P E T I T I O NPETITION FOR PARDON, Date: 2.X.1946.

The petitioner, Professor Alfonso BORRARO, is addressing his petition to the President of the Republic on behalf of his nephew, named BORRARO Elvio.

He declares that his nephew has been eleven years ago and went to West-Africa. He was made there a prisoner by the Allied Forces. His parents had no news from him for three years and were very worried.

Elvio Borraro sent finally a letter, which has arrived on August 30th 1946. He informed his parents that he succeeded in escaping from a concentration camp in South-Africa and, having no means, was compelled to commit a robbery, together with his companions. He was arrested and sentenced by an Allied Court to a very long term on imprisonment, which is not being exactly specified in his a/s letter. He only claims that the conditions of his life are terrible.

The petitioner points out that his nephew has always been an honest labourer and has no previous penal record. He asks the President to intervene with the Allied Authorities, in order that his nephew be pardoned and released. He gives the following address, which was indicated on the envelop of the letter, sent to him by Borraro Elvio: Rosland Street P.O. Box 1457, Cape Town S.A. He believes that his nephew is serving the penalty in the prison of Cape Town.

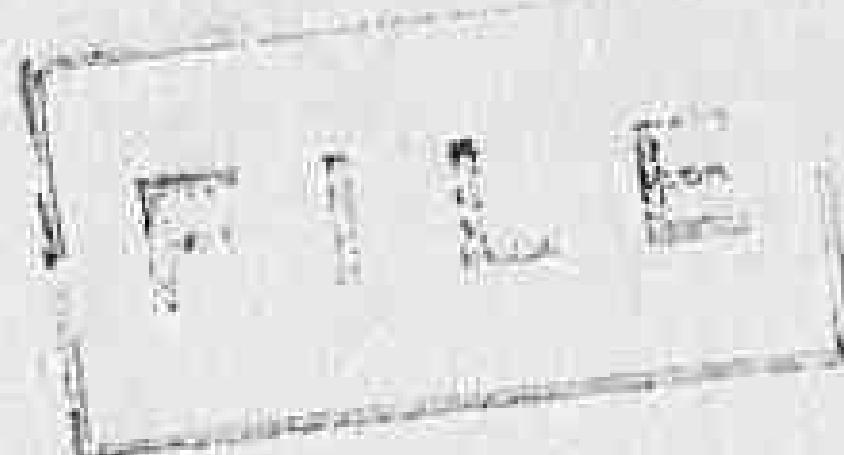

With reference to your above mentioned note, the letter quoted below has been received from the Procura at the Tribunal of Bergamo :

" In reply to your letter addressed to the Director of the local judicial prison you are hereby informed that the prisoner FLORI Antonio was released by mistake on 6 June 1946.

Without any regard to the sentence imposed by the Allied Court, the release order issued by the local Tribunal, which found FLORI not guilty on the charges preferred against him, was carried out.

As soon as the mistake was discovered, necessary instructions were given to trace and rearrest him but to date we have not succeeded.

We did not take any action against the prison personnel in view of their unexperience."

1. See your letter of 26 September 1946

2. The case of Major Di Martino, Mario, was considered in its regular order by the Board of Review. All cases wherein persons convicted by Allied Military Government Courts are being reviewed by the Review Board. In the case of Di Martino, Mario, the conviction was affirmed but the sentence was reduced. The reduction in sentence was made by way of review and not by way of pardon or other clemency.

3. The offense with which Major Di Martino, Mario was convicted was a violation of Proclamation 1, Part II, Article IV, Section 11, which reads as follows:

"Any person who destroys, damages, endangers, interferes with, steals or wrongfully either receives or has in his possession any property of the Allied Forces or any member thereof to the aggregate value of more than 10,000 lire, shall upon conviction by an Allied Military Court, be liable to punishment by death, or by imprisonment or fine or both, as the Court may determine."

The particulars alleged were as follows:
"In that the accused did, on or about 8 February 1945, at or near Livorno, have in his possession 200 - 300 lbs sacks of beans and 40 - 150 lbs sacks of flour, the property of the Allied Forces."

4. This case was tried twice. The conviction in the first trial was reversed on Review, and the sentence set aside and a new trial was ordered. The conviction and sentence on the second trial were duly affirmed. Thereafter, the case came on for consideration before the Board of Review, and action was taken as set out in paragraph one of this letter.

2. The problem here appears to have arisen through the actions of the Special Court of Assize of Bologna. On the date when that Court sentenced Puccetti, 7 December 1945, it either knew or should have known that Puccetti was already serving the sentence of two years imprisonment from 8 May 1945 imposed by an Allied Military Court on 24 May 1945.

3. It is a question of Italian Law whether the sentence of the Special Court of Assize has been affected by the mandato di scarcerazione of 23.4.1946 of the Office of the P.M. of that Court, ordering his release on 29 April 1946 on the ground that the sentence of the Court had been served. So far as this Commission is concerned the mandato di scarcerazione appears to have been granted by the P.M. under error. The time Puccetti had served up to 29 April 1946 was served on the prior sentence of the Allied Military Court and had nothing to do with the Special Assize Court sentence.

4. So far as this Commission is now concerned, and that concern is only with the Allied Military Government sentence, that sentence now expires on 23 September 1946. Without seeing the terms of the Special Assize Court sentence and the mandato di scarcerazione this Commission is not in a position to give an opinion on whether the normal procedure under Italian Law that a convicted prisoner serves any subsequent sentence on expiry of the first has been abrogated. As mentioned in the

preceding paragraph, however, the present problem is regarded as one for the Ministry's decision.

1. The above man was arrested in October 1945 pending investigation and formulation of charges in respect of various offences. He was not granted provisional liberty because he was considered to be a dangerous criminal and was strongly suspected of being the leader of a criminal organization responsible for many thefts and hold-ups. NO. 411 Field Security Section reported on him as follows:

"His sanguinary character and his lack of scruples hold in subjection and terrorize the population of Brughera where he is virtually in control. Public opinion accuses him of being the head of a delinquent organization. He must be considered as a dangerous element to public order and to the security of Allied troops. "

The Questura of Udine reported on him in the same strain and states that numerous murders are attributed to him although it has not been possible conclusively to establish his guilt.

2. Investigations were pursued over a long period in order to bring this man to trial in an Allied Military Court but this proved impossible as apparently witnesses who might have established his guilt were too terrified to go to Court and give evidence against him. Accordingly, at the end of April the case was turned over to the Questura of Udine so that he could be dealt with by the Commission for Confino and Ammonizione. The Questura instituted further investigations and communicated upon the matter with the Ministry of the Interior, but in the result they also were unable to obtain concrete proof of the many crimes of which he is suspected and it was found impossible to bring him to trial. In the meantime he was sent by the Ministry of Justice to the Casa Penale at Porto Longone for precautionary and disciplinary reasons. Finally, as it

was found impossible to induce anyone to give evidence against him, he was freed by the Questura of Udine on 6 September last and returned to his home where he is subject to close police surveillance.

He is the father of seven children, who, along with their mother are completely dependent upon him for support. With him away, they are being deprived of the very necessities of life.

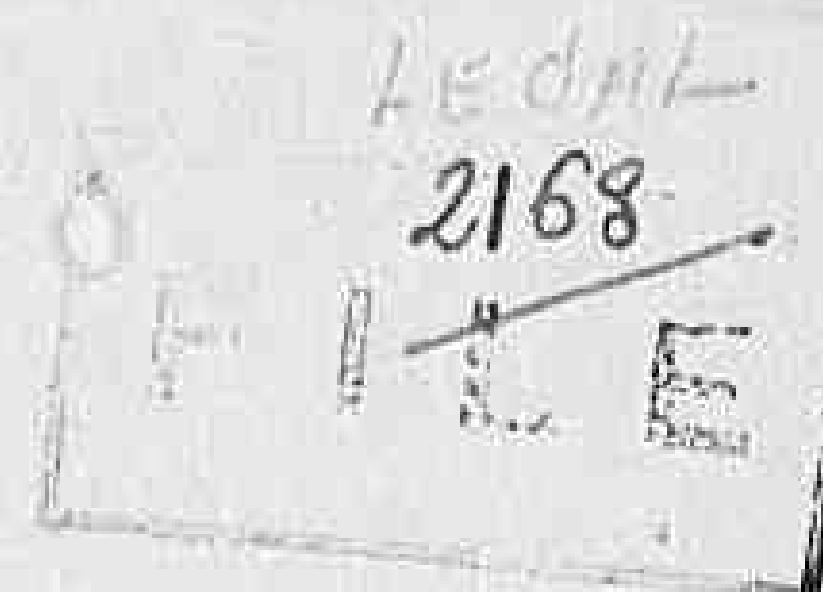

My son wrote a demand of pardon to Allied Court in Rome with a recommendation of the doctor of jail and of the Director, because my son saved a good conduct and why he is sick. The demand of pardon is dated August 28, 1945, with n. 29277, but till now he did not receive answer.

The Undersigned Melchiorra Troia in Perez, living at 148 Via Rome, Siracusa, has the honour of asking your assistance in the following case:

My husband, Giovanni Perez of the late Sebastiano, was sentenced in 1944 and sent to the Judiciary jail in Siracusa for having participated in a theft against the Allied Forces. Discussing the case he proved that he did not take part in the theft, but in spite of that, given that in those days to repress such thefts they punished also those who were suspected of having committed them, he was sentenced to 4 years, 2 months and a £5000 fine. My husband appealed against such a decision but up to now his sentence has not been diminished.

Your Excellency! My husband is at present at the Hospital to undergo an operation for ulcerated hemorrhoids. After the operation he will require assistance and care which are impossible to get in a jail. He was not even benefited by the amnesty granted for the advent of the Republic and yet his case came under those comprised in the grant.

Your Excellency, please consider this case with benevolence and have my husband benefit of those advantages that the law granted to all those who had heavier sentences and that he, innocent and honest workman, was not granted.
