1. Reference our AC/4023/2/L, of 24 August 1945 and your 136/EST of 4 September in reply thereto.

2. The matter in issue is not the appointment of a "Chief Judicial Officer" but the delegation by the Chief Commissioner to a Judicial Officer not below the rank of Lt. Col the power to review certain cases. Attention is drawn to Article 32, paragraph 3, "Consolidated Instructions" which specifically requires the appointment by the Chief Commissioner of such officer for such purpose. The article in question reads as follows:

"3. The record of the following cases will be 46 reviewed by the Chief Commissioner OR by a judicial officer not below the rank of Lieutenant Colonel APPOINTED BY HIM FOR THAT PURPOSE....."

3. Whatever may have been past practice, the fact remains that the law is clear. Also, attention is directed to the fact that the military Governor of Italy has studiously delegated by written authority to each succeeding Chief Commissioner the power to review cases; it is a portion of this power that the Chief Commissioner delegates under authority of Article 32, paragraph 3, "Consolidated Instructions".

DEAR Colonel,

Many thanks for your letter of 31st ult. and your congratulations. I am well aware of the trouble you and Brigadier Upjohn have taken in connection with my promotion and I am most grateful to you for putting it through in the face of great difficulties.

The idea of going to Venezia Giulia is most attractive to me and even if it were not I would wish to help out as far as I could. My position is however as follows. Some months ago I was seriously considering the advisability of volunteering for the Far East with a view to an ultimate appointment in the Colonial Civil Service. Since then I have received advice from home which incline me to think I can do better by returning there. There are business reasons connected with my resumption of practice which unfortunately render it imperative that I be back in the UK by mid-October at the latest. I discussed this with Brigadier Upjohn and pointed out that I would be very pleased to stay on here until the beginning of October but could not for reasons explained to him remain after that. If this is any use to you I am entirely at your disposal.

If, as seems likely, you decide in the light of the above that it is not worth while sending me to Venezia Giulia it may not be out of place for me to make a suggestion. I know that Backhouse has volunteered to stay on for at least one year. I understand he is at present doing an excellent job in Bolzano Province with all its international complications. I know that he did excellent work in Region 5. I imagine he would fill your bill for the present job. I don't know of course what other candidates you have available nor have I any information as to Backhouse's own present plans or intentions. I merely take the liberty of suggesting him as a possibility.

Release from Active Duty.

Regional Commissioner, Emilia Region. (through Provincial Commissioner, Bologna Province)

1. I hereby make application for release from active duty due to the following reasons and circumstances:

(a) I entered upon active service on 26 May 1943. I arrived in North Africa on 19 October 1943 and in Italy on 19 January 1944.

(b) I am married and the Father of two children, ages 8 and 11. I have 87 points.

(c) When I volunteered in the Army I was serving as State Senator of the Twentieth Senatorial District of Kentucky. I resigned that office in September, 1943, and the unexpired term was filled by special election. I have been nominated, without opposition, as the Democratic nominee for State Senator from this same District. The General Election will be held on 6 November 1945. The District is overwhelmingly Democratic. I have no Democratic opposition. The last date for a candidate from any other party to file in opposition to me expired on 25 June 1945, and no one filed. I will, therefore, be unopposed in the General Election. A certificate of election to this office will be automatically issued to me in November of this year. 14

(d) The General Assembly of Kentucky will not convene until the first Monday in January 1946. However, organization of the Senate and preliminary legislative work will begin in November of this year. There will no doubt be a great amount of preliminary legislative work in connection with War Veterans. I will be the only member of the Senate who has served in this War, and am therefore especially anxious to be present at meetings of the Legislative Council who will consider and prepare legislation of this nature.

Sub P2 - Members of the army, other than the regular army, while on active duty may become candidates for election to public office without the tender of nomination as provided in (1) above and may file such evidence of their candidacy as required by local law.

Sub Paragraph 4 - A member of the army on active duty in a proper case can be discharged for the convenience of the Government under honorable conditions, or released from active duty, for the purpose of performing the duties of President of the United States or one of the following public offices specified in Section 5 (c) (1) of the selective Service and training Act of 1940, as amended: Vice President of the United States, the Governors and all other State Officials chosen by the votes of the entire State, of the several States and Territories, Members of the legislative bodies of the several States and Territories, Judges of the Courts of Record of the United States and of the several States and Territories and of the District of Columbia. Separation from the service or from active duty, as may be appropriate, is mandatory for any member of the army on active duty who becomes a member of either of the legislative bodies of the United States.
