Dear Guy,

I am writing this letter on behalf of Mrs. Dodero the wife of Captain Dodero mentioned in the within Certificate. Mrs.Dodero was formerly Miss Wilson of Vancouver Canada. She has been living alone in Nervi since the internment of her husband and his Ships Company in the early part of the war in Cuba.

Mrs.Dodero has only indirectly heard from her husband and in all this time has had no letter but she has learned indirectly that he has suffered much in health. The company located in Genoa will pay to Mrs. Dodero only 2500 L. per month out of her husband's earnings accumulated and as she can receive no money from her mother in Canada she is hard pressed to manage. Further Mrs. Dodero feels that owing to his internment in Cuba they might be lost souls with no one immediately concerned.

I am attaching the Certificate which insures immediate employment. On his release with the hope that you would be good enough to bring the matter to the authorities of the proper department in the talian Government. Anything you could do in the interest of the Captain and Mrs. Dodero would be appreciated very much indeed. I know the family sufficiently to know thus to be a legitimate and deserving case.
