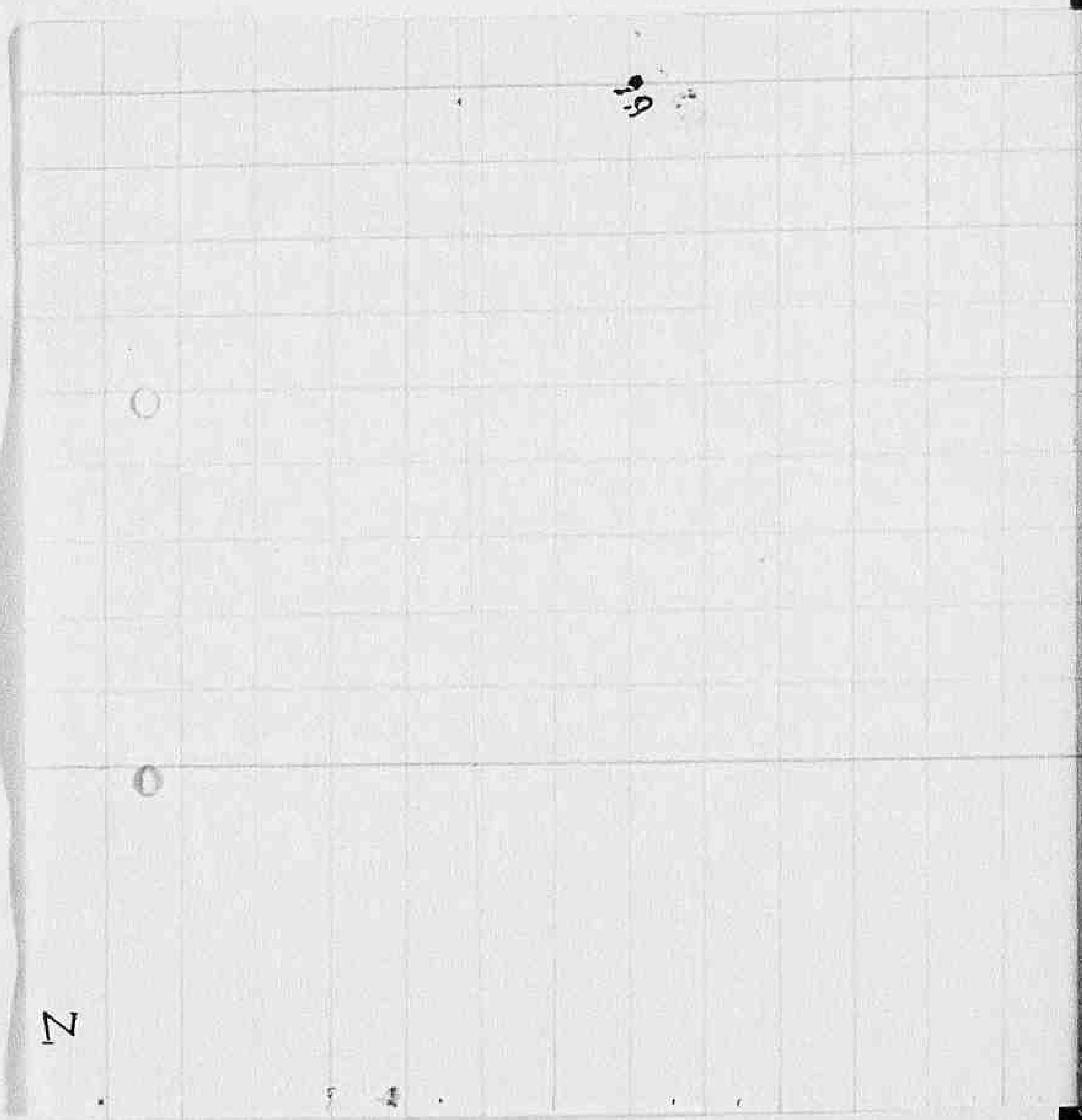

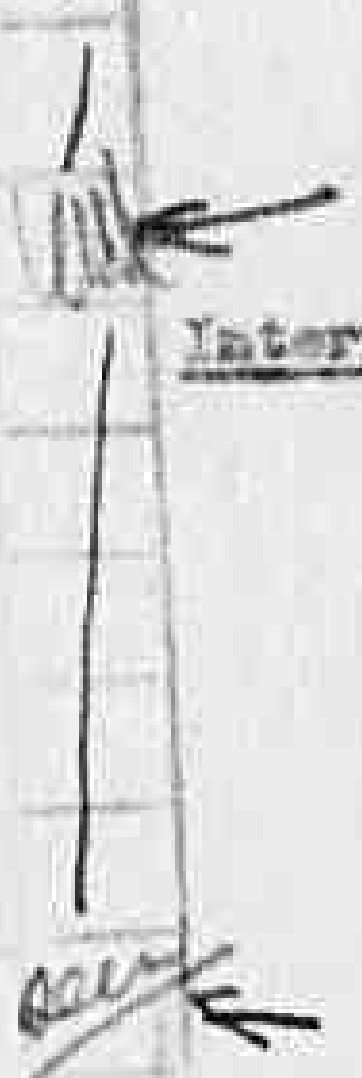

Dear Behrens,

I have heard from Dickie that he declines to consent to the exchange of Balboni for Gaziano. Meanwhile Gaziano has arrived here. After speaking to him I find that he is quite happy to serve in Venezia Region provided he is not sent to Trieste. That was what he was afraid of when he made his application. I am happily able to do the necessary re-shuffle to meet his wishes, so that he will not have to go to Trieste. To replace him in the Trieste party I have to-day wired, on the R.C.'s instructions, to G-1, H.Q., A.C., requesting that Major Gold (who has already been assigned to the Region, but has not yet reported) be sent direct to join Group "D", Venezia Region, at Lucera, which is the Trieste party.

In the circumstances I think everybody is happy, and so far as I am concerned the matter is dead and buried.

I am not without hope that I may be setting foot in my Region in the course of a few days. If so, I shall do my best to keep you in touch with what I am doing. Unhappily I may find myself rather pressed, because for the time being, in addition to being a legal officer, I find myself also acting as Deputy Regional Commissioner - quite a wearing job when there are moves on foot. I sincerely trust that this situation will not last long, as I shall certainly not be able to do my legal job properly if it does.

I hope you will be one of the first of my guests in Venezia. You will always be welcome.

I have a high opinion of Gaziano, and shall be sorry to lose him. but to meet his wishes I am prepared, if Dickie is also agreeable, to take Balboni in exchange. I have had a word with Lt. Col. Orpwood, P.C. of Trieste, who knows Balboni, saw his work in Bari, and would like to have him as a legal Officer. I do not know Balboni myself, but your recommendation, backed by Orpwood's, is enough for me.

If there is any difficulty about Balboni I would, as a further alternative, be prepared to accept Sabatino, whom I know - but it might be difficult to persuade Piedmonte to disgorge him!

Whoever is selected, I do ask most earnestly that he should report immediately. In order to save time, I should like you to have him dispatched ~~direct~~ to Group "D", Venezia Region, at Lucera, where he should report to Lt. Col. 2. Your statement about losing four officers is not clear. I did not accept your kind offer of Major MCCORM, and you voluntarily accepted an exchange of Major COX for Major PARLIN. So far as I can discern the only officer you have actually lost is Major DREYFUS and I am sending you Captain MORE as a replacement.

3. My personal opinion is that Captain MORE is better suited for your requirements and will certainly work harder than Major DREYFUS.

4. From reports I hear of Major MCCORM he should be qualified and competent to act as your Deputy Regional Legal Officer. Most of your other officers are of the highest quality available to this Sub-Commission and I may say that I was particularly impressed with Lt. KNAPP, the new officer I sent you.

As Campbell told you, Gaziano has been working at this Hq and is leaving very shortly for Venezia.

Gaziano has been in to see me with a personal request that he be transferred to Lombardia Region. His reason is that he has a wife in Italy who is expecting a baby by the end of July. Gaziano feels that by that time there might be some chance of her joining him in Lombardia Region where there obviously would be none in Venezia.

I am making no recommendation in this case which I am forwarding to you for your decision simply because Gaziano has asked me to do so. Gaziano is a capable officer who speaks fluent Italian and has considerable knowledge of Italian Courts. I will suggest, if Dickie is willing, that he might be prepared to give you Lt. F. H. Balboni in exchange. He also speaks fluent Italian and has had experience of AMB Court work in Bari where he did very well. I do not know whether he has the same experience of Italian Courts as Gaziano.

As I said, I am making no recommendation in this case because you are only too aware of the difficulties which I have had over personnel. At the same time, I can appreciate Gaziano's personal point of view and if the exchange could be arranged to the satisfaction of all parties concerned, I am not prepared to stand in the way.

I am sending a copy of this letter to Dickie and if both he and you are willing to make the exchange and will let me know, I will get the necessary orders issued. If I do not hear from you I shall assume that you do not wish to take any action and I shall leave matters where they are.
