In the meantime the third must leave a paper on the 25 July, which will mean he has had some kind of sick leave. What must he do? go back to Trieste?

He is however ill and his health will not permit him to undertake a long journey. He is valued by the medical authorities as attached to his role being in the Ministry.

As a father I do not feel that I can remain indifferent to the concern of my son, and as I have no influential friends and have not received any reply on the requests sent to the Ministry, I beg you to be so kind as to take some with the said Ministry of Grace and Justice with a view to finding out what my poor son must do on the 25 July and thereupon let him know.

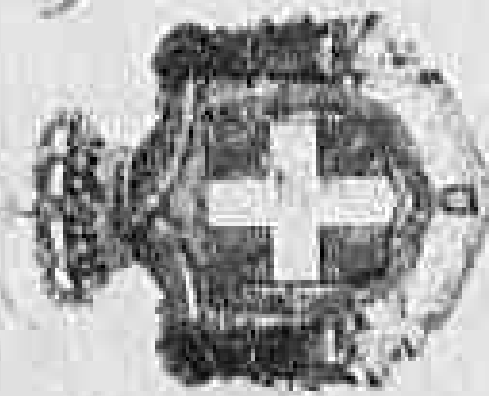

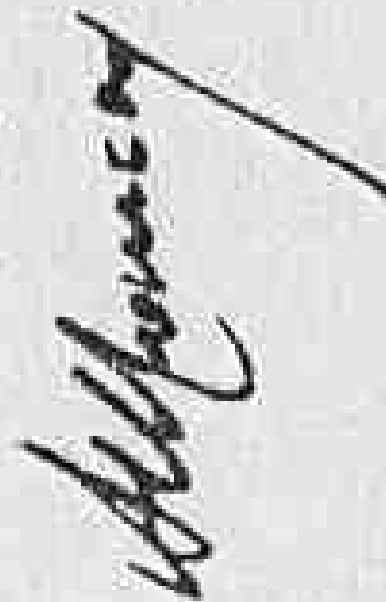

1. In compliance with the wishes of the Chief Legal Adviser, the following data is furnished concerning Brigadiere SESTRI Giorgio, CC.RR., assigned to the Tribunale Station, Legion of Naples. Brigadiere SESTRI Giorgio has been assigned to the Legal Division, Allied Military Government, Southern Region since 8 January 1944. His services to the Allied Military Government and to the Allied Commission have been invaluable and most meritorious. Brigadiere SESTRI entered the Carabinieri service on 23 April 1929; on 31 March he was promoted to Vice-Brigadiere; on 31 March 1943 he was promoted Brigadiere.

2. Brigadiere SESTRI has been responsible for the maintenance of order in the various Allied Military Government courts held in Naples and for the safe custody of the accused brought to trial before these courts. He has performed these duties in a most outstanding manner; he has time and again demonstrated the use of excellent judgment, the faithful performance of his duties, and the efficient management of those under his control.

3. Much of the credit for the successful handling of Allied interest cases in the Italian Courts is due to the cheerful and efficient cooperation of Brigadiere SESTRI not only with the Allied military authorities but also with the Italian police agencies.

Very notable was his action in the case of the Vitale brothers, who were acquitted by an Allied Military Government court on 16 March 1946. By his careful attention to proceedings in the Vitale case, Brigadiere SESTRI was able to effect the arrest of Iovino Donato, Italian civilian, wanted by the police authorities for aggravated robberies upon other civilians.

4. It is my earnest recommendation that Brigadiere SESTRI Giorgio be recommended for promotion to the grade of Maresciallo on the basis of his length of service as a Carabiniere and on the basis of his invaluable work to the Allied. It is felt that the good work and faithful service of Brigadiere SESTRI should be brought to the attention of his superiors.
