Subject : Release of prisoners.

To : The Minister of War and Justice.

1. Two cases have recently been brought to the office of this Commission of a tempt made in Italian Government territory to secure the release of prisoners held in gaols by the use of forged release orders purporting to be signed by Allied officers, these forgeries were so expert that they were detected only by accident.

2. In order to prevent unauthorized persons from effecting releases from Italian prisons of prisoners who are at the disposition of the Allies it is requested that you inform the Directors of all prisons and jails and others responsible for custody of prisoners in territory that has been turned back to the Italian Government that no prisoner who is at the disposition of the Allies will be released before the expiration of his sentence except upon orders from the office of the Minister of War and Justice, upon receipt of communication from this Sub-Commission stating its decision or action in such case.

3. This practice will apply only to the territory that has been turned back to the Italian Government.

4. It will be the policy of the Legal Sub-Commission to communicate to the Minister of War and Justice the action of the Sub-Commission in altering the sentence of any prisoner held at the disposition of the Allies in territory that has been returned to the Italian Government, or in denying the petition of any such prisoner.

SUBJECT : SAMTEO CARLO DI ROMANICO.

1. In the above case, the conviction and sentence are affirmed.

2. In disposing of the \$50,000 lire, an order was entered by the Court that the sum is confiscated. It is necessary to modify such order.

3. It is undisputed that the accused stole 85 sacks of American sugar. It follows, therefore, that title to such sugar at all times remained in the United States Government. Not having title, the accused could not possess title on the alleged sale. The money which he received in exchange for the property was held by him as trustee or as a depositor or bailee for the United States Government and the Court should have entered a proper order turning over such funds to the United States Government.

4. The distinction is important. As I understand it, funds forfeited by the Court as additional punishment find their way to the Italian Treasury. The sugar or its value represents tax money expended from the treasury of the United States. Being in the nature of stolen property, under Article 28, paragraph 3, b, the Court enters proper order that the stolen property will be returned to the true owner.

The Court, therefore, should cause the record to deal with this subject matter accordingly, and action should be taken to effectuate its execution.


2. This was the form used by Major Glenn and the signature "Vannini" is known to me to be the name of his secretary, so it appears authentic on its face.

1. Returned herewith is your letter and attached report Q-1B/16120/3,6/1/0 of 12 September 1945.

2. It is apparent, from the facts as alleged, that the case is not one which would have been submitted to this HQ for review; notwithstanding a search has been made of the regional records - (Lazio-Umbria and Emilia-Marche) - but no record of trial could be found in the case of Monk Paolo di Giovanni. It is quite possible that the matter was not submitted to the Courts for adjudication in which event a record of such trial could not exist.

3. Since the officers in question are not available, as stated in the attached report, it is suggested that the prison records could be consulted and thereby determine from the order of release,

- (a) if N.G.I. was ever tried by an Allied Military Court, and
- (b) by whose authority N.G.I. obtained his release.

1. See your letter 15 September 1945, AC/5003, case of
Buzzati Vittore.

2. The accused was charged with making a false statement in
connection with an official matter. It was alleged that on or about
10 June 45, at Milan, as general secretary of the Hotel Albergo Trieste,
he made a false statement in his "scheda personale" denying he had
been a fascist "antisocial" or "squadrista".

3. The prosecution produced the "scheda personale" of the
accused. In response to the question, "Have you any of the qualifications:
Antisocial? Squadrista?" the accused answered therein "No". There was
introduced into the record as Exhibit B, a membership card in the Partito
Nazionale Fascista, which appears regular in all respects and bears the
photograph and signature of the accused. This card discloses that the
accused was inscribed in the fascist party as of 10 May 1921. There was
introduced as Exhibit "C" a letter from the Federazione provinciale
Umbria addressed to the accused by notation on the fold on the back
stating addressed to the accused by notation on the fold on the back
side, which purports to show that accused was a Squadrista on 31 October
1922 and was charged with the duty of commanding certain squads.

4. In the instant case in the judgment of the Court there appears
the following (page 5):

"In my judgment the letter, (Proc. Ex. 3) is insufficient
to establish the fact that defendant was a squadrista, and there is no
other evidence tending to prove the fact."

The original membership card (Proc. Ex. 2) is regular in
every respect and proves prima facie that the defendant was a
member of the fascist party in good standing through out the year 1923
and that the date of his inscription in the party was 10 May 1921. The
original card having been offered and received in evidence, it became
the duty of the defendant to raise in the mind of the Court a reasonable

doubt as to the date of his inscription in the party as evidenced by the card. This the defendant has failed to do".

5. From the above it is really apparent that the card (exhibit B) was measured by a rule of law which differs from that with which the letter (exhibit C) was measured. The prima facie proof accorded the card (exhibit B) is rejected as to the letter (exhibit C); the court plainly indicates that as to exhibit C other proof was requisite.

6. The prima facie proof given by the Court to exhibit B can be sustained if the document in question was outside the boundaries of hearsay evidence. The rule excluding hearsay evidence is applicable to written or documentary evidence, as well as to oral evidence. A statement of a person who is not called upon as a witness is none the less "hearsay" because it has been reduced to writing, and is offered in that form to the Court. (in the instant case the Court recognized and applied such rule to exhibit C). But in its application to documents of a public or official character the rule is subject to many important qualifications. In the case of many (but not all) such documents, there are statements which they contain are, either under the general law or under express statutory provisions, admissible as evidence of the matter to which they relate. This is so, not because such documents are an exception to the rule but because the law induces a presumption that persons shown to be acting as public officers are presumed to be legally in office and to perform their duties properly.

7. Italian law indulges in such presumption in many of its documents of a public or official character. The question arises, was the document offered as "exhibit B" within such favored class? We are unable to answer this question as the record is silent on that premise.

8. In answer to question (a) paragraph 4 of your letter, we give our opinion that in the absence of a rule of law cloathing such card with a presumption that the same is evidence of the matters to which it relates, it was admissible in evidence as hearsay but within the boundaries of the rules set forth in Consolidated Instructions.

9. In answer to question (b) of paragraph 4, it is our opinion that the customs, rules and regulations of the Fascist political party are controlling on the issue if whether or not by his conduct and that of the party a person was a member of the party and a "fascista" or "quadrista". Even if a membership card carries a presumption as to matters to which it relates, it is still open to proof whether such facts are true. The issues of fact must be decided by the court on the evidence and under the rules prescribed for its observance. 103

10. If and when this absent matter is disclosed if it is still desired we will glad to rule on the case in the light of what has been written.

This case does not seem to me to present so difficult a question. It is really a question of fact to be decided by the Court. I, myself, did the accused make a false statement or not? I am sure that he never thought he had not been "ambassador" [redacted]. The P.L.O. wants me to make a question of fact, which is not a proper function for us. The trial officer hears the evidence and views the witness, and it is only our concern to determine whether there is sufficient evidence to support his finding. I do not think it is ours for us to give a yes or no answer to (a) & of the letter of P.L.O. In short, in 1927 it seems that he was not recognized by the Party to be an "antemarxist". But this does not mean that he had never ~~been~~ been an "antemarxist". The cards are for different periods. One was issued in 1923 and the other in 1927. It is quite within the realm of possibility that he fell from grace in the years the Party officers and were not accorded a high status in the year 1927.

The Schab Personal does not ask whether you are now a member of the "Antemarxist"; but asks whether you have held the position of "Antemarxist".

The audience quizzed the Trial Court in Princeton that at one time, at least, he had held this position, regardless of the fact that the evidence showed without dispute that in later years he was not an Antemarxist.

Recommendation: That we inform the P.L.O. that the evidence is sufficient to affirm the finding of the Trial Officer to the effect that Schab probably stated in this Schab Personal that he had not been a member of the "Antemarxists".



1. The General Court appointed by your Order of 24 Aug. 45 consisting of the undersigned and Captain N.A. Dickens and 1st Lt. Edward E. Nevans Jr. assembled at Cuneo on 6th Sep. 45. On that and the two succeeding days it heard evidence in the charges of homicide of an Algerian soldier against TOSELLLO Spirito and concealment of the corpse against MARRO Giovanni.

2. In each case a unanimous verdict of Not Guilty was returned and it was ordered that the accused who had been in prison for over three months be released.

3. The French Authorities were invited to send an officer to observe the trials or to assist in the prosecution. An officer did attend on the first morning and for part of the first afternoon. He did not understand English or Italian and the proceedings were translated for his benefit into French. He assisted the Court by translating from Arabic to French in the case of one witness.

4. One French military witness, the companion of the dead man on the day he was killed did not appear. It was stated that one week before the trial he had been repatriated to North Africa for demobilisation.

5. In his absence the case for the prosecution rested on the confessions of the accused. In the homicide case that confession covered only the firing of certain shots and evidence for the defence established the place of firing as in a small community of six or seven houses. There was no evidence that death resulted from these shots and some evidence that later the dead man went out of the village possibly followed by the accused. French medical opinion placed the place of death as some 500 metres outside the village; death as almost instantaneous; and the wound as one with which the

deceased could not crawl far less walk.

6. There being no satisfactory evidence of Tosello following the deceased out of the village or of his firing any other shots the finding was as stated.

7. In the concealment case Marro acted on orders of his superior who was then exercising a form of police activity under A.M.G. and in agreement with the French Forces occupying the district. He did not carry out the order personally but through civilians to whom he relayed it. The Penal Code covers his case: the order, for reasons given by his superior, appeared a lawful one which he was not entitled to question and he is not therefore punishable. The concealment was anyway not from the competent authority. - A.M.G. - to whom the matter was reported.



In default of fine accused is to serve one year of imprisonment additional. The sentences of 3 years imprisonment on charges three and five are to run concurrently. Under the provisions of Consolidated Instructions, Article 26, paragraph 3, "suspended sentence", (pages 67 and 68) a sentence suspended by a Court or reviewing authority, remains in suspense during the continuance of Allied Military Government. In the event of an alleged breach of any such terms or conditions upon which the sentence was suspended two methods are available for the putting into effect the whole of the suspended sentence:

- (a) The accused may be brought before the first available Summary Court (not necessary the court which imposed the sentence) and if such breach is proved by evidence the court will order the accused to serve the original sentence or such part of it as was suspended; or
- (b) A subsequent conviction by an Allied Military Court for any offense shall have the effect of putting into effect the whole of any suspended sentence unless the court otherwise directs.

3. In the instant case, a portion of the sentence was suspended conditioned on accused's good behavior during the continuance of Allied Military Government. In the terms of Consolidated Instructions, "The sentence remains in suspense". The alleged breach does not, ipso facto, change such suspense; there still remains to be followed the procedure, judicial in nature, available for such cases.

On July 23, 1944, the farmer Fabbri Pietro di Domenico (licensed to sell his products in the suburban market of via Montebello) was arrested by agents of the R. Guard of Finance who were on guard duty on the checking points established by the Inv. of A.M.G. around the city of Rome. He was charged with attempting to bring vegetable onto the market by illegal paths and outraging the soldiers on duty.

Fabbri was taken with his cartload of vegetables (horse-drawn) to the market of Via Montebello where the vegetables were sold. The sum obtained (Lire 3,808,00) was deposited in the Bank of Italy and a money order taken out. The money order, No. 418098 A of 24.7.1944 was sent by this office with letter No. 207 of 28.7.1944, to the Black Market Control Division, Rome (Via Lucullo).

Since in the meantime the Black Market Control Division had ceased to function in the city of Rome and the staff had been transferred to North Italy, I telephoned Miss Sini Ernes (former employee of the Division) to know what had been done with the Bank of Italy money order in question. Miss Sini replied that the money-order, together with others of the Black Market Control Division, had been changed into a post-office current account (judicial account) in the name of Fabbri and sent, with a list of others, to the Procura del Regno in the Civil and Penal Law Courts of Rome, pending proceedings on this case. Miss Sini was unable to give the particulars of the current account book in question because the list accompanying the current accounts sent to Procura del Regno (last February) was forwarded, along with other official documents of the Division, to the Allied Commission of Rome.

We wish to inform you of the above in order to know whether Fabbri has the right to the sum of lire 3,808 obtained from the confiscated products. If so, he must present himself at the Commission to secure the authorization required to draw the current account book from the Procura del Regno. The particulars of the books should be given in the list mentioned above.
