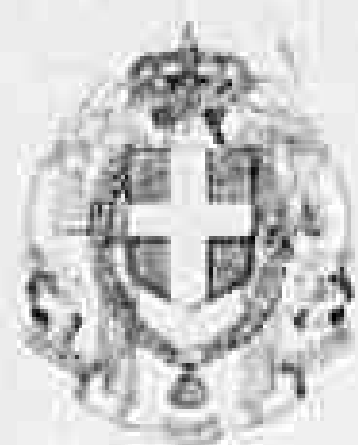

On 19 April 44 the Allied Officer commanding the U.S. Army Unit from
which it was suspected that patrol in the possession of SPAGNUOLO had been
stolen ordered the C.O. of Cosenza to arrest him. This officer was
entirely ignorant of Italian procedure and acted in good faith on the grounds
that he considered the penalty inflicted by the Court inadequate and thought
he was entitled to take steps to augment it.

Unfortunately the officer did not report the matter to AC, nor for
that matter did the Procuratore del Regno of Cosenza, who likewise neglected
to do so at the inception of the case.

The Legal Officer states that he immediately arranged for SPAGNUOLO's
release on 25 Oct, adding the comment that, on the facts disclosed, the
imposition of a suspended sentence was unjustified, but as no appeal was
preferred the offender was released. The Legal Officer further considers that
no substantial injustice was done, SPAGNUOLO having been found guilty of an
offense for which the term of imprisonment suffered was a proper punishment.

1. Ref your ACC/4030/L of 29.9.44 to which RLO Southern Region in his L/3024nof 3.10.44 instructed this HQ to reply direct.
2. I visited COSENZA on 25.10.44 and ascertained the following facts:
 - (a) Facts set out in letter of Ministry of Pardon and Justice letter of 20 Sept 44 regarding conviction of SPAGNUOLO, Giovanni by Tribunale of Cosenza on 30th March for unlawful possession of petrol, and the imposition of a suspended sentence of 11 months and a small fine are correct.
 - (b) On the facts as disclosed to me the imposition of a suspended sentence was unjustified, but no appeal against this sentence was submitted.
 - (c) Consequently Spagnuolo was released.
 - (d) On 19th April Capt. Ericsson who commands and at the material time commanded 300 Engineer Company U.S. Army, with HQ at SIFA, province of Cosenza, and from whose unit it was suspected that petrol in possession of Spagnuolo had originally been stolen, ordered the Maresciallo GARR of Cosenza to arrest Spagnuolo.
 - (e) I had an interview with Capt. Ericsson who makes no claim to understand Italian legal procedure, and appeared to be under the impression that Spagnuolo's sentence was inadequate - with which I agree - and that he, Capt. Ericsson, was entitled to augment it. He took no steps either to bring Spagnuolo to trial or to report matter to ACC, and he made it clear that the reason for the arrest was the offence which had already been dealt with by the Tribunale of Cosenza.
3. It is, I hope necessary to add that in view of the facts above set out I arranged for Spagnuolo, Giovanni immediate release, and he was released on same day October 25.
4. My findings are:
 - (i) That the re-arrest of Spagnuolo was completely irregular and legally unjustified. It is proper to add that Captain Ericsson, who is in command of a ~~company~~ company with con-

LUMBER

siderable responsibilities, acted in perfectly good faith.

- (ii) That in fact no substantial injustice was done, Spagnuolo having been found guilty by the Italian Courts of an offence for which the term of imprisonment he has served was a proper punishment.
- (iii) That the Procuratore del Regno of Cosenza was at fault in NOT bringing the matter at any time to the attention of ACC.

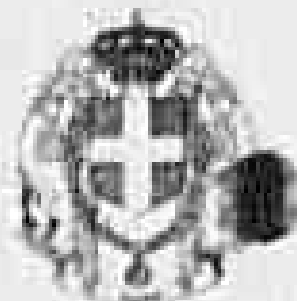

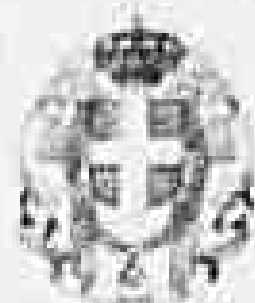
