1. These petitions except for occupation could go direct to the Italian Minister of Justice for his action.

2. Because of occupation, they are forwarded generally with recommendations for or against the petition, by the MLO. They are by this Sub-Commission submitted to the Minister of Justice for his consideration and are acted upon accordingly if his determination is not contrary to the regional recommendation. Likewise because of occupation the final action has had to be taken at this HQ.

3. To avoid taxing the Chief Commissioner with such matters it was arranged that Col. Upjohn when Chief Legal Officer should grant or deny the petitions on behalf of the Chief Commissioner. Unless I hear to the contrary, I will assume it is agreeable to you for me to continue the same program on your behalf as Acting Chief Commissioner.
