TO : H.Q., Allied Commission,

With reference to AC/4040/L of 9 Jan 45,
there is no security objection to the Minister of
Justice being given official notification of the
particulars of enemy agents executed.

It is requested however that such notification
should not be given until one calendar month after the
sentence has been carried out, unless the facts are to
be released officially to the public before that month
has elapsed. In the latter case, the Minister of Justice
should be informed at the same time as the facts are
made public.

TO : H.E., the Minister of Pardon and Justice.

1. In answer to the request made recently by Your Excellency to be supplied with particulars of persons executed in conformity with sentences of Allied Military Courts, the position is as follows:

a. In cases of no security interest, particulars will be supplied as soon as possible after execution.

b. In espionage and other security cases, particulars will be supplied at the expiration of one month from the date of execution or on public release of the execution, whichever shall be the sooner. Your Excellency will appreciate that these particulars, except in the cases where there is a public release, are to be treated as highly confidential. Will Your Excellency also please emphasize this to any officials whose duty may require them to see these particulars.

c. Particulars, so far as available, of past executions will be forwarded in the near future.

SUBJECT : Execution of Prisoners.

TO : APHQ G-2.

1. The Minister of Justice has requested that he may be officially notified of the details of persons who are executed by the Allies after sentence of death. He states that he requires this information for the purpose of maintaining his civil records.

2. It is presumed that there can be no objection to this information being supplied in cases where the accused is condemned for offences not connected with security e.g. for the murder of an Allied soldier.

3. Would you please state whether you have any objection to this information being communicated in cases of security interest. It has already been explained to the Minister that, if given, the information will have to be treated as highly confidential and that it will probably not be given until a reasonable time has elapsed after the execution.
