I am by common consent divided from my husband since 10 years. I haven't therefore followed his life, I ignored the sad lot that he had met. In learning it my agitation was very deep, and immense is the torture of my two daughters.

Sofio Sante Lt Colonel has always led a life of honour and sacrifice in the great war he was twice decorated for military valour. On September 8th he was taken prisoner by the Germans. To escape deportation he adhered to the wretched movement of the so called Social Italian Republic.

I don't believe my husband-Doctor- has committed any culpable or deplorable actions. I know that without defence, defence in the sense of an efficient defence of testimony and documentations in an atmosphere of burning hatred and excited by intimidation he has been condemned to death by extraordinary Court of Assise in Asti on June 4th. The trial is presently before the court of Cassation special section in Milan, where the petition will be heard on July 9th 1945. I, English by descent, have always been faithful to the ideals of liberty and honour which are the glory of my native country: I, sister of an English officer, mother of two creatures convinced that my husband doesn't deserve death & invoke from the nobility and power of my native country the rescuing intervention for my husband.

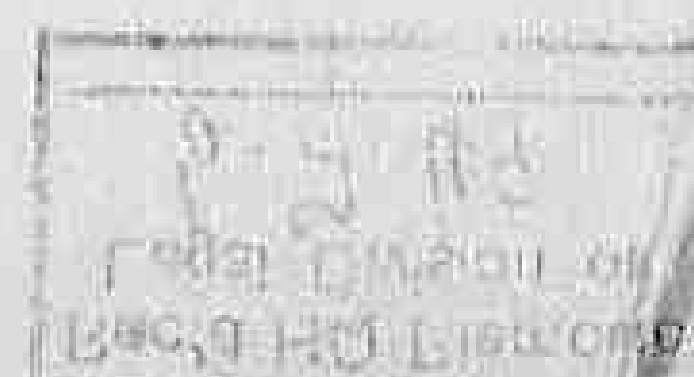

1. Lieut. Sabatino has just visited this Sub-Commission in order to enlist my assistance in the case of an unfortunate who had been sentenced by the Special Court of Assize and whose appeal had been rejected by the Supreme Court of Cassation on the ground that it was out of time. I understand that you have ordered that the sentence of death be suspended for the time being.

2. I have informed Lieut. Sabatino and am writing to you in order to record officially that the policy of this Commission is not to interfere in matters of procedure of this type. The question of appeals being made in or out of time and the true construction of the decree upon this question were fully discussed at the Milan conference. If the Italian Courts consider that they are correctly interpreting the intention of the legislature it does not appear to me to rest with Lieut. Sabatino, the undersigned or even the Regional Legal Officer, Piemonte, to reach a different conclusion.

3. At the same time I feel confident that the Chief Commissioner would not wish to affirm a death sentence which was contrary to the justice of the case and which had been rejected on appeal owing to some technical difficulty in procedure.

4. I accordingly informed Lieut. Sabatino that the suspension on the death sentence should be removed provided that sufficient time has been given to the accused to place with the Minister of Justice any petition which he feels would serve his interests. At the same time I requested Lieut. Sabatino (if the scope of the duties entrusted to him extends so far) to write this Sub-Commission a full report on the case in order that we may ascertain whether in fact there is any real chance of a miscarriage of justice. If there is we shall naturally take action.

5. The strings of Lieut. Sabatino's heart had clearly also been wrung in other cases and he wished to complain bitterly over such sentences as those of eight years imprisonment on a domestic servant and twelve years upon a layer out of dead bodies. The same considerations apply to all cases of this nature and it is entirely within your discretion to recommend that the Chief Commissioner should exercise clemency on behalf of this or any other accused.

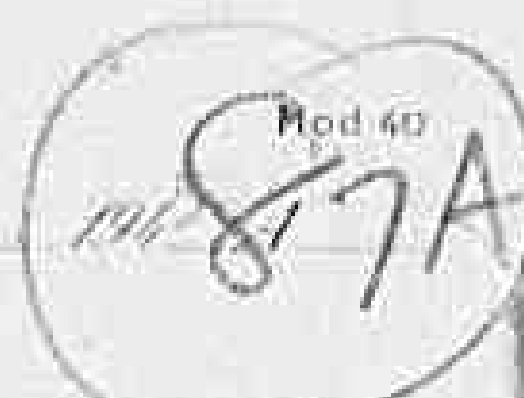

3. It is desired to bring to your notice the extreme importance of the principle involved in this case. At the present moment there is a considerable delay between the imposition of death sentences by the Extraordinary Courts of Assize in North Italy and the actual execution of the sentences. This delay is causing much adverse criticism and considerable unrest; it has been undoubtedly responsible for several of the instances of attacks upon jails and murders of the inmates. It is the view of this Commission that every effort must be made to reduce these delays.

4. The position under Italian law in regard to the sentences in the Extraordinary Courts of Assize is as follows:-

a. The accused has the right of appeal to the Court of Cassation.

b. If the appeal to Cassation is dismissed, the accused may petition for clemency to the King of Italy. Such a petition is considered by the Minister of Justice who advises the sovereign thereon.

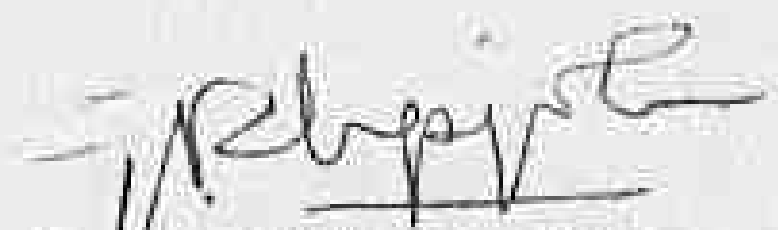
5. Under international law the position of the King is taken by the Allied Military Government. In the early days of AMG the Military Governor delegated to the Chief Civil Affairs Officer all his functions in this matter. Pursuant to such delegation this Commission takes the

advice of the Minister of Justice and gives decisions in accordance with that advice.

6. It is considered that if in addition to this procedure further petitions which may be addressed personally to the Supreme Allied Commander are to be examined before a sentence is carried out, the additional delay will have most unfortunate results.

7. In the particular case of BMDI Enrico the papers are at the present moment being examined by the Minister of Justice. The petition addressed to the Supreme Allied Commander has been forwarded to the Minister with a request that he give all proper consideration to it. So far no opinion has been received from the Minister on the case.

The undersigned, BERTI Giovanni, a resident of Rome, living at Via Urbana 33, has a son who formed part of the Republican-Fascist army. He has been condemned to death by the Supreme Court of Assise of Reggio Emilia on 8 June 1945. His name is BERTI Enrico.

In these days the Milan Section of the Court of Cassation has denied an appeal.

Since my son is charged with minor offences, the sentence of capital punishment must be attributed to the fact that the judges wanted to make a single block of six guilty persons (in fact the same witnesses who accused him said that my son was much less guilty than the others). Torn by pain, I dare to turn to you, the Supreme Commander of the Allied Military Government in Italy. 92

We know that you have come victorious in the name of Liberty and Justice; we know that in your generous heart harbors no sense of approval for cruelty and vengeance. A poor father and poor mother make an appeal.

To the magnanimity of your heart. We know that at present the execution of the sentence has been suspended while awaiting the revision and the approval of the Allies. This has been stated by the Italian Judicial organs this morning.

A gesture of clemency can save a young life, a whole family. We will be eternally grateful.

My dear Mr. Ambassador:

I am now in a position to give you the following further information on the case of BONGIOVANNI Carlo.

The two children of Bongiovanni were never taken to prison, but were left in the custody of their aged grandmother, where they still are.

The wife, Consuelo Rodriguez, was in prison because she was alleged to have accompanied her husband on his tours and to have been present when his murders were arranged and executed. As no charges had been filed against her, however, she has been released on the orders of AMF. She is now at liberty in Turin, but she has given an assurance that she will not leave the city. The Italian authorities have been informed that if it is intended to bring charges against her in the future, the full requirements of Italian procedure must be respected.

The stay of execution upon the husband is causing considerable resentment locally.

My dear Colonel Behrens,

In continuation of my letter of June 25th regarding the Bongiovanni case I wish to inform you that I am in receipt of a message from the Department of State at Washington to the effect that the President of Venezuela sent a radio message to the Lieutenant General of the Realm soliciting a suspension of the sentence on Bongiovanni and a commutation thereof if possible.

According to the message which I have received from the Department of State, it would appear that the President of Venezuela desires me to ascertain whether the Lieutenant General of the Realm actually received this message, whether any action was taken thereon and what additional steps the Government of Venezuela might properly take in the premises. I wish to add, however, that in view of the fact that the sentence against Bongiovanni appears to be entirely regular, I would not wish to appear to intervene in any way in this case on behalf of the American Government.

I shall be grateful for any information which you may be able to furnish me along the foregoing lines. 42

1. Our PR/LE/427 of 22 June 45 refers. — 109A

2. Since that time representations were made by the Swiss Consul regarding the wife Consuelo Rodriguez who was in prison here. The two children, incidentally, were not, but were in custody of their aged grandmother.

3. Consuelo Rodriguez is alleged to have accompanied her husband on his tours and to have been present when he was arranging some of his murders and having them carried out.

4. It was found, however, that formal charges had not been made against her nor any application to the Procuratore Generale for extension of the time for doing so. The Provincial Public Safety Officer accordingly ordered her release and this order has been carried out by the Italian authorities who have moreover been warned that in this case as in all other cases they must conform strictly with the law. The P.P.S.O. has the lady's assurance that she will not leave Torino without his knowledge and he does not anticipate that any charges will in fact be brought against her. If they are brought the strict requirements of arrest and procedure will be carried out.

5. The stay of execution of the sentence against BONGIOVANNI has apparently raised considerable displeasure here: possibly this is ill-informed opinion which does not appreciate that the "delay" to date is only to allow of further investigations.

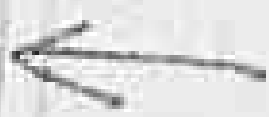

1. Pursuant to your request I have made a careful investigation of the trial of the above subject before the Extraordinary Court of Assize. I should add that *I have followed carefully all* the proceedings of the Court and have attended some of the sessions held. In addition, however, following your telephone call, I conferred at length with the Publico Ministero and with Counsel for the defense, *Singly* ~~jointly~~ and together, and I have also spoken to persons who attended the trial of Possenti.

2. The facts, which are *undisputed* ~~the~~ ^{as} follows: Possenti was accused of 2 crimes each of which carried the death penalty and the Court convicted him of both crimes. In respect to one charge, that concerning participation in a proceedings leading to the death of a leading citizen of Savona, Possenti offered to prove that *during the* period in question he was stationed on service at the town of Calizzano, some distance away. He asked the witnesses. The Court heard one. The Pubblico Ministero conceded, however, that during the period involved Possenti did in ~~fact~~ ^{fact} live in Calizzano. The request of Possenti for a continuance to bring the second witness, the proprietor of the hotel of Calizzano, was ~~thereupon~~ ^{thereupon} refused. Counsel for the defense did not insist on the point because he believed it of no significance. The Pubblico Ministero adduced *evidence* that notwithstanding Possenti's residence in Calizzano he was personally connected with the incident in question and the Court ~~found~~ ^{found} Possenti guilty on this charge, as well as on the second charge with aid not relate to the evidence.

Pursuant to your request I have made a careful investigation of the trial of the above subject before the Extraordinary Court of Assize. *I have followed carefully all* I should add that the proceedings of the Court and have attended some of the sessions held. In resp. to one charge, that concerning participation in a proceedings leading to the death of a leading citizen of Savona, Possenti offered to prove that during the period in question he was stationed on service at the town of Calizzano, some distance away. He asked the witnesses. The Court heard one. The Pubbico Ministero conceded, however, that during the period involved Possenti did in ~~fact~~ ^{fact} live in Calizzano. The request of Possenti for a continuance to bring the second witness, the proprietor of the hotel of Calizzano, was ~~thereupon~~ ^{thereupon} refused. Counsel for the defense did not insist on the point because he believed it of no significance. The Pubbico Ministero adduced evidence that notwithstanding Possenti's residence in Calizzano he was personally connected with the incident in question and the Court ^{found} ~~found~~ Possenti guilty on this charge, as well as on the second charge with aid not relating to the evidence described above. The conviction on both charges has been upheld.

3. In my conference with Counsel for the defense, he stated that the witness Possenti wanted to present was immaterial. He also stated that he was satisfied that he had been given a full opportunity to present the defense of Possenti.

4. I might add that I have investigated Defence Counsel Ferro Andrea. He is considered one of the most able co-defendants and experienced Criminal lawyers in town. His defence of Possenti was so

vigorous that the day following the trial writing appeared on the walls accusing him of being a Fascist because of his method of defence of Possenti.

5. I am convinced that the trial was a fair one and that Possenti was properly convicted. Under the circumstances the point of law involved in my inquiry was properly decided in a manner similar to that which would pertain under Anglo-American law. However that may be, the point was decided as a legal point, and not because of ^{any} ~~war~~ prejudice.
