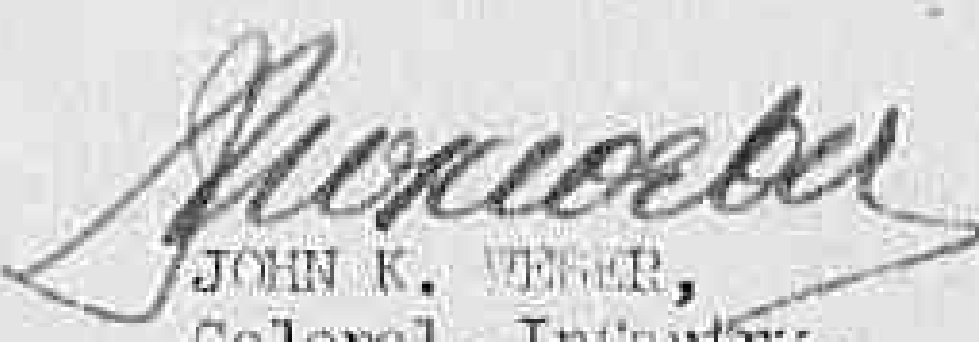

3. Attention is directed to the inquiry made by the Prison Director concerning the release of Allied Prisoners. The Prison Director should be advised that of the circular issued by the Ministry of Grace and Justice that the release of Allied Prisoners prior to the expiration of their sentence will be notified to the Director by the Ministry of Grace and Pardon. It was our understanding that this circular had been sent to each Prison Director.

4. The case of MARTINELLI, Vito is up for re-consideration. Convicted with MARTINELLI, and sentenced to three years imprisonment was FORMARI Giovannina di Ferdinando, whose name does not appear on the lists of prisoners being detained on Allied sentences. Can we be informed where this prisoner is detained so that the case may be reviewed?

2. The above mentioned persons were tried before an Allied Military Government Court sitting at Alessandria on 25 August 1945. They were each charged with the violation of the following: Proc. I, Art. IV, Sec. 5, in that on or about 10 August 1945 at Acqui, they were in wrongful possession of firearms, (2) Proc. I, Art. V, Sec. 45, in that on or about 10 August 45 at Acqui they did act to the prejudice of good order in occupied territory by conspiring to commit a robbery by use of firearms and make an illegal arrest at Sassello.

3. PRZKA, Vincenzo; BARBELLA, Antonio and FIORINI, Ugo were found "Not guilty" of the first charge and guilty of the second charge. MARRICALL, Aldo and QUILLICI, Domenico were found "Guilty" as to both charges.

The Prefect of Ferrara wires the following:

"The a/m young-men, who are detained in the local Prison, were condemned on 6 July 1945 by the Allied Military Court to one year's imprisonment as they were found in possession of revolvers and hand-grenades: Primo Masetti Wolmer, Toschi Rianfranco, Michellini Flavio, Denini Emilio, Gessi Mario, Baravalli Cesare, Zappaterra Giulio, all from Ferrara. As we have to deal with young-men who fought for the cause of national liberty and who during their detention always held good conduct, this Office, since last September, begged the Ministry of Grace and Justice to send, for competence, to your Commission proposals aiming to obtain an act of clemency on behalf of said prisoners. This Office heartily urged many times said Ministry in order that the Allied Commission be solicited, but up to this moment no decision on the matter has been taken. Sent for your information and action begging you to approach the Allied Commission in order that the situation of the a/m young-men be benevolently examined with a view to set them free. We deem it opportune to obtain the act of clemency within the 24 inst., recurrency of the liberation of Ferrara, as otherwise demonstrations could take place with unfavourable consequences for the public order of the province."

Considering the precedents of the prisoners in question and the excellent conduct held by them after the sentence, which is almost expiated, we beg your Commission to kindly examine the position of the a/m young-men who fought with the Allied Forces for the liberation of Ferrara.

A kind information of your decision would be appreciated.

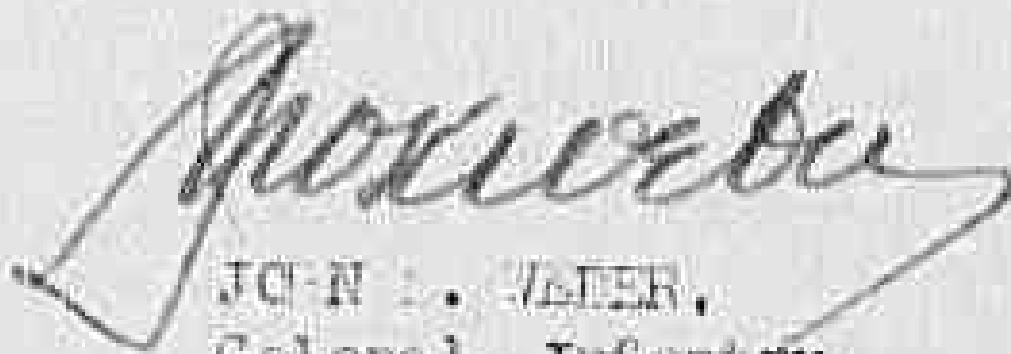
