TO : Civil Affairs Section.

1. Reference your 4/46 C/CA of 22 August 1945 herewith submitted scheme of the Legal Sub-Commission for reduction of personnel after the restoration of territory to the Italian Government.

2. The following officers and EM/OR can be released 14 days after such restoration :-

3. It is unlikely that it will be possible to make further reductions on the second phase 60 days after the first proposed reduction. As regards officers, Lt. Col. Mansford will be due for LIAP and it will probably be necessary to retain 1 officer (Major Nugent) to assist Col. Weber in review of cases. As regards EM/OR, two of the four remaining personnel will almost certainly be due to leave for release about this time.

4. Nine civilians are at present employed with this Sub-Commission. It is hoped that in the light of experience it may be possible to reduce this number by five fourteen days after restoration, and probably by a further two at the date of the second phase.

- 1 A scheme is to be prepared for a reduction in the TC/SE of the Civil Affairs Section.
- 2 The scheme will be divided into two phases:-
 - (a) Reductions in TC/SE which can take place 14 days after the date of the forthcoming hand-over of Northern Italy to the jurisdiction of the Italian Government;
 - (b) A second reduction in TC/SE which can take place 60 days after the date of reduction in the first phase above.
- 3 The scheme for your Sub-Commission will cover both officers and EM/CA and numbers will be given in all cases. In selecting personnel for the two phases, regard should be had to the release groups of British personnel and the point score of American personnel.
- 4 It is appreciated that schemes will be, to some extent, provisional and will be liable to change in the light of circumstances prevailing at the time.
- 5 Civilian staff will not be dealt with individually but the numbers employed at present should be stated in the scheme and the approximate reduction recommended should be given for the two phases above.
- 6 Please draw up your scheme and submit as early as possible.

MEMORANDUM TO: Manpower and Reorganization Committee.

1. Reference your C-18/35/1/A, dated 9 Aug 44.
2. Officers in Legal Sub-Commission see List "A" attached.
EM/OSs in Legal Sub-Commission see List "B" attached.
3. It is assumed initially that a Chief Legal Officer and Deputy Chief Legal Officer are required and that no discussion is required in that point.
4. As long as Allied Military Courts function, there must be a Chief Judicial Officer, now Lt. Col. I.D.M. Campbell for the purposes of supervising the courts, reviewing cases, etc. Despite the fact that even early in the occupational stages, work previously done by AMJ Courts is now increasingly placed in Italian Courts, there still are many cases in AMJ Courts which come for review before the Chief Judicial Officer. In this work, the Acting Chief Legal Officer and his Deputy lend assistance whenever possible and in death cases and spy cases one or both of them make independent reviews. As a matter of fact, were it not for the shortage of legal personnel in the field, there would be an assistant Chief Judicial Officer at Headquarters in order to take part of this burden so that the Chief Judicial Officer could get out in the field as he should do and was done until about five months ago when the assistant was ordered into another theater.
5. The Chief Counsel, Lt. Col. Grossman, has all of his time taken up with the preparation of General Orders, amendments to proclamations, preparation of opinions, etc. Capt. More, ~~was~~ although ~~is~~ normally his assistant, is engaged also as general assistant on personnel and detail matters for the AGLO and the ADCLO.
6. The Italian Branch consisting of four officers, Lt. Col. Hammadford, Lt. Col. Thackrah, Major Palmieri and Lt. Pryce, together with three Italian lawyers have work that keeps them occupied without cessation. Increasing work is placed on them by reason of the fact that various questions of Italian legislation is increasingly referred to them. Major Palmieri, now in the hospital, ordinarily spends little time at Hq. Generally, he is in the field aiding one region after another in setting up Italian Courts in which he has been most successful.
7. As set forth in List "B", one OP, a file clerk, can be spared. However, this sub-commission is short in typists and I have repeatedly requested a replacement for one EM recently returned to the U. S. Because of the nature of the work done by this sub-commission, I think it inadvisable to use any additional civilian personnel.

1. The limited available personnel, both Officer and m/c's, of the Commission, with no immediate relief assured and the extensive requirements indicated to us, the un-liberated regions of Italy, necessitates drastic elimination of all non-essential activities and the consolidation of Offices and Sub-Commissions of Headquarters, Allied Control Commission.

2. The Acting Chief Commissioner has appointed a Committee as follows :-

with the following terms of reference :-

To consider the re-organization of Headquarters, Allied Control Commission, with the mission of making the greatest possible number of Officers and m/c's available for field assignments and with a view to securing optimum efficiency with the most economic employment of available manpower. Consideration will be given to effecting the elimination of all activities not absolutely required for the accomplishment of the mission of the A.C.C., and also to the consolidation of Offices and Sub-Commissions where possible, consistent with the present situation.

3. The Committee met on Tuesday, 8th August 1944 and it was agreed that the four main points on which recommendations for possible reductions should be based are:

- with the following terms of reference:-

To consider the re-organization of Headquarters, Allied Control Commission, with the mission of making the greatest possible number of Officers and E/Os available for field assignments and with a view to securing optimum efficiency with the most economic employment of available manpower. Consideration will be given to effecting the elimination of all activities not absolutely required for the accomplishment of the mission of the A.C.C., and also to the consolidation of offices and Sub-Commissions where possible, consistent with the present situation.

3. The Committee met on Tuesday, 5th August 1944 and it was agreed that the four main points on which recommendations for possible reductions should be based are:

- (a) Amalgamation of Sub-Commissions and Branches
- (b) Reduction of functions
- (c) Substitution of Italian or other local personnel for Allied personnel
- (d) Withdrawal of non-essential personnel.

4. It is the intention to ask Heads of Sub-Commissions and branches to present their own recommendations by which the Acting Chief Commissioner's proposals will be met and for this purpose the Committee will sit each day from 0900 hrs to 1200 hrs commencing Friday, 11th August 1944.

5. When preparing their recommendations, Heads of Sub-Commissions should remember it is the policy of A.C.C. to transfer increasing responsibility upon the Italian Government, leaving members of Headquarters, Allied Control Commission to advise and supervise.
