear in mind that three officers (Troxell, Delbridge and Fielding) are now occupied fulltime in handling olive oil transgressors throughout the Province under the direct orders of Major Glenn and are not available for any work in Florence. Two General Court cases a week as well as the ordinary stuff keep the others busy.

What is happening about that Financial Order and Directive you were preparing when I was last in Rome? Incidentally the old topic of how Orders should be signed is rearing its ugly head again and a pronouncement by my General is expected shortly. The attached Schedule does indicate a certain confusion and the authority of Noel Mason MacFarlane in Sondrio is to say the least questionable.

Hope to see you again soon

I am, as you know, desperately short of officers but I might be able to manage a replacement if that really becomes necessary. I have in mind Capt. Falk, who will probably be promoted to Major very shortly, and who is a most reliable and experienced officer quite apart from being a member of the Superior Branch of the profession.

I do not know how much work Carslake or Vogel ^{is} ~~are~~ doing at the present time; I believe that Carslake is occupied but they have sufficient officers in Abruzzi-Marche to make him available. I have no doubt that Vogel will be available in a few days although he may be sitting on a General Court at Bari at the moment.

I observe that your region is reasonably busy but I have sent out Lt. Johnson and Major Keyseil in the last few days and I am also sending up Miller very shortly so that you should be able to manage without difficulty.

With reference to financial orders, I have been having ^{diff} ~~diff~~ rows with Labor about ~~it~~ and I succeeded last week in persuading Mr. MacMillan to issue a peremptory order to Labor to make their mind up about policy. I hope therefore that within a few days the matter will become what, I believe, is known as finalized.

1. For your information I have requested the Regional Commissioner to recall Major Oates and Major Aulisi to this Headquarters forthwith. You will of course remember that these two officers are at present temporarily attached, the former to AMG 5th Army, the latter to Southern Region, subject to recall at 48 hours notice by the Regional Commissioner of this Region. Such notice is now being given.

2. The reasons for this action are as follows. I have been in consultation with Lt. Col. LEVIT, who informs me that in 8th Army Area there are pending a considerable number of trials of alleged spies. In order to avoid getting into arrears, and so as not to leave a legacy of uncompleted cases in the event of the army advancing, it is proposed that the General Military Court appointed to try cases in 8th Army Area be enlarged by the inclusion of additional officers, so as to make it possible for two courts to sit at once. The proposed additional officers include Major Oates and Major Aulisi. It is intended that as soon as they arrive here they shall be attached by order of the Regional Commissioner to AMG 8th Army.

3. I selected these two officers to offer to Lt. Col. Levit for service with AMG 8th Army for two reasons.
