Further to this HQ letter of even number dated 4 Feb 46.

1. The foreign born wives and families of British Service personnel now residing in the CMF will be entitled to certain facilities under a scheme known as Families Scheme "B".

2. Applications from personnel eligible who have not already applied will be forwarded to G-1 (B) Section this HQ in accordance with the proforma forwarded under the above quoted letter.

3. In cases where there are children by a previous marriage it may not be possible to provide accommodation for them, and on this account a soldier may be excluded from the scheme.

4. It is pointed out that accommodation for married families is limited and it may not be possible to include all applicants in this scheme.

5. The provision of accommodation for families from UK under Families Scheme "A" will take priority over Families Scheme "B".

6. A soldier may make application for quarters for his wife if she is resident outside ITALY but in CMF (i.e., resident in GREECE or NORTH AFRICA) and if he is granted quarters his wife will be given free passage to his station.

7. The following additional instructions will apply to Families Scheme "B":

The wives and families of officers and other ranks residing in this Theatre should be protected against the following diseases:-

Smallpox	- by vaccination
Enteric group disease	- by TAB inoculation
Typhus	- by TAV inoculation

In addition, the protective inoculation of children against ~~at this time~~ is strongly recommended.

3. In cases where there are no other arrangements possible to provide accommodation for them, and on this account a soldier may be excluded from the scheme.

4. It is pointed out that accommodation for married families is limited and it may not be possible to include all applicants in this scheme.

5. The provision of accommodation for families from UK under Families Scheme "A" will take priority over Families Scheme "B".

6. A soldier may make application for quarters for his wife if she is resident outside ITALY but in CMF (i.e., resident in GREECE or NORTH AFRICA) and if he is granted quarters his wife will be given free passage to his station.

7. The following additional instructions will apply to Families Scheme "B":

The wives and families of officers and other ranks residing in this Theatre should be protected against the following diseases:-

Smallpox	- by vaccination
Enteric group disease	- by TAB inoculation
Typhus	- by TAV inoculation

In addition, the protective inoculation of children against ~~diphtheria~~ is strongly recommended.

Special examinations (e.g. "X"-ray, blood tests, microscopical examinations, etc.) will be charged as laid down by Allowance Regulations 1944 Article 71 para 9.

8. In the case of Officers or other Ranks who are not eligible under this scheme owing to the fact that the husband has less than three months to serve in this theatre, application can be made for the husband to live at the wife's place of residence.

9. Permission can be granted by the soldiers' Commanding Officers subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The place of residence will be inspected under arrangements to be made by ADMS, Rome Area Allied Command, and passed as suitable;
- (b) Application will be made to 52 Town Major, ROME, who will issue the soldier with the necessary authority to live in a private residence in ROME.

10. These wives and families will be entitled to Medical and Dental treatment, and EPI rations can be drawn by the husband through his own unit for his wife and family on the same basis as Medical treatment and EPI supplies are provided under Families Scheme "B".

11. These wives and families will not be entitled to rations.

(c) (i) All officers who are absent from their unit on account of sickness, temporary duty or ordinary leave, will, providing they are retaining the services of their civilian servants, certify same in accordance with the attached proforma 'B'.

(ii) If retention of servant certificates are not rendered for periods of absence it will be assumed that officers concerned have not retained the services of their civilian servants, and issue of allowance will cease automatically for the period of absence.

3. Both forms of certificate will be fully completed (in duplicate) by the officer concerned, and will be countersigned by Chief Liaison Officer or Head of Sub-Commission as appropriate. They will be forwarded to this H.Q. with the relevant casualty (AC Form R.5) which will be endorsed accordingly "certificate 'A' (or 'B') attached".

4. Officers on the present posted or attached strength of this Commission, being absent on attachment, been absent

(b) (i) All officers who are absent from their unit on account of sickness, temporary duty or ordinary leave, will, providing they are retaining the services of their civilian servants, certify same in accordance with the attached proforma 'B'.

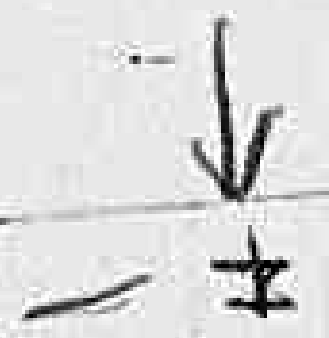
