The lawyer TORIO VINCENZO, Milan, writes on 5 IV 1946 that PALESE ANNA and PALESE VINCENZO have been sentenced on 25 X 1944 by the Superior Allied Military Court of Milan to eight years imprisonment each.

The penal proceeding has been initiated by an Allied Court, but Rome was restored to the Italian Administration, and Fiorentini's case was transmitted to the Italian Judicial authorities.

No penalty of any kind has been inflicted to Fiorentini. As the bail represents a security that an accused will appear at the trial; as that trial has not taken place; as there is no more reason to hold that bail, Fiorentini requests that the bail be refunded.
