1. Reference your R5/511/17 of 27 June 44, addressed to Rear Hq. your attention is drawn to our letter 278/188/CA of 29 June 1944.
2. Your original letter of 9 June 44, asked for certain proclamations and orders to be forwarded to you stating that "at the moment there is no need for any further deliveries but it would be appreciated if the totals of the proclamations and orders could be brought up to 4000 in due course". There was no indication of urgency and the only other information we had from you was on 25 June when you stated they were urgently required and the necessary copies were forwarded to you on 26 June 1944. Partial action was taken on your original letter and then full request was met on receipt of your second letter.
3. Legal Sub-Commission advised this Hq. on the 15th that you desired 300 copies as soon as possible. At that time the matter was in the hands of the printers and we had to wait until the printer had run off some more copies. Your reference to repeated request is therefore not understood.
4. Legal Sub-Commission have also advised you that the old Proclamations No. 5 and 12 are out of print. This Section has none of these old proclamations in stock as they were handled by Legal Sub-Commission. We are however asking Region III if they have any on hand and if this is so, we shall forward them to you. It is suggested that you might consider having copies printed. We are prepared to assist but it is pointed out if you wish us to have these printed it will take a little time as the printers are very busy at the moment with proclamations, orders etc.
5. With regard to old General Orders Nos. 18 and 20, this is not understood here as there were no old Orders of such numbers. Copies of Order No. 20 have been forwarded to you and copies of No. 18 will be sent to you as soon as possible.

1. The C.I.G. has just returned from a visit to Region 5 and has been asked by the Regional Legal Officer to pass the following message to AF and AF Section.

While I have no desire to be obstructive, I still consider that it would be most convenient for supplies of Proclamations to be delivered by you to Armies direct, as agreed at the meeting, and distributed by them to P.Cs. as required. At any time when proclamations, etc., require to be posted P.Cs. will invariably be acting under the orders of the respective Army Commander, and not under this H.Q. Distribution through Regional H.Q. would therefore be irregular, and would possibly present difficulties, since Regional H.Q. will not necessarily be in touch with Provincial H.Q. during the operational phase.

3. However, I am prepared to cooperate in any system of distribution that may be arranged. For your information, my estimate of the number of proclamations, etc. required by Region 4 is 10,500, made up as follows:-

1. Referring to my letter OA/73 of 26 April, 44, I understood from my S.L.O. when he last went down to Salerno that the new Proclamations would be up with Eighth Army by 6th May. Subsequently it is understood they were being brought up by an officer to arrive here on 7th May, and I am now informed that they will be delivered on Thursday next week at a Conference being called at Caserta.

2. I have sent two messages down by telephone today to the effect that unless the Proclamations arrive here tomorrow morning it will be impossible to distribute them in time. I wish to stress this point and to make it quite clear that I have no Proclamations available to issue in the event of any advance being made, and if these Proclamations do not arrive, I cannot accept responsibility for posting proclamations in freshly occupied territory.
