TO: Legal S/C.

Repatriation of PW has for some time been a subject considered on a high level between AFHQ and the C.C. In general, AFHQ policy has been to hold all PW.

This office has from time to time received many applications from several sources for the return of PW. The C.C. decided however, to submit a small list of 25 names to AFHQ and if this were passed to then forward another list of similar size. We have heard that the 1st list has been favorably considered and therefore, C.S. have been asked to prepare No. 2. It will therefore, be seen, that all that can be done in regard to your PW is to submit a list to the C.C. with a covering note giving the reasons for such submission and then leaving the C.C. to place the names in one of the lists according to the priority they decide upon vis-a-vis other demands.

If your S.C. will put up a strong recommendation and attach the list, the matter will be forwarded. A short reference that you are aware of the general position regarding PW might be included.

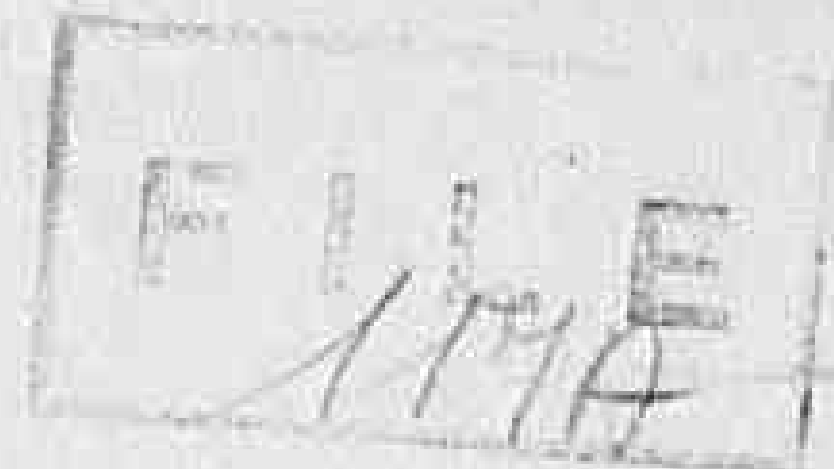

I lodged on the 7th June 1946 an application with the Ministry of East Africa, requesting an urgent repatriation of my son, named Dr. Mario BORTTI, who is at present a judge at the " Pretura " of Tripoli. Said petition was supported by a family certificate and a medical statement.

I sent another petition to your Ministry on the 29th June 1946, with reference to my first petition, lodged with the Ministry of East-Africa.

My son remains up-to-date at Tripoli. The state of my health, as well as one of my wife, became sensibly worse. I am 77, and my wife 70 years old. We are terribly depressed and are afraid that we will not see our son again. He is our only son, he is single and is living in Libya for over 7 years. He is our only moral and material support.

I am compelled to apply again to your Ministry, (if necessary, with the Ministry of East-Africa), in order that my son be repatriated to Italy at the earliest possible date. I have not seen him for over seven years.

I trust that my insistence will be understood, and the prayer of a poor old father will be listened.

This would not only be a great hardship, and, as mentioned in the letter, an injury to science, but may be considered as a breach of international conventions regarding prisoners. In order that Lieut. Riccobono may not be deprived of the fruits of his labours during years of captivity which will be a definite contribution to legal science it would be greatly appreciated by this Sub-Commission if the I.P.W. Sub-Commission would take all steps necessary to have the manuscripts sent by the safest means to Italy.

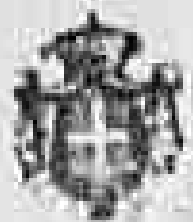

EXECUTIVE MEMORANDUM

NUMBER : 3)

REPATRIATION OF ITALIAN NATIONALS TO ITALY.

1. This Memorandum sets out the classes into which Italian Nationals held as Prisoners of War and Internees are divided, and the procedure which must be followed in making application for their repatriation.

2. There are two main classes:

- (a) Italian Prisoners of War i.e. members of the Italian Forces in Allied hands and Italian Merchant Seamen who have been interned by any of the Allied nations.
- (b) Civilians and groups of civilians living or interned outside Italy.

ITALIAN PRISONERS OF WAR AND MERCHANT SEAMEN.

3. WAR MATERIALS DISPOSAL AND ITALIAN PRISONERS OF WAR SUB COMMISSION is responsible for the handling of all questions concerning the repatriation of Italian Prisoners of War and Italian Merchant Seamen.

4. The following are the categories in which Prisoners of War or Merchant Seamen may be repatriated.

(a) Entitled Repatriates.

Sick, wounded, those who are 60 years of age or over, those who are over 50 years of age and have been two years in captivity. These Prisoners of War are now being repatriated automatically as shipping becomes available and will be demobilized on arrival in Italy.

(b) Compassionate cases.

Cases where Prisoners of War are required to take care of a family who have no other means of support, on conditions similar to those under which an Allied soldier would be posted home. Such cases are compassionate.

ITALIAN PRISONERS OF WAR AND MERCHANT SEAMEN.

3. WAR MATERIALS DISPOSAL AND ITALIAN PRISONERS OF WAR SUB-COMMISSION is responsible for the handling of all questions concerning the repatriation of Italian Prisoners of War and Italian Merchant Seamen.

4. The following are the categories in which Prisoners of War or Merchant Seamen may be repatriated.

(a) Entitled Repatriates.

Sick, wounded, those who are 60 years of age or over, those who are over 50 years of age and have been two years in captivity. These Prisoners of War are now being repatriated automatically as shipping becomes available and will be demobilized on arrival in Italy.

(b) Compassionate cases.

Cases where Prisoners of War are required to take care of a family who have no other means of support, on conditions similar to those under which an Allied soldier would be posted home. Such cases are comparable to those of men of military age exempted from service, and will be demobilized on arrival in Italy.

(c) Priority workers.

Workers who are required by a U.S. or British agency or by an Italian Government agency for important work as a direct contribution to the Allied War Effort. Such cases are comparable to those of men of military age exempted from service as key workers, and will be demobilized on arrival in Italy.

(d) Effective Members of the Italian Armed Forces.

Prisoners of War who are required for active service with the Italian Armed Forces, approval must first be obtained from the Service Sub-Commission concerned.

PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED IN DEALING WITH ITALIAN PRISONERS OF WAR AND MERCHANT SEAMEN.

5. All applications and enquiries regarding repatriation with- in classes 4 (a) and (b) will be forwarded direct to the Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War, Corso Vittorio Emanuele 120, Rome.

6. Requests will only be submitted under 4 (c) when respon- sibility is accepted by the Director of the Sub-Commission, Regional Commissioner or the Italian Government agency, submitting the case that the Prisoner of War concerned will fill and is qualified to fill the appointment for which he has been requested. Requests under 4 (c) made by an Italian Government agency will in the first place be submitted to the Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War.

7. All requests for repatriation under 4 (d) will be initiated by the service Ministry concerned to the appropriate service Sub- Commission. The requests will give full particulars of the per- sonnel required and their proposed employment in the Armed Forces. After approval by the service Sub-Commission concerned the requests will be returned to the service Ministry for submission to the Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War. Prisoners of War will not be absorbed into the Armed Forces in ITALY by any other means.

8. The Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War will check and collate all applications and requests made to him and will forward them to War Materials Disposal and Italian Prisoners of War Sub-Commission which will, if it approves, make formal ap- plication to higher authority.

9. In all cases under the above conditions repatriated Italian Prisoners of War of military age will only be demobilized or re- leased from service for other duties provided the service Ministry concerned does not require their retention in the Armed Forces.

CIVILIANS LIVING OR INTERNED OUTSIDE ITALY.

10. The DISPLACED PERSONS AND REPATRIATION SUB-COMMISSION will be responsible for the handling of all applications for the repatria- tion of civilians and groups of civilians living or interned out- side ITALY.

11. The following are the conditions on which applications may be made for repatriation of civilians to ITALY.

7. All requests for repatriation under 4 (d) will be initiated by the service Ministry concerned to the appropriate service Sub-Commission. The requests will give full particulars of the personnel required and their proposed employment in the Armed Forces. After approval by the service Sub-Commission concerned the requests will be returned to the service Ministry for submission to the Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War. Prisoners of War will not be absorbed into the Armed Forces in ITALY by any other means.

8. The Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War will check and collate all applications and requests made to him and will forward them to War Materiale Disposal and Italian Prisoners of War Sub-Commission which will, if it approves, make formal application to higher authority.

9. In all cases under the above conditions repatriated Italian Prisoners of War of military age will only be demobilized or released from service for other duties provided the service Ministry concerned does not require their retention in the Armed Forces.

CIVILIANS LIVING OR INTERNED OUTSIDE ITALY.

10. The DISPLACED PERSONS AND REPATRIATION SUB-COMMISSION will be responsible for the handling of all applications for the repatriation of civilians and groups of civilians living or interned outside ITALY.

11. The following are the conditions on which applications may be made for repatriation of civilians to ITALY.

(a) Compassionate cases.

Cases where civilians are required to return to ITALY to take care of a family who have no other means of support. All cases on compassionate grounds will however be considered on their merits.

(b) Priority workers.

Cases where civilians are necessary to the war effort and will be a direct contribution thereto.

12. All requests from Sub-Commissions or Regional Commissioners for repatriation of civilians or groups of civilians under para 11 (a) and (b) will be forwarded direct to DISPLACED PERSONS AND REPATRIATION SUB-COMMISSION who will be responsible for screening all applications and approving them prior to forwarding them to higher authority. Directors of Sub-Commissions and Regional Commissioners will be responsible for insuring that the applications they submit are warranted by the circumstances and facts put before them. In applications under 11 (b) the civilian for whom the application is made must be qualified to hold the appointment for which he is asked and will fill the appointment after repatriation.

SUBJECT: Release of P.O.W. Judicial Officials.

TO: War Material Disposal & Italian POW Sub-Commission.

1. I am enclosing a list of numbers of the Italian judiciary who are believed to be Prisoners of War in the various theatres and for whom the Minister of Justice has asked.
2. The reason for this request is that as we move further north judges of these various classes are required. As a matter of fact there are at the moment a number of vacancies in certain of the courts recently liberated from the Germans.
3. The Minister of Justice stated, at a meeting held today, that so far as he was aware the persons mentioned in the enclosed list would be satisfactory for service and are not objectionable from a fascist standpoint. The Minister of Justice in all cases does not know where the prisoner of war is held.
4. It is asked that the request of the Minister of Justice be passed on to ~~ACC~~ in order that the return of these prisoners of war be commenced as quickly as possible.
5. There was some previous correspondence some time ago with AMHQ concerning the sending of a mission to North Africa when AMHQ was located there. The mission was to consist of General TRAINA, who was the Procuratore Generale, — Dott. TARTAGLIA, of the Ministry of Justice, and an officer of ACC. It was intended that they should go jointly to pick out as many of the judiciary, military and civil, as was possible.
6. However it later developed upon the fall of ROSS that there was a sufficient number of military judiciary personnel available and, therefore, General Traina's mission was called off by the Italian Army. However, I understand that a request for a few officer Prisoners of War was subsequently submitted. In view of the foregoing the mission insofar as Dr. TARTAGLIA was concerned was not pursued.
6. If Dr. TARTAGLIA is required at any time to go to North Africa he is available to do so.
7. I should like to know how this matter is likely to be handled as the Minister of Justice regards it as urgent.

SUBJECT: Repatriation of Italian Prisoners of War with Special Qualifications.

TO : G-5 Section, Allied Force Headquarters, APO 512.

1. Reference is made to your letter on same subject of 6 July 1944.
2. Your offer to repatriate specially qualified prisoners of war is particularly welcome since great difficulty is being met in finding suitable men to fill appointments in the various Civil Ministries and State Agencies. Sufficient men are simply not available in Italy.
3. Rather than send a special mission to North Africa to select suitable PW's - a method which would probably be clumsy in practice - it is now considered that quicker results could be obtained by the submission of lists of men who are known to be suitable for such posts.
4. In conjunction with the Italian High Commissioner for Prisoners of War we are now compiling three lists of two hundred names each. These lists would include civil servants of all grades down to class 8 or 9. They will shortly be forwarded, and your assistance is most earnestly requested to facilitate their speedy repatriation - or, alternatively, to inform us quickly of those cases which prove impracticable.
5. In the meantime a shorter list is being forwarded giving the names of prisoners suitable to fill judicial appointments. Owing to the number of cases which we are now handing over to be dealt with by the civil courts, it is essential that a further large number of judges be made available to the Italian Government.

For this list, therefore, we ask your immediate attention.

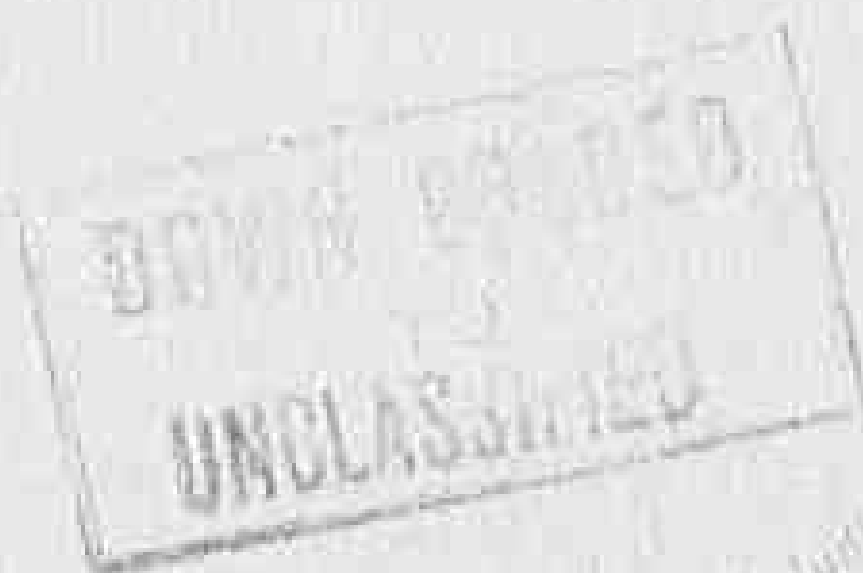

PROCEDURE FOR RECOMMENDATION OF  
RELEASE OF PRISONERS OF WAR

- 1 Prisoners of War will be released most exceptionally on request and then only if their services are necessary for the furtherance of the War effort.
- 2 The authority for initiating a request for the release of a prisoner will be the Sub Commission responsible for the class of work which the prisoner is particularly suited to do.
- 3 On being satisfied that the services of a prisoner are necessary the Sub Commission will forward their request together with a short statement of the reasons for their decision to the Deputy Chief Commissioner.
- 4 The papers relating to prisoners onto whom the request for release is approved by the DCC, will be submitted by him to the Public Safety Sub Commission who will investigate and report on the prisoner's local reputation and party history, returning the papers with their report to the initiating Sub Commission.
- 5 If this report is that the prisoner is suitable for repatriation the initiating Sub Commission will prepare the formal request for release of the prisoner for signature by the DCC.
- 6 The formal request will be addressed to the G.C. the Army by whom the prisoner is held and will contain :
  - a. such particulars of the prisoner and his location as will enable him to be identified.
  - b. The capacity in which it is proposed that he shall be employed and a short summary of the reasons that his services are required.
  - c. A statement that his services are necessary for the furtherance of the War effort.
  - d. A statement that his local reputation and party history have been investigated and are satisfactory.
  - e. A request that he be released.
- 7 Any application for release of a prisoner which originates outside the DCC will be forwarded to the appropriate Sub Commission who, if satisfied that the prisoner's services are necessary, will deal with it as above.

1. Trials of offences against Allied interests have been, and still are delayed both in the Military and Civil Courts, by the lack of judicial officials.
2. For that reason, and in order to leave no excuse to the Italian authorities to delay trial of cases, it is urgently recommended that the judicial personnel shown on the attached list, and now in custody as prisoners of war, may be returned to this country for judicial work.
