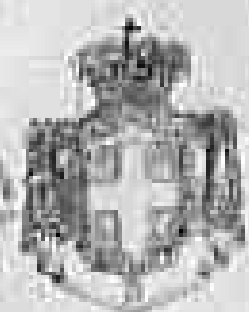

With reference to letter AC/4083/23/L of the 21st May 1946, the Ministry of Prisons and Justice communicates that they have received the following note from the prison director of Modena:

"It is herewith communicated that the above named prisoner has been sentenced on the 26th June 1945 by an Italian Court to two years imprisonment, and his penalty should therefore expire on the 26th June 1947.

However, said prisoner has escaped on the 6th September 1945 from the local Civil Hospital, where he was under treatment, and has no more returned to this jail."

SUBJECT : Copies of sentences.

TO : Giudice Sorveglianza Tribunale Nicosia
Poidomane.

1. Reference is your telegram of 14 July 1946.
2. Indomenico Salvatore di Timoleonte and Coslovich Antonino fu Matteo were arrested with others on or about 28 October 1944 and were charged with sabotage of Military Equipment under the Italian Penal Code of War.
3. They were tried by a General Allied Military Government Court sitting at Catania on 16 December 1944. Both were found guilty; Indomenico was sentenced to serve three (3) years imprisonment and Coslovich was sentenced to serve five (5) years.
4. On 25 January 1945 the convictions and sentences were affirmed.
5. On further consideration 10 July 1946 the sentence of Indomenico was reduced so as to end on 24 July 1946; the sentence of Coslovich was reduced so as to ~~end~~ ^{end} on 15 March 1947.
6. Copies of sentences against Antonini Enzo, Ilardi Giuseppe and Scalora Salvatore will be forwarded at an early date.

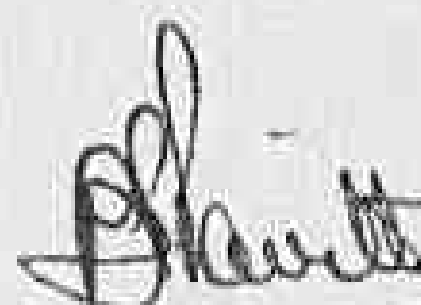

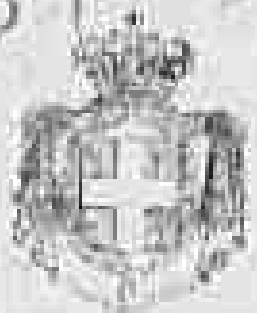

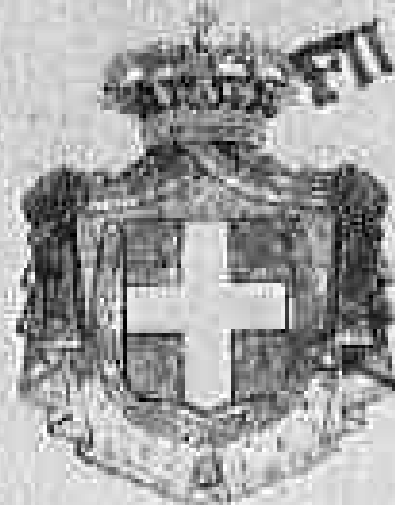

SUBJECT: MINOPOLI Carmine.

TO: Procuratore del Regno, Napoli.

1. Reference is your letter number 794/45 (8 Sez Indigeni) of 18 June 1946 addressed to the Ufficio Legale di Collegamento of Naples.

2. The above mentioned person was arrested together with seven other persons, DEBARTO Luigi di Mivio, CHIAROLANZA Vincenzo di Ciro, MINOPOLI Ferdinando fu Antonio, PICCIRILLO Domenico fu Giuseppe, BELLOPEDI Vincenzo fu Giuseppe, RUSCILLIO Gennaro fu Giorgio and GIACCHIELI Francesco on or about 2 December 1944 and charged with: (a) offering a bribe (violation of Proc. 2, Art. 2, Sec 2), (b) conspiring to bribe and to steal (violation of Proc 2, Art 3, Sec 1), and (c) attempting to steal sugar (violation of Proc. 2, Art. 3, Sec. 2).

3. All accused save for MINOPOLI Carmine were tried before a Superior AGC Court sitting in Naples on 22 December 1944. The seven defendants were found guilty as charged and sentenced as follows: MINOPOLI Ferdinando - 4 years imprisonment from date of arrest on each charge, the sentences to be served concurrently; as to the other defendants, 3 years imprisonment from date of arrest on each charge, sentences to be served concurrently. The confiscated money was ordered returned.

4. On review 9 February 1945 the following decision was announced:

1st charge: All convictions quashed
2nd charge: Conviction of MINOPOLI Ferdinando fu Antonio affirmed. Sentence to read 4 years imprisonment. Convictions of all other accused quashed.

3rd charge: All convictions affirmed. Sentence in each case reduced to 1 year. Sentence on MINOSOLI Ferdinando fu Antonio under 2nd and 3rd charges to run concurrently.

5. On further reconsideration the following decision was announced on 14 March 1946: The sentence of MINOSOLI Ferdinando fu Antonio is reduced so as to end 31 March 1946.

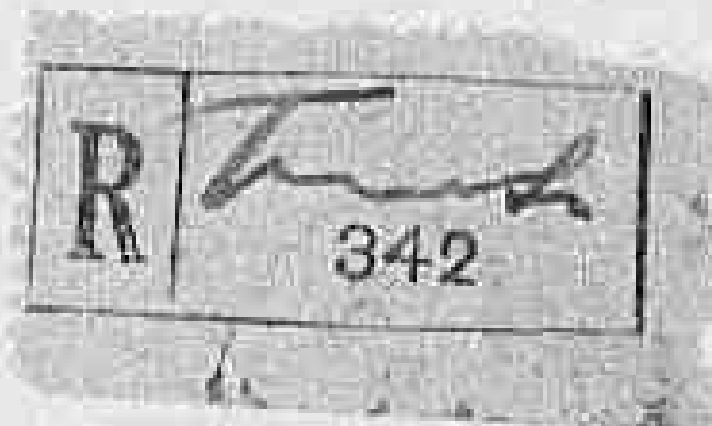

Application for pardon.

Undersigned Russomando Ugo son of late Raffaele and
Grassa Marianna born at Naples on the 27th Dec. 1904 and living
at Naples;

arrested at the 5th October 1944 for transgression of Allied
ordinance and condemned on the 23rd Nov 1944 by the Allied Court
to 4 years of imprisonment;

presently detained in the Portolongone jail;

begs to forward to your Commission respectful petition, poin-
ting out the circumstances of his arrest and asking for a right and
generous understanding.

On the 5th October 1944 I was at Prato owing to family reasons.
While eating in the "Stella d'Italia" Restaurant I had the pleasure
of getting acquainted with 3 Allied soldiers. While talking I learnt
that I had the possibility to return to Naples, where I live together
with those Allies. So we dated up for 6 o'clock in the evening when
we met, the soldiers proposed to buy some food to eat during the jour-
ney. Of course I felt, it was my duty to provide for the food, and thus
I gave to one of them, who was going to buy it, 1000 lire. In that very
moment, M.P. soldiers came along and arrested me.

On the 23rd November, I was condemned by the Allied Tribunal to
4 years of imprisonment.

Your Commission can easily see which and how great my crime was.
Anyway, in order to better explain my innocence, I want to point out
following:

1) I did not know anything about the Allied ordinance forbidding
to Italian civilians to ride on military vehicles. On the other hand
I had seen many civilians on Allied cars, and thus I did not even sup-
pose there was such an order;

2) I wanted to reach at the earliest Naples, where I had left
my old mother, my wife and children, and there was no other transpor-
tation available;

3) I did not imagine to be committing a crime when I offered
something to eat to those soldiers who were going to start a long
trip;

4) My 16-years-old son and I co-operated with Partisans for the liberation of "aples. I can eventually prove this with regular statement issued by the local c.l.n.;

5) My family urgently needs my presence home, because all my sons are under-aged my wife is not in good health and my mother is old and troubled since my arrest.

May be I failed, may be I am guilty, but I really did not intend to commit any crime. I always was an honest citizen, and all my penal files can prove this. I am sure that the high sense of justice of your Commission shall understand and forgive I only want to re-join my family, my wife and children which suffer so terribly for my imprisonment. I hope that this petition may be favourably accepted. You can believe that this terrible year I spent here in my cell, my grief and humiliation have been an hard punishment for me. And may God bless those who shall make me and my family happy again.

Hopefully waiting for an answer, I thank in advance

1. Reference is our letter AC/4083/23/L of 23 May 1946 and your letter No. 106/13-4 of 22 May 1946.

2. RIVANO Giuseppe was arrested on or about 25 March 1944 for violation of Proclamation 2, Article 2, Section 40 (Unlawful possession of Allied Forces property, "Flour"), and Proclamation 2, Article 2, Section 45 (acts prejudicial to the good order of the Allied Forces).

3. The accused was tried before a Superior Allied Military Government Court sitting at Castellorivano on 17-19 May 1944, convicted and sentenced to serve 7 years imprisonment, two years of which were suspended.

4. The case was reviewed 25 June 1944 at which time the conviction on charge one was affirmed, the conviction on charge two quashed, and the sentence reduced to 5 years.

5. On further reconsideration, the following decision was transmitted to the Minister of Pardon and Justice: the sentence is reduced so as to end on 17 January 1947.

1. Reference is made to your letter, subject as above,
dated 25 June 1946 No. 15527.

2. "Records of this Headquarters regarding court proceedings
against Major DI MARTINO, Marino, show that:

a) On 30 March 1945, before a Superior Military Court at
LIVORNO, he was charged with violation of "reclamation No. 1, Art. IV,
Section 11, for wrongful possession of Allied property. To this charge
he plead Not guilty. He was found guilty by the Court and sentenced
to ten years imprisonment, of which the last three years were
suspended. The Court ordered confiscation of 362,000 Liro. On
20 May 1945, on review, the conviction and sentence were quashed and
a trial de novo ordered before a different court.

b) The case came to trial before a Superior Military
Court held at Livorno on 18 July 1945. In this trial the offence
charged was the same. The accused plead Not guilty. He was found
guilty and sentenced to three and one-half years imprisonment.
Disposition of property as provided by the previous Court was ordered.
Conviction and sentence in this case were affirmed on review on
10 October 1945.

c) On 14 May 1946 the conviction and sentence were
reconsidered. The conviction was affirmed, but the sentence was reduced
to six months and on 31 May 1946.

Dear Sirs:

The Secretariat of State of His Holiness takes the liberty to recommend for the kind consideration of the competent authorities the request for the liberation of Duilio Ferrari presently serving a prison term at Trento.

It is stated in the request that Signor Ferrari was sentenced to two years imprisonment for the possession of arms. In his defense Signor Ferrari declares that he had collaborated with the underground for one year and, that together with about twenty other men, he was under the command of Captain De Salvo of the United States Army. They had taken it upon themselves to harass the nazis in the Brenner district. After a few months Captain De Salvo was ordered to return to America. Ferrari states that he asked the Captain what he should do with the arms and was told to keep them, especially since the district was not free of SS troops and there was danger of an uprising there since there no longer was a police force in the district.

He was denounced for the possession of the above arms and sentenced to two years imprisonment. He

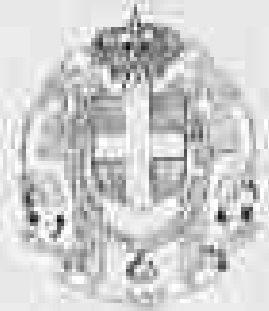

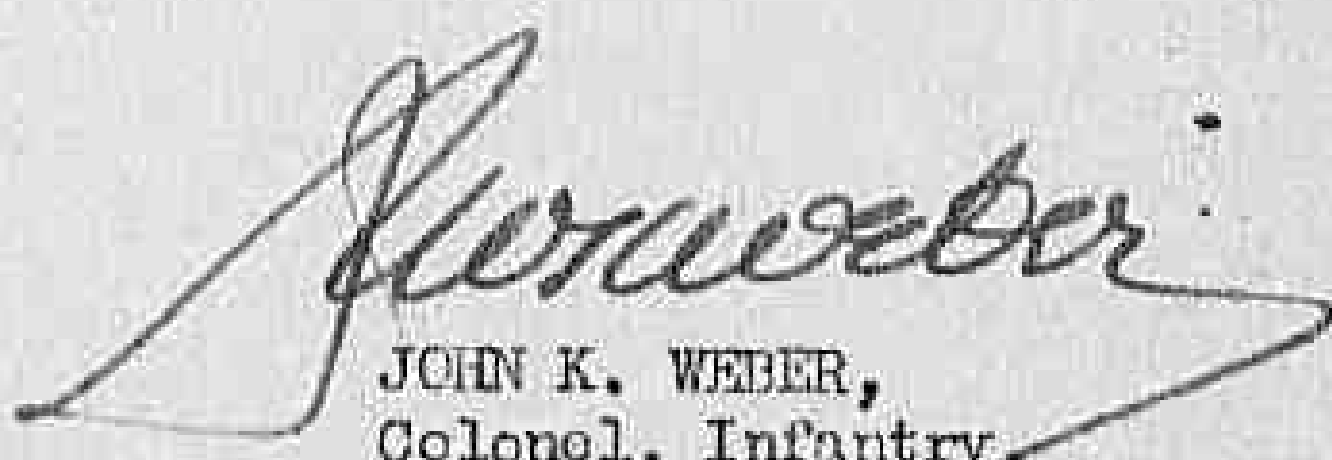

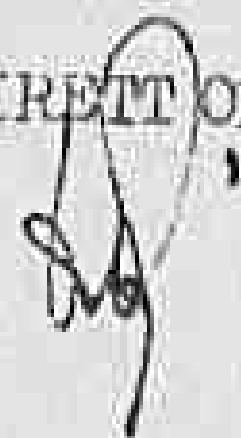

a) On 30 March 1945, before a Superior Military Court at Livorno, he was charged with violation of Proclamation No. 1, Article IV, Section 11, for wrongful possession of Allied property. To this charge he plead Not Guilty. He was found Guilty by the Court and sentenced to ten years imprisonment, of which the last three years were suspended. The Court ordered confiscation of 362,000 Lire. On 20 May 1945, on review, the conviction and sentence were quashed and a trial is now ordered before a different Court.

b) The case came to trial before a Superior Military Court held at Livorno on 18 July 1945. In this trial the offence charged was the same. The accused plead Not Guilty. He was found Guilty and sentenced to three and one-half years imprisonment. Disposition of property as provided by the previous Court was ordered. Conviction and sentence in this case were affirmed on review on 10 October 1945.

c) On 11 May 1946 the conviction and sentence were reconsidered. The conviction was affirmed, but the sentence was reduced so as to end on 31 May 1946.
