1. It is of considerable importance that the Sub-Commission's monthly report be as complete, as accurate and as well written as possible. The report is intended to reflect the findings of officers in the field, to strengthen authority in ACC, and to the Government in London and Washington. To all of those organizations it represents the only complete source of information on the Sub-Commission's operation. Moreover, the report represents the only continuing historical record of the Sub-Commission.
2. It has been found that preparation of the monthly operational report has required a large amount of rewriting of the material submitted by the various sub-sections. It is obvious that the majority of the report would not be well suited for use as it is submitted originally with the subject matter. It is felt that to make changes and cuts less involved to outstanding material of each Sub-Section, minor editorial section account it will be the Sub-Section's duty to effectively, and compactly, adapt to that copied for use in the final report, much more valuable reports can be prepared.
3. It is requested that in future reports be prepared by conforming strictly to the main report in accordance with the directives in para para 4, and that no attempt be made to improve content in accordance with the suggestions in para para 5.
4. In general, questions of style can be answered by reference to the January or February reports of the Sub-Commission. The particular, the following points should be observed:
  - (a) Questions: the Sub-Sections' actions are to appear to be dictated, uncoordinated, and customized. How subjects discussed are to be conditioned with initial contact is also settled with diplomatic Roman letters and local language. The number of such subjects are to be captioned in lower case, with one initial capital, and numbered sequentially for better identification. Small volume letters enclosed

- (G) Copy should be submitted in double-spaced type, and in triplicate.

- (B) The material should contain as many significant statistics as possible. These statistics should be used either as bulletins or relevant to the argument or as separate appendices to interest the user reader.
- (C) Each paragraph should contain a topic sentence so that the reader knows the purpose of each.
- (D) Before submission to this office the material or sub-sub-sections should be sufficiently summarized or concluded, e.g.,  
organized narratively.

5) Before I left Salerno, I personally delivered to Lt. Col. Cross of Finance S/C the uncompleted work left to the Bendheims.

6) This Headquarters is under no obligations to the Bendheim brothers.

1. Both of the above named brothers were employed at Rear Headquarters AC as professional men: one with Legal Sub-Commission and the other with the, then called, Interior Sub-Commission.

2. It was reported to this office that they were both acting suspiciously at times, and since they were in a position to know much of what was going on, it was requested that they be checked.

3. They were interrogated thoroughly by Security Branch this Headquarters and a search was also made of their private papers. It was discovered that they were German Jews, who had lived a while in Switzerland but spent much time in Italy as stock brokers and economists. They are the authors of some texts on Economics. It was also discovered that at one time they may well have been comparatively wealthy. During the questioning they both seemed rather nervous, but this may well have been quite a natural reaction.

4. Nothing derogatory to their characters, moral or political, was discovered but it was felt that they were not above suspicion. It is felt that the Bendheims are "crackpots" in a sense but nevertheless quite keen on business dealings.

5. One of the brothers was eventually transferred from Interior Sub-Commission to Finance, working under Lt. Col. CROSS. As far as can be ascertained they performed their duties in an excellent manner.

6. Payroll records show that they were paid in full through 15 July 1944 which was the last pay day for Rear Headquarters.

SOUTHERN REGION.

1. Further to this sub-commission's letter of 11 Jan 45 I have now heard from Finance Sub-Commission that one of their officers was in Salerno a few days ago.

2. He states that he has taken all necessary steps to put an end to the activities of the Bendheim brothers and that he has notified all persons in the area that they have no authority from this Commission to carry on their business.

3. In these circumstances there does not appear to be any need for you to put in hand any investigation into their activities, although it might be desirable to check up in a short time that they have in fact abandoned their activities.

4. The Finance Sub-Commission do not consider that the possibility of criminal proceedings against Dr. Martine Bendheim should be pursued. I have no strong feelings myself about the activities of Dr. Eric Bendheim, but if, from what you know of him, you think that he should be prosecuted, no doubt you will take the necessary action.

1. During the time when HQ ACC were at Naples and Salerno, Dr. Eric Sandheim and Mr. Martino Sandheim were employed by the Legal and Finance Sub-Commission respectively.
2. Their employment came to an official end on the move of HQ ACC to Rome.
3. In these circumstances, it is somewhat distressing, if perhaps not altogether surprising, to discover that these gentlemen are alleged to have retained possession of an office in the Palace of Justice, Salerno, where under the protection afforded by signs reading respectively "Allied Commission - Near Link Legal Sub-Commission" and "Allied Commission - Near Link Finance Sub-Commission" they are apparently carrying on a business which offers obvious scope for the lucrative employment of misdirected talents.
4. As an illustration of their activities, there is attached hereto a copy of a letter written to you by Mr. Eric Sandheim and forwarded to this sub-commission.
5. It is of course essential that their activities should be brought to an immediate close, but it is also desirable that, if any actual criminal offence can be proved to have been committed by either of the gentlemen concerned, the necessary proceedings should be put in hand forthwith.
6. Please investigate and report in due course.



j. The Bendheim brothers stated they were directly under the supervision of Capt. Nadill. Capt. Nadill denied same, stating that he (Capt. Nadill) believed that the Bendheim brothers were employed by the Allied Commission.

j. On or about 20 December 1944 the Procuratore del Re no of Salerno had called at my office and informed me that Bendheim brothers had been seeking information from all offices of the Italian Courts and had gone so far as to enter the consultation room of the Tribunale judges during deliberations and insisted upon sitting in the room to listen to the Court's deliberation. I informed the Procuratore del Re no to refuse any and all information to the Bendheim brothers and to eject them from any office or deliberation room, should they attempt to repeat such conduct. I made this statement because I was under the impression that the Bendheim brothers were merely custodians of some property belonging to the Allied Commission. I knew the Bendheim brothers had no other official duties.

k. Capt. Nadill and I both ordered the Bendheim brothers to vacate their office immediately, but they proved to be obstinate, stating we could not force them to go. 2

l. Capt. Nadill and a Carabiniere were to proceed to the Palazzo di Giustizia to examine the office of the Bendheim brothers and to make certain that they would vacate the building immediately.

m. Capt. Nadill will advise us in due course as to what action has been taken.

1. Reference is made to the attached file N. L-3660.

2. I investigated into this matter on 16 January 1945 and have the following to report:

a. The Bendheim brothers occupy an office in the Palazzo di Giustizia in Salerno.

b. They have, since Headquarters ACC left Salerno in July 1944, held themselves out to be employees of the Allied Commission. Such representations were made to DADOS, DAID, other Allied military organizations, and to Capt. Belli (as late as December 1944 in the case of the latter).

c. Because of these representations, some of the aforementioned organizations, thru its officers and O.R.s, have requested the Bendheim brothers to act for them on many occasions.

d. Similar representations were made to the Italian Courts and the officials thereof. As a consequence, the Bendheim brothers had easy and ready access to the various records of the Italian Courts.

e. The Bendheim brothers have received no pay what-so-ever from the Allied Commission, nor from any other military organization since July 1944; however, they have been receiving meals and rations from friendly members of DAID and DADOS.

f. The Bendheim brothers are not regularly employed by anyone.

g. Tucked upon one of the cabinet doors, in the office of the Bendheim brothers, were exhibits "A", "B" and "C", which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

h. Exhibit "D" is a report of activities made by the Bendheim brothers.
