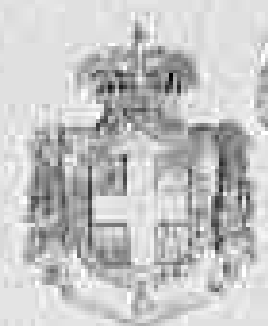
SUBJECT: FALVO, Antonio

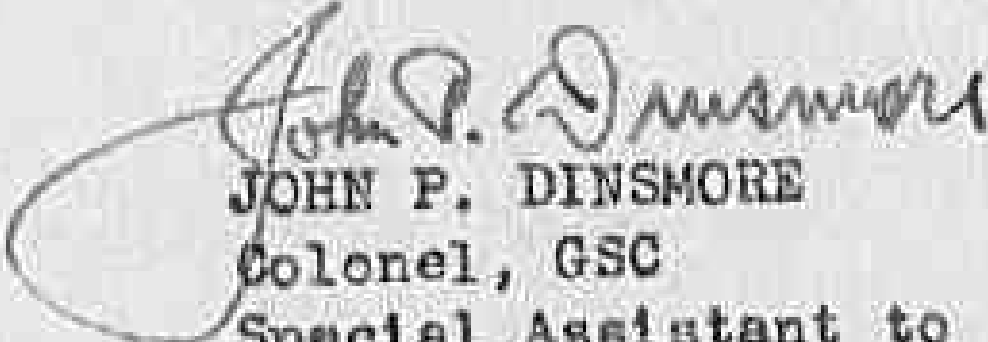

Dear Mr. Cavallaro;

Your cousins Gregorio Cavallaro and Antonino Cavallaro have requested me to refer to you the case of your other cousin Umberto Cavallaro, who was sentenced by the Allied court to seven year imprisonment.

Enclosed herewith is a copy of a letter I sent to Admiral Stone, head of the Allied Commission here, a copy of a letter I received from Col. Behrens and a copy of my answer to Col. Behrens; all of which are self explanatory. Speaking from one lawyer to another, I can assure you that the case was a frame up and a bad one at that and as I pointed out to Admiral Stone, Cavallaro was not guilty of a conspiracy, nor even of aiding and abetting. The judges evidently took a dislike of him, because he tried to fight for his rights and sentenced him just for that and nothing else. For the present I will send you these copies and later if you see you can do something for him, tell me what you want and I will try to send it to you, or perhaps you can get it through the authorities in Washington. Here in Italy the military authorities do not use the American system of protecting a man's right; here they are arrested, kept in jail for an indefinite length of time, without permitting him to have a lawyer, or released on bail and if they find nothing against him he is let out, without any recourse. This is practiced by the C.I.C. and C-D-I-.

Till yet I have received no reply to my letter of July 14th. addressed to Col. Behrens. In case I should receive an answer or any thing should develop that would change the situation, I will keep you informed.

I would suggest that you take this matter up with the Legal Department of the War and State Department and also get some Congressman interested in the matter. Perhaps Congressman Mercadante would handle the matter. I think he will remember me, I was from 1914 till 1921 Assistant U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of New York. If you see him, give him my best regards and tell him that the Italian people ^{very} are grateful for what he has done and is doing for them. Please let me hear from you as soon as possible, and with kindest regards, I am,

Dear Mr. Cavallaro,

I have received your letter and examined the documents you have sent me concerning your cousin Umberto.

As the decision taken against him has been issued by the Allied Military authorities, I don't see how our Government could possibly interfere and have it reconsidered at the present time, all the more so as the sentence has already been reduced from seven to four years.

I think, however, that when the Italian Government shall have regained full capacity also in matters concerning violations of Allied military regulations, it may be possible to have this case taken up again.

At all events, if you believe that your cousin is entirely guiltless and that the judgment against him is wholly unfounded, there would be ground for our Government to call attention to the case in high levels.

SUBJECT: Case of Cavallaro Umberto

TO : E. Paul Yaselli

1. The Chief Commissioner has referred to me your letter of 8 July 1945 on the Case of Cavallaro Umberto with instructions to reply thereto.

2. At the outset I must draw your attention to the provisions of Rule 23 of the Rules of Procedure for Allied Military Courts which stipulates, inter alia, that petitions for review of cases tried in the courts must be signed either personally by the accused or by the lawyer who appeared for him at the trial. You did not appear for the accused at the trial, and it is therefore only by courtesy that your petitions on behalf of the accused have been considered.

3. Furthermore this case has been very carefully reviewed by several Legal officers. I have not myself personally been interested in or concerned with the case at any time.

4. As a result of the reviews which have been made the Legal officers who studied the case came to the conclusion

a) that it was a pure question of fact whether or not your client was a party to the conspiracy with Catullo to bribe the soldiers. There was plenty of evidence upon which the court could come to the conclusion that he was a party to such conspiracy, and in fact the reviewing officers considered that such conclusion was natural and proper on the evidence and

b) that the further evidence which it was desired to submit on behalf of Cavallaro could not assist the case. Indeed the statement which the proposed witness was prepared to make appeared to prove conclusively the guilt of Cavallaro.

5. In these circumstances I do not consider that any further action is necessary in this case.

Sir;

Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of July 11th 1945 regarding the above matter, contents of which have been duly noted.

I thank you for the information contained in paragraph two of your said letter. With regards thereto, I called at your office to ascertain the procedure in such a case, but, was told that no information could be given and as a favor, your Sergeant gave me the address of the Region where I could file an application.

With regards to the rest of your letter, if you do not consider that any further action is necessary in the case, my client requests me to take the matter up with the Washington D.C. authorities and I will accordingly comply with his request.

May I, on this occasion, call to your attention a letter dated March 17th 1945, addressed to you which letter I delivered personally at your office, a copy of which I herewith enclose and to which letter I never received a reply. About three weeks after delivering the said letter and not having had a reply I called at your office and requested to see you. I was asked what I wished to see you about. I stated that I desired a reply to the above mentioned letter. When the clerk returned, presumably from your office, he told me that you could not see me and would answer the letter if you thought it necessary. I have never received any reply to the said letter, and wish to renew the request made in said letter, because some of the officials of the C.I.C. in Rome still abuse their power.

Subject- the sentence of Cavallaro to 7 years imprisonment as a gross
misarrriage of justice.

Sir;

Permit me to submit to you for your kind attention and careful consideration a misarrriage of justice committed against my client Umberto Cavallaro.

The case came to me after my client had been convicted by the Allied Military Court in the Province of Florence, to serve 7 years in prison for an alleged conspiracy of corrupting two American soldiers, for the transport of about 6,500 meters of woolen material, in an army vehicle, on Oct. 3rd. 1944, from Florence to Rome.

The facts in the case are in substance as follows;

There were five defendants in the case, namely: Arturo Catullo, Polchino Calvetti, Vincenzo Carè, Giuseppe de Rosa and my client. The first two were the owners of the said merchandise to be transported and Catullo was Anglin, one of the American soldiers as Government witnesses, Lires 15,000.00 on account of Lires 30,000.00 which Anglin and his associate Ahearn were to receive, when the merchandise would have reached Rome. This money was given to Anglin while the material was being loaded upon the truck by Catullo and Calvetti. The said money was given to Anglin with the knowledge and consent of Calvetti. At the time of the trial, Ahearn did not testify, as he was not available. Carè and de Rosa were simply to travel on the truck, since they were only interested in reaching their homes in the south and Carè was a nephew of my client. My client had no interest in the matter and became involved because Catullo met the two soldiers outside of my client's office, they were looking for a toilet and asked Catullo to indicate one. Catullo who knew how to speak English got talking to them and invited them into my client's office to finish to drink a bottle of wine they were carrying in their hand. Before entering my client's office, Catullo and the two soldiers talked about transporting the material to home and finished the conversation in my client's office and in his presence. My client had known Catullo only about 40 days, before said meeting, having sold

Catullo, on different occasions within the said time, spools of thread, about 100 dozens of cotton thread and about 65 dozens of combs. Catullo and the two American soldiers met again in my client's office to discuss the transportation of said merchandise, on which occasion my client was also present. The above in substance are the undisputed facts in the case.

The sentence of the court was 7 years for my client, 5 years for Catullo and the other three defendants were acquitted.

Catullo and Calvetti were the owners of the material to be transported. The former having made the agreement with the two soldiers, (with the knowledge of the latter, who was to pay a proportionate share of the liras 30,000.00. and liras 15,000.00. which were actually paid at the time the said material was being loaded upon the truck) received a sentence of five years imprisonment and Calvetti, who surely was a co-conspirator with Catullo, was acquitted. My client, who had no interest in the material to be transported, made no agreement with the soldiers, except to participate in the talks, gave no money to any one, or loaned any money to complete the transaction, was not present when the material was loaded, or did he go out of his office to do any thing to further the alleged conspiracy, in other words committed no overt act in furtherance of the alleged conspiracy, received a sentence of seven years imprisonment. If my client under the circumstances has been guilty of any thing, is simply that he should have reported the matter to the proper authorities, or not permit said transaction to be discussed in his office. Under no circumstances, is he guilty of a conspiracy and should never have been convicted for such a crime, on the evidence as shown in the record. His allowing Catullo to discuss a deal of that sort in his office can be explained, that he wanted to be courteous to a customer and was interested that his nephew Care got to his home.

When I took this case, the first thing I did was to interview General Alessandro Santi, of the High Command, at the Italian Military Headquarters, in Rome, who it was stated, that during the German occupation of Florence, my client had given him and his staff sleeping quarters in his home, besides food and all other accommodations, for about two weeks and free of charge. The General admitted ~~that~~ all this and added that my client also kept for him, for over one year a trunk full of ammunitions, at the risk of his life and that of his family. The General offered his whole undivided support for the cause of my client and is ready to appear any where for him. The General gave me a letter explaining what my client did and said I could use same on his behalf. This letter I attached together with about 17 other letters, stating all the good my client did for the Allied cause, to the application I submitted for a review of the case, to all of which no attention whatsoever has been paid.

I have made several attempts to bring this matter to the attention of the legal authorities, of the Allied Command, in Rome; but without success. I have tried to talk to Col. W.E. Behrens; but could never be received, the nearest I got to him was the Sergeant clerk in the legal department, who would never give me any information about the case, stating it was his orders. I have tried to have the record copied, in order to properly prepare the application for a revision, or

SUBJECT : Victor GOLDMARK and Raffaele RALLONE

TO : Commissioner (Attn: L. M. O.)

1. Reference your L-5040 of 21 December 1945.

2. I have carefully considered the record of trial and the various letters of recommendation for clemency which have been made in this case. In my opinion, the time has now arrived when favorable action can be taken. The defendants have been in confinement since March, 1945. The principal actor received but eighteen months imprisonment at the hands of a Court Martial, and has no doubt received the benefits provided by law for time off for good behavior. The sentence of the defendants may in law be reformed to meet this parallel case.

3. On reconsideration, the convictions are affirmed. The sentence of two and one-half years imprisonment in respect of Victor Goldmark and 12 months imprisonment in respect of Raffaele Rallone are reduced to terminate as of the 31 day of December 1945. The defendants will be released from custody occasioned by these proceedings.

4. Record is returned.

I shall also speak to Colonel Hannaford about this case which I take the liberty of bringing to your attention, trusting you will keep in mind the special condition of Mr Angeleni and his family

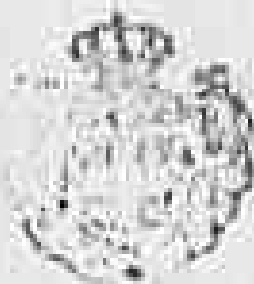
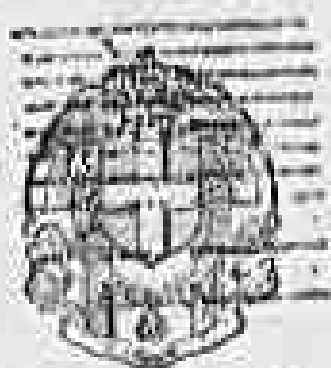

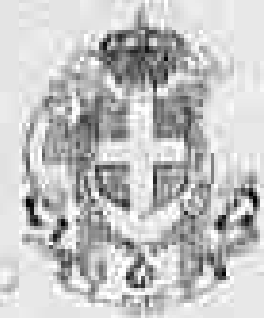

On 27th March 1945 the above named was sentenced at Naples to two and half years imprisonment and fined 50,000 lire or six months for conspiracy and stealing NAAFI/EFI property. Report N°75 dated 23rd. April, 1945 (attached) gives brief facts of this case.

Goldmark age 28, an Austrian Jew is married and has two boys (twins) age 11 months. His wife is residing in two rooms at N° 12 Via Mondella Gaetani, Naples. Yesterday she visited this office and begged for assistance in order to obtain food for their children and fears she will be compelled to leave the above address for failing to pay rent. Mrs. Goldmark age 23, a Jew, was born in Poland. She was extremely distressed and has undoubtedly come to the end of her resources. During the past few weeks she has been selling her clothing to buy food. To verify her statements a visit was made at her home address, there is no doubt Mrs. Goldmark urgently needs assistance. The children were clean and well nourished, but it was obvious for their sakes, this mother was sacrificing everything.

At the time of her husband's arrest they were in possession of a small sum of money, which represented their savings. The fine of 50,000 lire was paid, the remainder of the cash has now been spent on food etc. Being Austrian she is unable to seek help from any Consulate. Mrs. Goldmark's parents are in Switzerland, she has no relatives or friends in Italy. The care and attention required by the twins prevents her obtaining employment.

Prior to the outbreak of war, Victorio Goldmark was a student in Vienna, his parents are residing in New York.

PAGE No.2.

This young married couple are intelligent, clean and respectable appearance. Being Jews they have suffered considerably during this War. Both have spent three years in Concentration Camps.

Prior to his arrest Goldmark had been employed as a Staff Supervisor for eighteen months at the NAAFI/EFI Bakery, Naples and had given every satisfaction. The Sergeant in charge of this Bakery was Court Martialed for being concerned with Goldmark in stealing etc. NAAFI/EFI property and was subsequently sentenced to eighteen months imprisonment. The preparation of this case for Court Martial was conducted from this office. It was revealed had the Sergeant exercised proper supervision, and, had not been involved, Goldmark would not have had the opportunity to commit the offences for which he was sentenced to 2½ years imprisonment.

Attached is a letter dated 29th. March, 1945 written by Captain Simmons, RASC/EFI who is Officer in charge of NAAFI/EFI Bakeries in Italy. He asks that consideration be given for suspension of sentence in the case of Goldmark.

It is also known on 21st. September, 1945, Mr E. Bonomi, Governor of the Italian Civil Prison at Poggioreale, Naples has petitioned for early suspension of sentence.

Goldmark has been imprisoned at this jail for six months. Owing to the War, shortage of food and supplies, also to the fact most of the prisoners are of the poorer class, Goldmark has suffered considerably. There is not the slightest doubt the past six months have been more than a lesson to him.

Considering all the circumstances, it is humbly suggested the suspension of sentence be favourably reviewed, in order Goldmark can return home to support his wife and two very young children, who at the present time are practically destitute.
