2. As you are no doubt aware the Decree granting amnesty for common military and rationing offences (R.D. No. 96 of 5 April 1944) and the Decree extending such amnesty to offences committed during the Allied Military Government in restored territories (D.L. No. 363 of 5 Oct 1944) exclude from the benefit of amnesty all sentences in cases adjudicated by Italian Courts and affecting Allied interests. This exemption has been enacted precisely for the reasons set out in para 2 of your letter. For the same reasons an agreement has been entered into with the Minister of Justice that no petitions for pardon or conditional liberty in Italian Court cases affecting Allied interests will be acted upon by Italian authorities without approval of this Sub-Commission.

Generally no pardon or conditional liberty will be agreed to unless in very special circumstances.

1. I have no specific objection to the granting of Conditional Liberty in these two cases.

2. I do however make a general objection to the granting of any such liberty in this Region to persons convicted of offences affecting Allied Interests particularly theft on the following grounds.

a. That such persons should not be put in a more favourable position than persons previously convicted by AMG Courts who do not get the benefit of Conditional Liberty.

b. That there is still a vast amount of stealing of Allied Property so that any leniency is likely to have a bad effect.

3. I feel that this is largely a matter of policy and I shall be glad to have your general views thereon. It would I feel be beneficial to Allied Interests here if there was a ruling that such applications would be refused in all normal cases and wide publicity given to this decision.

4. In the present cases the original sentence was 2 yrs & 6 months reduced on Appeal to one year. If the accused now arrive back home after a mere 6 months the Sicilians are strengthened in their belief that Allied property can be pilfered without risk of heavy penalties.

5. It will also be appreciated that the Military Authority who are greatly interested in the original sentences imposed do not fully realize that many sentences are reduced on Appeal and that only half the reduced sentence is likely to be served. Were they aware of this fact I have no doubt they would be far from satisfied.

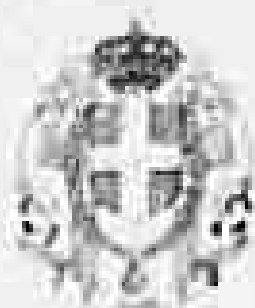
