1. The Italian Minister of Pardon and Justice addressed the following request to this Sub-Commission.

2. Dott. FORNARIO Erasmo, former pretor and acting President of the Tribunale of Gondar at present civilian internee at Sudan (address: civilian internee No. 31408, 337 P.O.W. Camp, Postal Section Sudan), and Dott. ORIANI Giulio, pretor and head of the Sezione Pondiaria di Misurata, Tripolitania, (employed by Ministry for Italian Africa as of 24 July 1942) were admitted "d'office" to the scrutiny for promotion (scrutinio per la promozione in Corte d'Appello) held in 1943. However, by a decision of 13 January 1944 the Second Section of the Consiglio Superiore per la Magistratura found that the above two magistrates do not deserve a promotion.

3. The Minister requests that the two magistrates be advised of the outcome of the scrutiny and invited to issue a statement as prescribed by law which permits them to lodge an appeal against the decision. (Art. 167 of the Ordinamento Giudiziario.)

4. If you agree to comply with Minister's request would you please forward the statement of the above two officials to this Sub-Commission for onward transmission to the Minister.

SUBJECT : Observations on First President of Court  
of Appeals of Torino.

TO : R.L.O., Piemonte Region, APO 394.

1. I have been observing the First President of Court of Appeals of Torino since I first came in contact with him on 10 May 1945. I have spoken to him personally on official matters almost daily and noticed his attitude in discharging official duties. My conclusions are that he is an instrumentality of C.L.N., from which Organization he holds office and desires to remain in its good graces in order to remain in the position he now holds. He does not have a free mind in the strict sense of the word, in my opinion, as a magistrate should have.

2. This gentleman held a meeting of all personnel of Special Courts of Assizes prior to these courts becoming active in Piemonte. I attended that meeting. <sup>apart from</sup> ~~Aside of~~ having said, in a low unimpressive tone of voice, "let us judge with serenity" he did not seek to impress the personnel with the importance of convicting defendants on proof of their having been in fact collaborators with the enemy, knowing that due to the heated conditions that prevail in Italy today convictions could easily be obtained solely because the defendant belonged to the Fascist Republican Army or was employed by it in some insignificant capacity.

3. Some of the convictions seen in Torino are not in my view indicative of true justice, for example:

(a) Pierina and Bruna della Giusta, females, members of Fascist Republican Army. One a seamstress the other a maid. Only evidence against them was that they belonged

to army abovementioned and P.F.R.

Result of this trial ----- 8 years, 6 months imprisonment.

(b) Secondina Lerici, female, member of Fascist Republican Army. A nurse who job it was to prepare dead bodies for burial at the local Military Hospital. No other evidence.

Result of her trial ----- 6 years imprisonment.

(c) Oreste De Stefanis, employed by a Fascist newspaper. His job was to post pictures of a propaganda nature in the show window of the newspaper office. The pictures were handed him by his superiors.

Result of his trial ----- 10 years imprisonment.

39 4. At the Milan conference held on 30 June 1945, after Allied Officers of A.C., Legal Sub-Commission explained that members of Fascist Republican Army should not be tried for that sole fact, The First President of Court of Appeals of Torino was the only one that said openly, "I feel that they should be tried for having belonged to that Army".

5. I have no recommendation to make but submit these observations for what they are worth. However, I might say that I am not very enthusiastic over this gentleman.

- (ii) He then applied to Provincial Legal Officer Como without mentioning the previous refusal; Provincial Legal Officer Como said he saw no objection, but confirmation must be obtained from Milan.
- (iii) He next applied to the Regional Legal Officer, Lombardia Region, who knowing the views of the First President, declined to entertain the application.
- (iv) He then apparently went to Naples without permission.
- (v) He gave the Ministry to understand that he had permission to go from Provincial Legal Officer Como without mentioning that this was not confirmed either by the Regional Legal Officer or the First President.

1. With reference to the attached letter dated 9th July from the Procuratore Generale to the Ministry, I desire to place on record the following facts regarding the above-named magistrate:

- (i) He applied to the First President Milan for leave and was refused.
- (ii) He then applied to P.L.O. Como without mentioning the previous refusal; P.L.O. Como said he saw no objection but confirmation must be obtained from Milan.
- (iii) He next applied to the undersigned, who knowing the views of the First President, declined to entertain the application.
- (iv) He then apparently went to Naples ~~without~~ permission.
- (v) He gave the Ministry to understand that he had permission to go from P.L.O. Como, without mentioning that this was not confirmed either by the R.L.O. or the First President.

2. Dott. Vaccaro is a poor type of magistrate, and his presence at or absence from Menaggio is probably of small importance either way. What is important is that the policy of the First President should be supported in practice in matters such as the granting of leave in which it has already been approved in theory.

3. For this reason, it is suggested that the facts stated in para 1 be communicated to the Ministry with the request that disciplinary action be taken against Dott. Vaccaro.

1. In reply to your letter of 2 July 1945, ref. UC/89 I am not clear whether Signora SCAVONE wishes to go with her children to Tripoli or whether she wishes her husband to come to Italy.
2. It will be extremely difficult to obtain permission for her husband to come to Italy.

She request, therefore, your Ministry to grant her authority to return home, and begs you to give her help and assistance.

Trusting that her request will be take into consideration, she thanks you in anticipation.

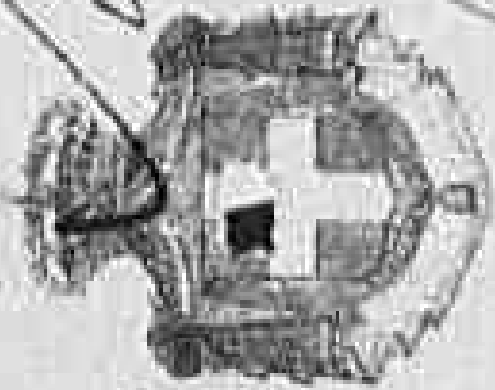

I submit my particulars, in order that I may be temporarily assigned by that Command, to a Court of Law as a judge, possibly in Venice, where I presently reside with my family, or secondly in Padova or Treviso.

By Decree of the republican Ministry of Justice, dated November 13th 1944, while I was judge at the Court of Law of Vicenza, I was placed on the unattached list for a year, from November 15th.

Therefore the Court of Law of Vicenza ceased paying me the retribution from January.

By a Decree of February 22nd 1945, the same Ministry revoked the Decree of 13th November, substituting it with the appointment to the Court of Law of Verona, running from the 15th November, date of expiration of the placement on the unattached list.

I did not reach the residence of the Court of Law of Verona, as I could not and can not take service according to the provision of a State and a Government which disappeared at the time that I ought to have regularly assumed service.

Being, therefore, absent from service for contingent reasons relative to the social and administrative situation, with the necessity of receiving the salary as well as for the expired months, residing, as I have already declared, out of the residence of Vicenza, I beg that Command to provide, whenever it is of competence, for my temporary appointment to the Court of Law of Venice, and to order that the salary from the Treasury Section of Verona or of Vicenza be made collectable in Venice by transferring the records to the Treasury Office of Venice.

I am applying to you on the advise of the President of the Court of Appeal of Venice.

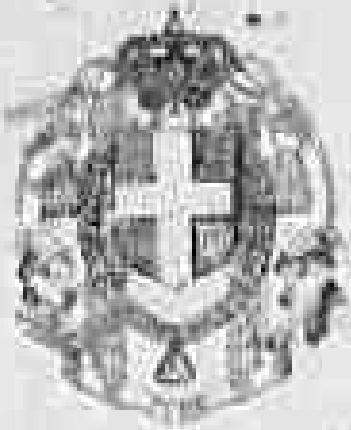

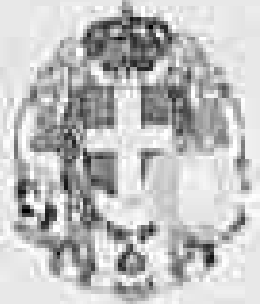

In the first days the Committee asked for his removal on the grounds that he had on one occasion written an article urging the Court officials to carry on with their function and said that he supported the Fascist. The article was never produced nor could the writer get any one to put the complaint in writing. When GO 35 came into effect it was urged that they enquire into his case but nothing has been done. In fact the writer was on one occasion told that there wasn't sufficient against him to effect his removal. The impression at this HQ. is that they wished his removal in order to install a patriot in his place. In the meantime he has been cooperative and efficient in every way.

3. As to the Procuratore Generale of Genoa, Dott. Alfonso Aroca, this official has not functioned in view of the fact a warrant was issued by CLM, and later withdrawn. This official stated with the imputation against his name he could not function and it appears that somehow he had his case enquired into by the Special Court of Assize whose finding and records are herewith transmitted for the Minister of Grace and Justice.

4. It is proposed to ask this official to re-assume his functions as the Epuration Committee have also been informed in his case to take proceedings in the event of there being any question of his good faith.

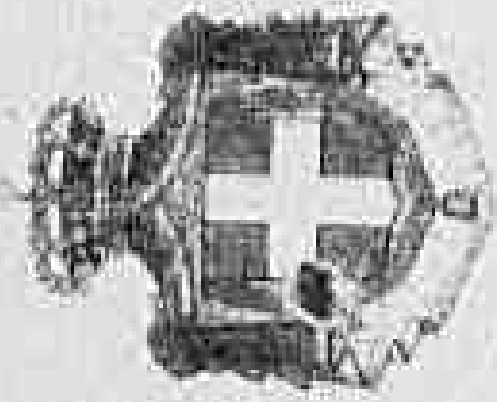

3. Strongest representations were made at the Ministry to the effect that it is imperative for both the new Procuratore Generale and Primo Presidente to proceed to Bologna without delay and to provide for a transfer of GASTRUCHI from Bologna. As for GASTRUCHI the Ministry points out that he has been placed "fuori del ruolo organico" a disposizione del Ministro in accordance with Art. 225 of the organic judicial law by virtue of Ministerial Decree dated 8 June 1945. His case is now being examined by the new Minister with a view to eventual separation proceeding. It should be noted that this Decree was issued by the Ministry on their own initiative and not on request of this Sub-Commission which has merely suggested the transfer of GASTRUCHI from Bologna as recommended by you.

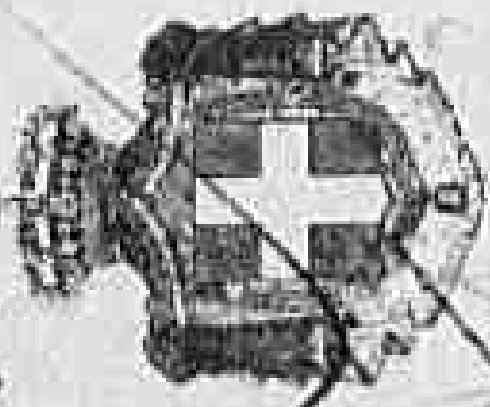

1. The enclosed memorandum was dictated by H.E. Cartesegna in my office this afternoon and is forwarded for urgent action.

2. It is suggested that communications of this kind affecting senior magistrates in AMG territory should not be issued by the Ministry without prior approval of A.C. To send all these magistrates into retirement at the present time would bring the work of the Courts to a standstill and in the case of Cartesegna himself, the Ministry is already aware that he has been confirmed by order of AMG.

3. Pending further instructions I have informed the First President that he and the other magistrates named are to continue in office.

SUBJECT : Magistrati in Northern Italy who have reached the age limit.  
TO : H. E. The Minister of War and Justice.

1. The enclosed memorandum received from LOMBARDY Region is forwarded to Your Excellency for action.

2. It is not admissible that "magistrati" who exercise their functions in AMI territory should be placed in retirement without previous notice to Allied authorities.

3. Furthermore this Sub-Commission cannot believe that Your Excellency could have known of the communication to which H.E. CARTASCHER refers in his note to LOMBARDY Region. At a time when every conceivable effort is being made to find politically and otherwise appropriate officials to undertake the increased commitments which are daily facing the northern magistracy; it is impossible to think that Your Excellency would have allowed, had you been aware of it, that the number of suitable magistrates be further depleted.

4. In the meantime all the officials concerned have been confirmed in their functions by AMI.

5. No doubt Your Excellency will confirm this step.

SUBJECT : Epuration of Magistrates and judicial officials.

TO : HQ Allied Commission (Legal Sub-Commission)

1. Reference is made to your letter AC/4039/L dated 16th June 1945 enclosing copies of two Ministerial Decrees dated 2nd June 1945 whereby 44 Cancellieri were declared suspended from their duties.

2. Further copies of these Decrees also reached this HQ with a covering letter from the Ministry of Justice to the Procuratore del Regno of Cremona, directing him to notify the officials affected, the Intendente di Finanza and other interested parties of the suspensions.

3. A communication on similar lines has to-day been intercepted between the Ministry and the First President, Milan, whereby the latter is instructed to provide a substitute for the Procuratore del Regno at Vigevano who is "sottoposto a giudizio di epurazione".

3. 4. While the undersigned does not wish to interfere unnecessarily with the attempts of this Ministry to put their own house in order, the simultaneous operation of two Commissions of Epuration is likely to lead to some confusion. May this HQ therefore be advised as to

- (a) the precise effect of suspensions made by the Minister of Justice in respect of officials within AMG territory;
- (b) the action to be taken by the local Epuration Commission with regard to an official declared suspended by such Ministerial Order. If the local Commission is required to make an order, must the date of suspension be the same as the date specified in the Decree ?
