1. Orders: Publication of General Order 37 was made during the month. There were no other General or Regional Orders.

2. A.M.G. Courts: Consolidated returns showing cases in each Province with the exception of Novara and Vercelli Provinces where no trials were held during the month, and classification of cases where convictions pronounced are sent herewith.

A General Court was convened at Cuneo on 6 September 45 to try two partisans on a charge of killing a French Algerian soldier. The accused were acquitted.

3. Italian Courts: The Italian Courts continue to function satisfactorily.

4. Special Courts of Assize: 221 cases were heard. There were 6 death sentences and 83 acquittals, 24 accused were sentenced to less than 1 year, 67 to more than 1 year but less than 10 years, and 41 to more than 10 years imprisonment. Seven death sentences, one from Asti and six from Novara, were carried out without incident.

1. As the Report for the month to the Regional Commissioner was required by today, the following details are based on returns from Provinces to approximately 29 August, and if approved it is proposed to include any subsequent figures in the next report.

2. Orders: The following Orders were issued during the month:-

General Order 51
Regional Order 8 - Census of Livestock.
Regional Order 9 - Issue of Fertilizers.
Regional Order 10 - Newspaper Reports.
- - Regulations - Labour Relations.

The last two orders were not printed, but were circulated to those concerned.

3. A.M.G. Courts: Consolidated returns showing cases tried in each Province and classification of cases where convictions pronounced is sent herewith.

4. Italian Courts: The Italian Courts continue to function satisfactorily. The amount of work disposed of has dropped through personnel having vacations.

5. Special Courts of Assize: 136 cases were heard of which 14 were not completed. There were nine death sentences and 38 acquittals.

The decision of the Court of Cassation in the cases of VINCIGUERRA and FUGLIATTI clarifying the question of neo-fascist organization membership in relation to collaboration has caused some stir. One Public Minister was very much upset but his position is still being dealt with without official reference here.

There were only minor "incidents" at two Courts and it is thought that Regional Order N° 10 will go a long way to stop even such incidents. Previously some newspapers printed highly provocative articles..

Last month's report, para. 4, should be amended to read that the Courts had tried 981 cases from commencement to date, etc., etc.

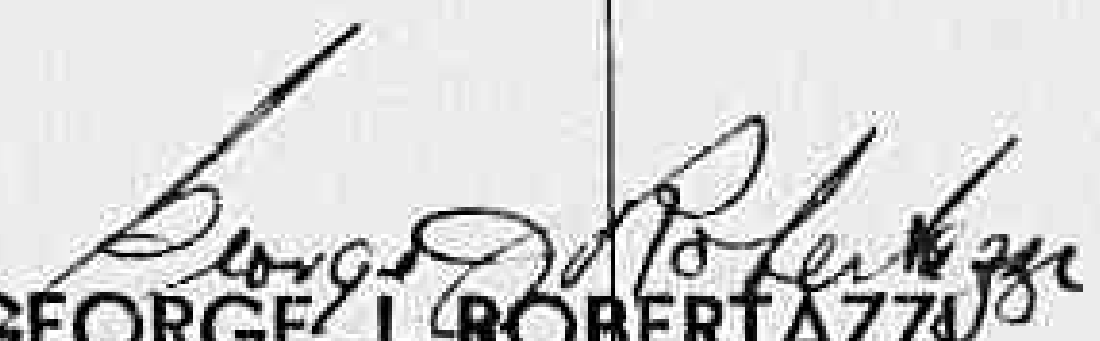

2. A.M.G. Courts were trying more cases than in previous months. Fire arms, illegal possession and circulation of vehicles without permit predominated.

3. Italian Courts are functioning satisfactorily.

4. Extraordinary Courts of Assize tried 981 cases, sentenced 40 accused to death and 4882 cases are awaiting hearing. The Courts are overworked, but there is no way of providing relief as trained personnel is not available.

5. Amnesty Decree has been implemented granting amnesty to certain common offenders for offenses committed prior to April 1944.

6. This report is not complete due to the sudden departure of three legal officers from the Region on orders, and a further supplemental report will be rendered within the next 10 days.

1. The following Regional Orders were published in June:
 - R.O.1. (Ratifying certain acts by C.L.N. and declaring future acts void).
 - R.O.2. (Civilian Movement)
 - R.O.3. (Collection of Rough Rice)
 - R.O.4. (Epuraton in Industry).
2. Normal Italian Courts are functioning satisfactorily. Shortages of personnel are known to the Ministry of Pardons and Justice but for the present that situation cannot be corrected and it is not serious.
3. Extraordinary Courts of Assize are functioning in all Provinces. Public criticism is about equally divided between those who think sentences are too lenient and those who think them too severe. The wives of those sentenced to be shot weights the latter.
4. Epuraton under G.O. 35 and 35 A appears to be satisfying the public. Commissions are functioning in all Provinces.
5. Epuraton in Private Industry is now proceeding under G.O. 46 and the indorsed R.O. 4. It is too early to report results.
6. P.O.W. and members of neo-fascist organizations continue to be a problem. The Extraordinary Courts of Assize want to try them, and the contradictory directives which we receive from A.C. and A.F.H.Q. are embarassing. We are feeling our way along at present.

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7. A.M.G. Court cases are increasing. Records of trials do not reach this office until 35 days after trial unless Petition for Review is filed, but from incomplete reports from Provinces it is estimated that about 100 cases have been tried.

8. Sequestration of Property of certain industrialists was threatened under D.L.L. 159. At a meeting with the R.C., the Legal Division, the First President of Court of Appeals, the President of the Tribunale of Turin, the President of C.L.N. and other interested parties it was agreed and conceded that such action would likely have an adverse effect upon employment and the economy of Piemonte unless the power of sequestration were cautiously exercised by the Courts. It was therefore agreed, first, that before any such order is issued the parties concerned would be notified and attempt to agree upon a consent order, second, that failing in such agreement the court would hear all interested parties and that in making any order would consider first the public interest. The President of the Court issuing the order will be held responsible that no order be issued by him which will have an adverse effect upon the economy of the Region.

9. Electoral Lists were distributed to all Provinces 28 June. The date fixed for commencement of such lists is 15 July 1945. One officer has been delegated to travel to all Provincial Capitals in the Region until 15 July for the purpose of expediting action of Italian officials.

SUBJECT: Report of Legal Division for May 1945.

TO : R.C.

Establishment of M.G. The R.L.O. and Regional O i/ch Italian Courts met with the First President and the Procuratore Generale of the Court of Appeals and other ranking Judicial officials on 11 May 1945 and from that date onward military government was established and maintained as to the Judicial branch.

Judicial Appointments. The First President and Procuratore Generale were temporarily appointed to office by C.L.N. who gave them power to make temporary appointments of Judicial officials under them. These appointees have all been continued in office. Difficulties now exist in filling some vacancies through lack of officials of appropriate grade. Where grade is prerequisite to appointment reference to the Italian Ministry is essential.

Decree Laws. These are being implemented, so far as authorized, whenever copies of the Gazzetta Ufficiale are received. D.L.L. 142 of 1945 (Extra-ordinary Courts of Assize) and D.L.L. 249 of 1944 (Fascist Republican Legislation) were given priority. It is anticipated that Extraordinary Courts of Assize will be sitting within the first week of June. D.L.L. 159 of 1944 (Sanctions against Fascists) has been implemented and those responsible for the establishment of the Courts and commissions set up under it are being urged to proceed. G.O. 35 and 35a have been published; and commissions set up in most Provinces. Many of the cases which normally have been dealt with under these orders have been disposed of before establishment of A.M.G.

People's Courts established by C.L.N. These Courts have ceased to function. Their unexecuted sentences are being regarded as legal

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warrants for arrest, and if necessary, for detention in custody. Re-adjustment of all cases where the sentence has not expired or been executed will be undertaken by competent Courts.

Prisoners of war and Fascist Crimes. Provincial commissioners have been advised of the test to determine what Italians are entitled to the status of P.O.W. Those to whom that status has been conceded are being confined to P.O.W. camps and a system evolved whereby if they are accused of crimes cognizable by Special Courts of Assizes they should be made available for trial. It is hoped that some such cases will be among the first held before these Courts and that public opinion will thus be satisfied that the guilty are not escaping justice under the cloak of P.W. status.

Italian Courts. Difficulties of finding necessary police and transport were experienced. The normal Courts, however, have continued to function.

A.M.G. Courts. The policy of having as many cases as possible dealt with the Italian Courts has proved successful. Only one case has been heard before an A.M.G. Court in the Region and there a youth was convicted under Proc. 1 of dangerous driving and making insulting remarks to Allied Officers and concerning the Allied Forces.

The Italian politician Pietro Nenni was arrested and charged with a breach of Proc. 3 but the case was not pressed following an apology by the accused. A local party leader was also charged with offence arising at the same time, and the case against him continued without day.

Proclamations and Orders. Some confusion was caused through the publication of above throughout the Region and in individual Provinces not being carried out thro' or in consultation with one central authority. Accurate records of the publications in each Province are now being made. Compliance with Regional Memorandum No 3 of 1 June 1945 will avoid confusion on this matter in the future.
