1. Reference is made to paragraphs 6 and 7 of this HQ letter G-1B/144/A dated 18 Oct 45 on the above subject.

2. The latest position with regard to officers in release group 21 is that they may be released at any time between 12 Nov 45 and 10 Feb 46. They will in any event be released on 10 Feb 46, but may be considered for release before that date, as and when they become surplus to THEATRE requirements. It is emphasised that the mere declaration that any individual officer is surplus to the requirements of this Commission will not result in that officer's release. He must be declared by GHQ to be surplus to the requirements of the theatre before his release can be entertained. It is, however, known to be the policy of GHQ to release as many officers as possible in Group 21, when once present commitments have been met.

3. The release of officers in Group 22 will not begin before 11 Feb 46, but officers in Groups 22 - 24 may apply for reversion to Home Establishment or release on compassionate grounds. In considering such applications, full weight will be given to the fact that an officer may have arranged to take up a civil appointment or have entered into domestic commitments in expectation of release under the earlier programme.

for the purpose of Release or Discharge

1. WOs and NCOs proceeding to the UK for the sole purpose of release under Release Regulations 1945 or of discharge from the Army will retain paid acting ranks and appointments from the date of leaving their units for embarkation, during the period of the voyage until the commencement of release or discharge leave, when the terms of War Office letter 18/Gen/3646(AGLD) dated 10 July 45 will apply.
2. Paid acting ranks and paid lance appointments will also be retained by personnel proceeding to their country of domicile overseas on repatriation from the UK or direct from an overseas command, for the purpose of discharge from the Army.
3. Acting ranks or lance appointments which on the date of leaving the unit had not been held for a minimum of 21 days will not be retained under this authority.

6. Regular soldiers with reserve service to complete will revert to their war substantive rank on transfer to the Royal Army Reserve. Such reversion will be published as a casualty in Part II Orders and will be recorded in documents in the usual way.
7. Service after the commencement of terminal or release leave will not reckon towards the qualifying period for time promotion under the Royal Warrant for Pay 1940, Articles 302-327.
8. This letter will apply where appropriate to auxiliaries of the AIS.

Subject : Voluntary Deferment of release.

1. It is known that there is uncertainty in many officers' minds over the reasons which prompt AFHQ to authorize most applications for Voluntary Deferment of release until General Demobilization, whereas a considerable number of applications for voluntary deferment for one or two years are rejected.

2. The following extract from a letter recently received by this HQ from AFHQ is accordingly forwarded for information:-

"1. It is not possible to give a firm statement of policy, except in general terms, since each case of deferment has of necessity to be treated individually and on its merits.

2. It should be noted that, whereas deferment until final demobilisation may be terminated at any time that an officer's service may no longer be required by the Army, deferment for one or two years is in the nature of a contract which guarantees employment for the period stated. This means that the cases of volunteers for one or two years must be more carefully considered than those for the more indefinite period."

4. Testimonials will be prepared in such a manner that they will help soldiers' future employers to know exactly what the bearer is capable of doing.
5. The co-operation of all officers concerned with the welfare of ORs is requested in this matter as it is considered that ORs who have served with this Commission should return to civil life with the fairest possible chance of finding suitable employment quickly.

- 2. Several ORs have arrived at this HQ with no entries on their ATs 1122 and who are known to be of exemplary character; their assessment of military conduct has been given as "GOOD" when this should have been "EXEMPLARY". If an officer does not know an other rank's character he should apply to the C.O. under whom the other rank concerned previously served.
- 3. Attention of all OGC British Detachments is drawn to the following paragraphs in King's Regulations 1940 - 423, 424, 425, 426, 427, 428 and 429. The instructions concerning assessment of character as outlined in the aforementioned paragraphs will be closely followed.
- 4. Testimonials will be prepared in such a manner that they will help soldiers' future employers to know exactly what the bearer is capable of doing.
- 5. The co-operation of all officers concerned with the welfare of ORs is requested in this matter as it is considered that ORs who have served with this Commission should return to civil life with the fairest possible chance of finding suitable employment quickly.
