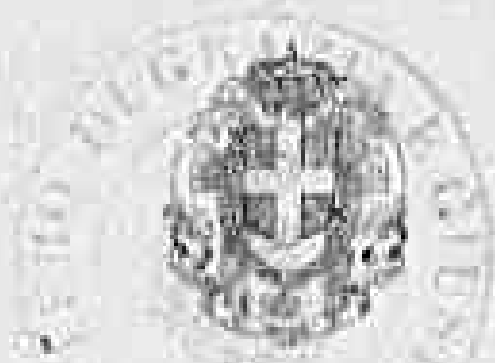

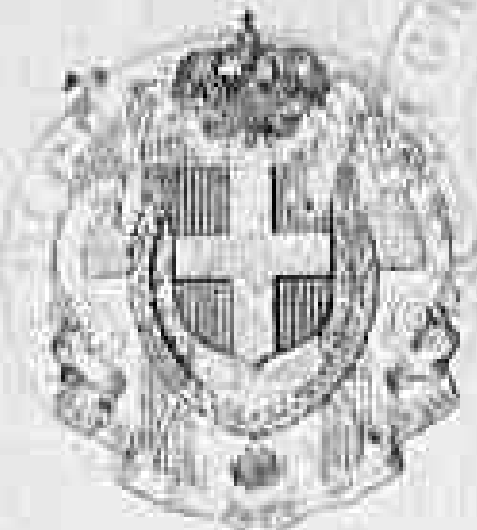

1. It is requested that if possible, there be obtained for this Division the official Compilations of Italian Laws and Decrees (Raccolta Ufficiale Leggi e Decreti) at least since 1930 up to the present.

a. It is understood that these may be obtained perhaps through the Minister of Justice at the Libreria dello Stato (Ufficio Commerciale), Piazza Verdi No. 10, Rome.

2. Such Compilations will be extremely valuable and are necessary for efficient functioning of this Division which is charged with the preparation of legislation independently of legislation in Italy proper since 8 September 1943. It is constantly necessary for this and other legal purposes to examine and study the Italian Law both before and after 8 September, 1943.

3. It is proposed that these compilations, if obtainable, will form the nucleus of a Library for this Division which is now in the process of formation.

4. It is understood that bids must be accepted within seven days for the contract to become operative in order to meet the rapidly fluctuating costs.

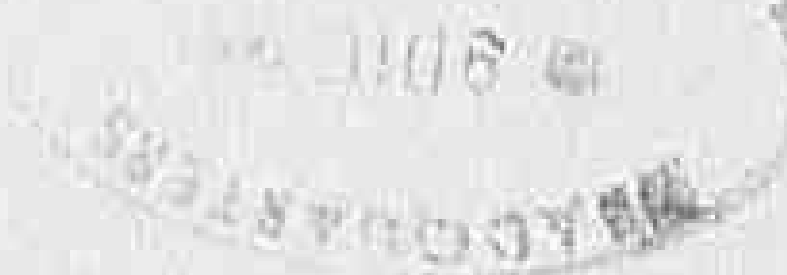

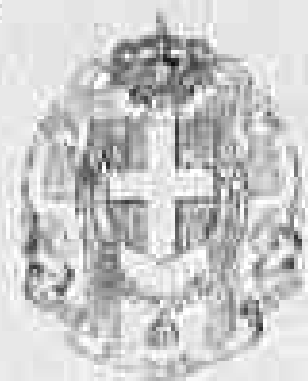
