SUBJECT: Gazzetta Ufficiale, No. 41 of 14 November, 1944, Paragraph 1-H, "Legislative Decree of Lieutenant General, No. 803 of 2 November, 1944".

TO : Legal Sub-Commission

1. With respect to the Legislative Decree of the Lieutenant General, No. 803, signed 2 November, 1944, which increases wages for workers in private industry, it is requested that all the provisions contained in this Decree be excluded from the Provinces of Emilia, Liguria, Venezia, Lombardia and Piemonte.

2. It is further requested that in its application to A.M.G. areas in Toscana, Marche-Abruzzi e Molise, and Umbria-Lazio, Article X be specifically excluded.

3. Objection is raised to the provisions contained in Article X:

A. On Juridical Grounds

The article indirectly provides for a compulsory attempt at conciliation - the responsibility for which is made to devolve on the "de facto" associations. In consequence of this provision, a citizen who is legally claiming a right would be obliged, in the event of a dispute, to submit his case for compulsory conciliation to associations which have only a "de facto" existence and are devoid of any legal status or juridical existence. The legal is therefore subjected to the "de facto" - an untenable juridical concept.

B. On Practical Grounds

As a result of the situation outlined above, the following difficulties are likely to arise:

- (1) The citizen claiming a legal right which is being denied to him in the application of the present law would not be in a position to know if "de facto" Syndical Associations exist - there being at present no provision for registration of the Associations;
- (2) Similarly, he would not be in a position to know the official seats of the "de facto" Associations, their jurisdictional activities, and the legitimate representatives to whom the dispute would be referred for conciliation;
- (3) In order to obtain redress of a legal right, he might have to submit his case to a "de facto" Association which for its political character or for its lack of seriousness he may regard as unacceptable or not worthy of trust;
- (4) He would, moreover, have no definite guidance wherever there might come into existence two or more "de facto" associations.

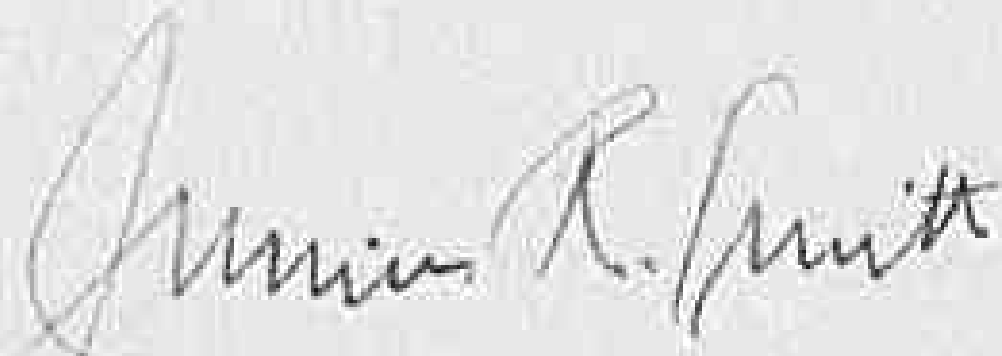

4. The provisions made by Article X are not in conformity with General Order No. 26, which devolves on the Labor Offices all attempts at conciliation and arbitration. General Order No. 26, therefore, already provides the proper machinery for the solution of these problems. Therefore, in making the Italian Decree applicable, it will only be necessary in A.E.G. territory to substitute General Order No. 26 for Article X.

5. When the text of this draft law was discussed with the Labor Sub-Commission, the provisions for arbitration were not those contained in the law as finally promulgated. In

fact, this text of Article X was never submitted either to the Labor Sub-Commission or to the Allied Commission. This raises the question as to whether the Italian Government is bound to consult A.C. with respect to any draft legislation. No directive has been issued to this Sub-Commission on this point since A.C.C. became A.C.

CIVILIAN CONTROL

1. Civilians entering HQ, A.C. may be divided into three categories:
 - a. Allied civilian personnel
 - b. Italian " "
 - c. Italian visitors
2. In view of the extent to which thieving has taken place it is necessary to exercise the strictest possible control of civilians entering the building.
3. All civilians employed in HQ. A.C. have had a pass "authority to enter HQ. A.C., Rome," issued to them.
4. All civilian visitors must enter by the main hall. They will be directed to one of the information desks and be issued with a visitor's permit against which the identity card of the visitor will be retained. An escort girl will conduct the visitors to the office required, except visitors in possession of a courtesy pass.
5. CC. RR. will examine the passes of all employees they do not recognise as such. They will also ensure that all visitors are in possession of the a/m permit. A few courtesy passes have been issued to chosen civilians who will be permitted to proceed without the visitors permit.

Visitors on leaving must hand their permit to a CC. RR. who will check the lapse of time between that written on the permit by the officer who has received the visit, and time of arrival at the exit. They will then claim the identity card.

Serious discrepancies or cases where suspicion of the Dona Fides of the visitors are aroused should be immediately reported to the Security Officer, Room when the circumstances seem to warrant it the civilian concerned should be detained.

It is important that equal attention be given to the procedure of exit as for entry.

6. All Italian civilian employees will eventually wear an identification badge. Civilian workmen will be in possession of a work-ticket showing the work necessary to be performed.

4. All civilian visitors must enter by the main hall. They will be directed to one of the information desks and be issued with a visitor's permit against which the identity card of the visitor will be retained. An escort girl will conduct the visitors to the office required, except visitors in possession of a courtesy pass.

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6. All Italian civilian employees will eventually wear an identification badge.

Civilian workmen will be in possession of a work-ticket showing the work necessary to be performed.

7. The Patrol of the corridors may ask for the documents of such civilians as they meet during their rounds who are unaccompanied by escorts or do not wear the badge.

8. Notice will be given when the badges are available.

9. On Wednesday and Saturday afternoons and on Sundays which are holidays, only specially authorized civilian employees and no visitors will be admitted, unless individually requested before hand by an officer.

During these holidays the side door to Via Molise will remain closed.

10. On other days the side door in Via Molise will be closed at 1830 hours.

11. No visitors will be permitted to enter by the side door. The Italian "OP's" on duty at the entrance to the taxi park will ask civilians seeking to enter whether or not they are employed in Headquarters Allied Commission, if they reply is affirmative the person will be allowed to pass. These OP's will not examine passes. This will be done by the CC.RR. on duty at the door. Other individuals will be directed to main entrance.

Establishment Memorandum #1, Hq Allied Commission, dtd 11 January 46, Cont'd:

12. Between 1830 hours and reveille, all persons, civilian and military, entering or leaving the building will sign the book which has been placed in the main hall for that purpose.

When it is necessary for civilian clerks to return to their offices after 1830 hours they should be in possession of a written authorization from a Officer of their Section showing such return is necessary.

If an Officer wishes to see a civilian in this building out of normal office hours he should leave a note at the reception desk giving the name of the Officer, the name of the civilian and the office to which he or she is to be conducted.

13. All civilians taking parcels out of the building will enter in the book the particulars required. Contents of the parcels may be verified by the CC.RR. or OR on duty.

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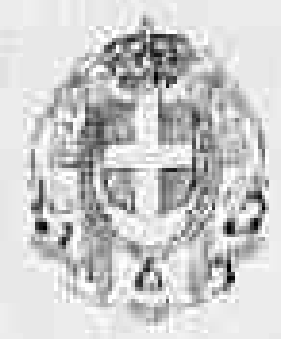

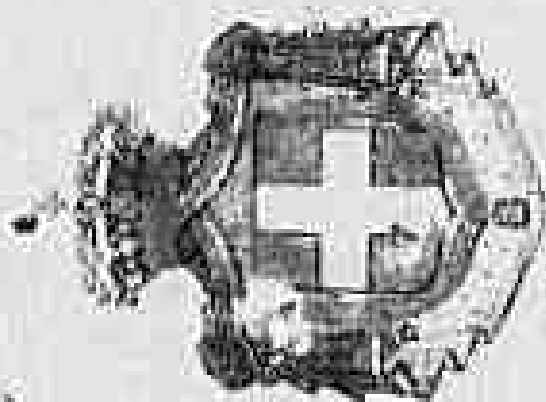

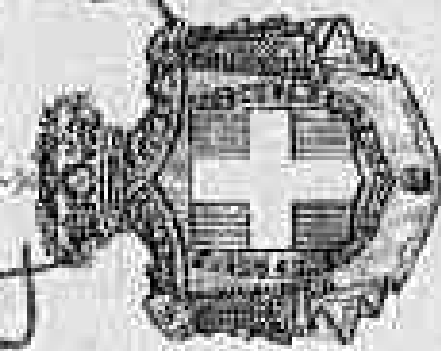

It has been brought to the Chief Commissioner's notice that Sections/Sub-Commissions of this Headquarters have, on occasion, issued directions to Regions in the North, on the assumption that Regional control has been effected. This is not the case. It must be realised that, until you are notified to the contrary, the greater part of the North is still under the administration of SCAO FIFTH or EIGHTH Army, as the case may be, and directions must not at this stage be issued to Regional Commissioners direct, but to SCAO's of Armies. There is no objection to copies being sent to Regional Commissioners for information.

2. In order that there shall be no misapprehension please note that the following Regions are still under Army control:

Duties of the Allied Commission Liaison Officers in Italian Government territory will be to watch over the Allied and Italian interests in furtherance of the Allied war effort, and to assist the Allied authorities in their relations with Italian local authorities. They will give advice to the Allied military authorities on any matter pertaining to Italian civil affairs, but will no longer be concerned with the assumption of advice or guidance to the Italian authorities. Neither will they assume functions which are properly those of military authorities. Personnel will normally confine their activities to the neighborhood of the HQ in which they are located, but in cases of necessity they will of course deal with all matters arising from civil affairs affecting Allied interests within the Regional boundaries.

4. Regional Commissioners will take steps to complete these moves by 1 April 1945. Further instructions will be issued by the

They will give advice to the Allied military authorities on any matter pertaining to Italian civil affairs, but will no longer be concerned with the assumption of advice or guidance to the Italian authorities. Neither will they assume functions which are properly those of military authorities. Personnel will normally confine their activities to the neighbourhood of the HQ in which they are located, but in cases of necessity they will of course deal with all matters arising from civil affairs affecting Allied interests within the Regional boundaries.

4. Regional Commissioners will take steps to complete these moves by 1 April 1945. Further instructions will be issued by the Establishment Section.

Reply to letter no. 1/4/1 of 24 July 1944.

TO : AGC, Interior Sub-Commission.

In reference to the letter indicated above we wish to point out the following :

1) There can be no doubt in connection with the name of the provincial circumscription of Rome, as the expression "Province of Rome" is that constantly used in Italian legislation.

This name can therefore also be introduced in the act mentioned in the letter indicated above.

2) In regards to the territory of the city of Rome, called Governatorat of Rome, in fascist legislation, we point out that it is the intention of the Italian Government to replace this denomination with the "Commune of Rome".

We trust that this intention may soon be realized in a legislative provision.

Meanwhile, in the acts relative to the transfer of administration, the use of the word "Governatorat" can be avoided by using "Province of Rome" instead, since the latter includes also the territory of the city of Rome proper.

2. Regional Commissioner, Region III will thereafter exercise supervision and control under ACC conditions throughout Region III with the exception of the Comune of NAPLES (which includes the City and Port of NAPLES) in which Allied Military Government will continue.
3. Regional Commissioner, Region V, will exercise similar supervision and control over the administration of CASERTA Province while administering the remaining Provinces of ABRUZZI and the MARCHE under Allied Military Government.
4. As from the date defined above, FOGGIA Province (Provincial Commissioner, Colonel C.R. Temperley) will be detached from Region V and will, temporarily, pass under direct command of ACC HQ. This Province, which lies in the compartmento of Apulia, will eventually pass to the command of Region II.
5. Adjutants of staff, transport and supplies are now being prepared by the Regional Commissioner, Region V and Provincial Commissioner, FOGGIA, and will be submitted to the Sections concerned for approval.
6. This will not be made public until further orders.

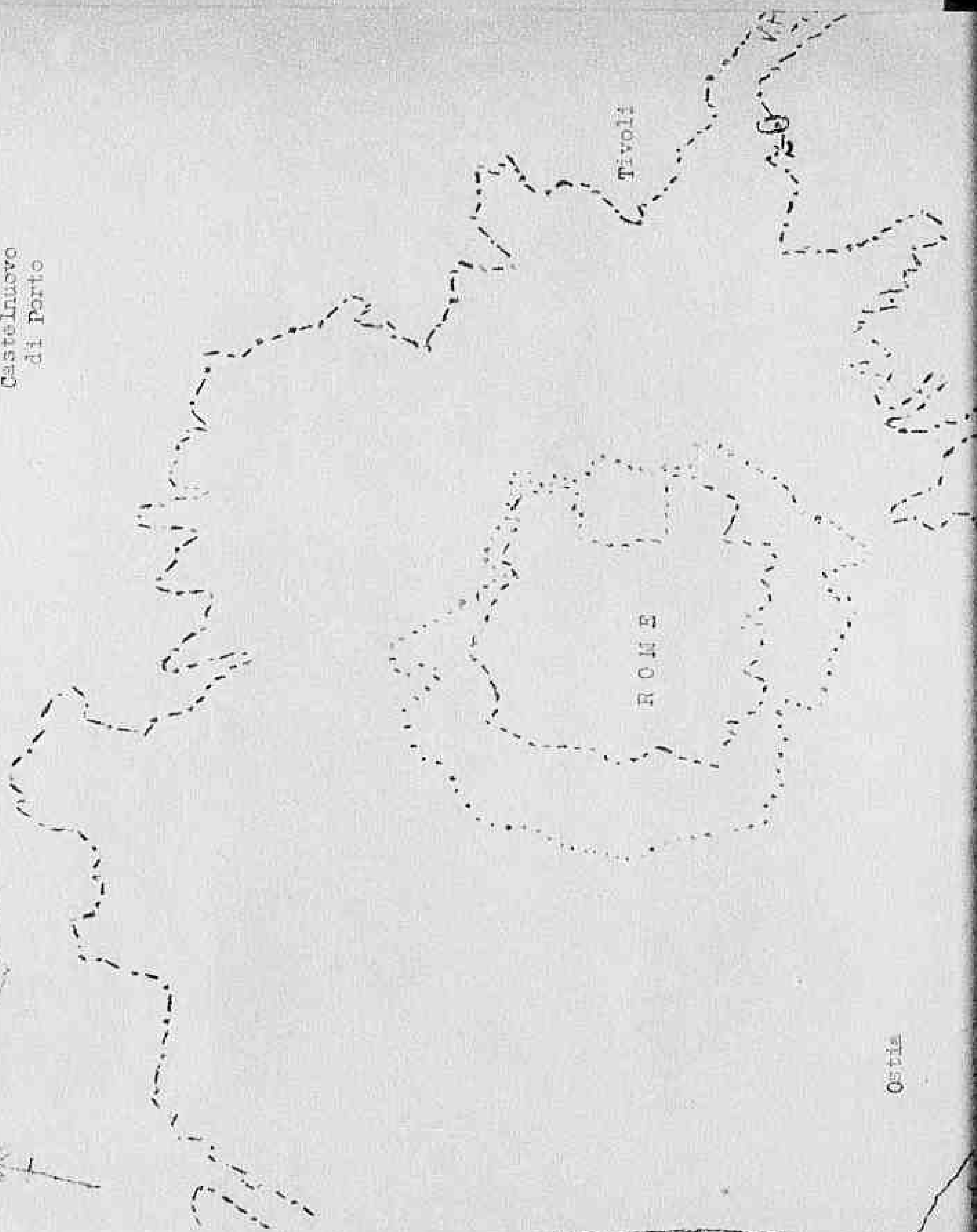

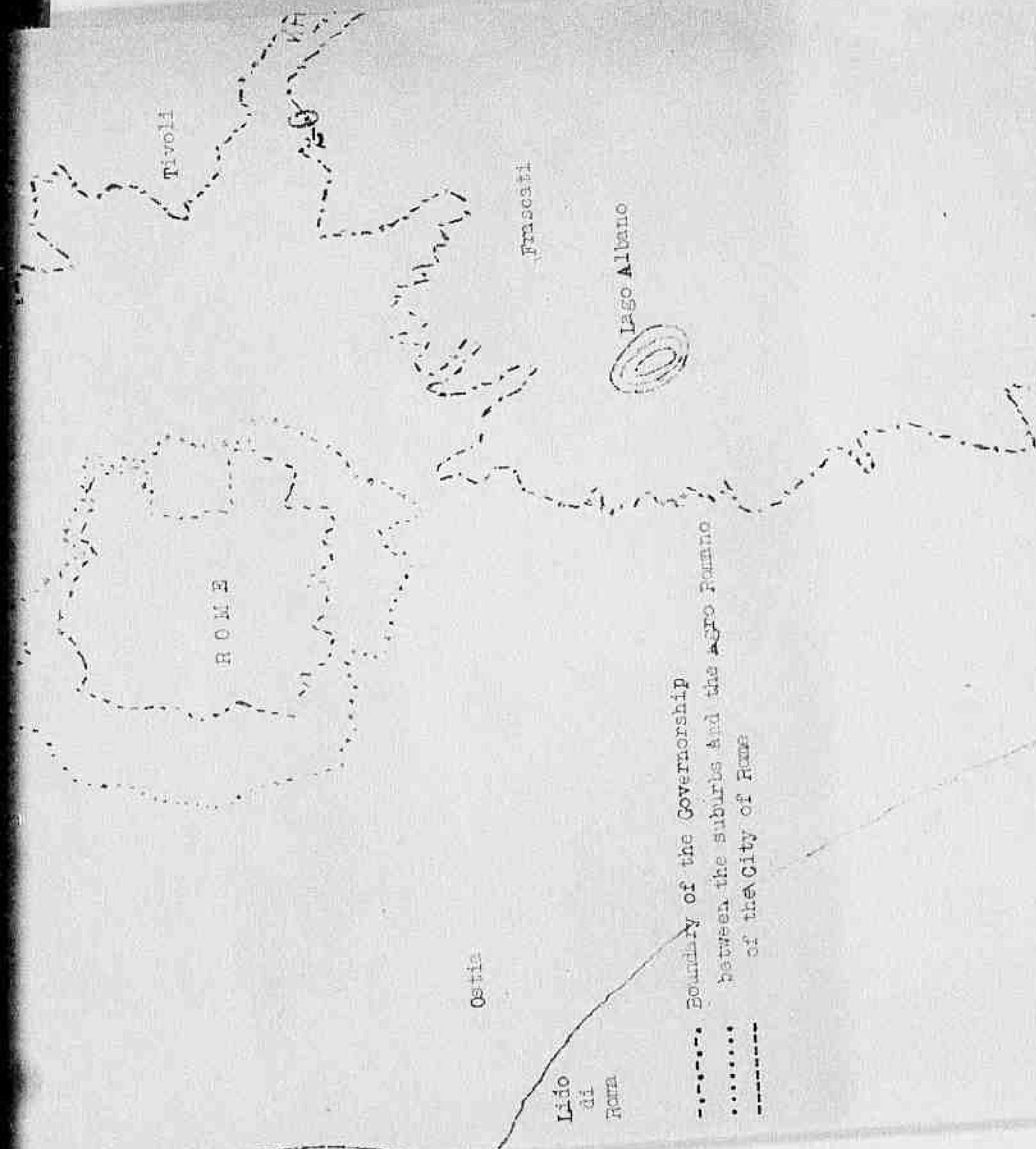

1. The question has been raised by Regional Legal Officer, Region 4 (RM/LR/Reg/L/1 dated 8 May 44) as to the relationship of SLO, Rome Sub-Region with legal officers Region 4 and 5th and 8th Army, and the following defines their relationship:

- a. SLO, Rome Sub-Region will be responsible to SCAG, 5th Army and NOT to RLO, Region 4 until Rome Sub-Region is taken over by Region 4 (see Exec Memo No. 33).
- b. SCAG, 5th Army may appoint SLO, Rome Sub-Region (if of rank of major or above) to review cases in Rome Sub-Region in his behalf in accordance with Article 32 (4) of Consolidated Instructions for Allied Military Courts.
- c. Rome Sub-Region being within an Army area until taken over by Region 4, Article 32 3 a will apply.
- d. In cases where under Article 32 3 a the case has to be reviewed by the Chief Commissioner the record will be sent direct by SLO, Rome Sub-Region and NOT through SLO, 5th Army, and will be returned direct.
- e. The SLO, Rome Sub-Region may dispose of the record in accordance with Article 31.5 if he so desires.
- f. The allotment, control and responsibilities of personnel between Region 4 and Rome Sub-Region is entirely a matter for arrangement between Region 4 and Rome Sub-Region and should only be submitted to this HQ in the event of some difficulty arising.

2. It will be for RLO, Region 4 to notify this HQ and RLO, Region 3 as soon as practicable of his requirements of personnel so that RLO, Region 3 may have as long notice as possible of the impending removal of officers assigned to Region 4 who are temporarily attached to him.

The Western group of the PONTINE Islands of which PONZA is the largest, will be transferred from Region IV (Province of Littoria) to Region III (Province of NAPLES). The island is already being administered by Region III and the change is, therefore, merely for the purpose of record.

REORGANIZATION OF REGIONS.

1. Owing to the great difficulty of lateral communications on the Italian peninsula in war time it has been decided to reorganize Regions IV and V on an east and west basis.
2. Effective 0001 hours 15 Feb Region IV will comprise the compartments of LAZIO and UMBRIA and Region V will comprise the compartments of MARCHE and ABRUZZI together with the province of FOGGIA.
3. Control of FOGGIA Province passes from Region IV to Region V with effect from 0001 hours 15 Feb. Further territory will be taken over by these two Regions from S.C.A.O's. AME 5 and 8 Armies as and when the Army Rear Boundaries move forward.
4. Consequent upon the restoration to the jurisdiction of the Italian Government of Regions I and II (exclusive of the islands of Pantellaria, Lampedusa and Linosa) the Regional Commissioner of Region II has taken over control of A.C.C. activities in the Provinces of Bari, Brindisi, Lecce and Taranto as from 0001 hours on 11 Feb 44.
5. Region III will remain, as at present, in control of the Provinces of Naples, Benevento and Avellino.
6. Until further notice correspondence for Region V will be addressed c/o Provincial Commissioner, FOGGIA Province.
