SUBJECT: Bar Association.

TO : H.E. the Minister of Justice.

1. Since January the Legal Sub-Commission has been urging that legislation be enacted setting up the Bar Association on non-fascist lines. We have received frequent inquiries about that.

2. Originally in Italy a general order was issued by Allied Military Government doing away with the fascist bar association and creating a new one. However one created in that way may only be temporary in form and it seems to me that the Italian Government which has been in a position to do so for many months should now enact permanent legislation setting up the Bar Association on non-fascist lines.
