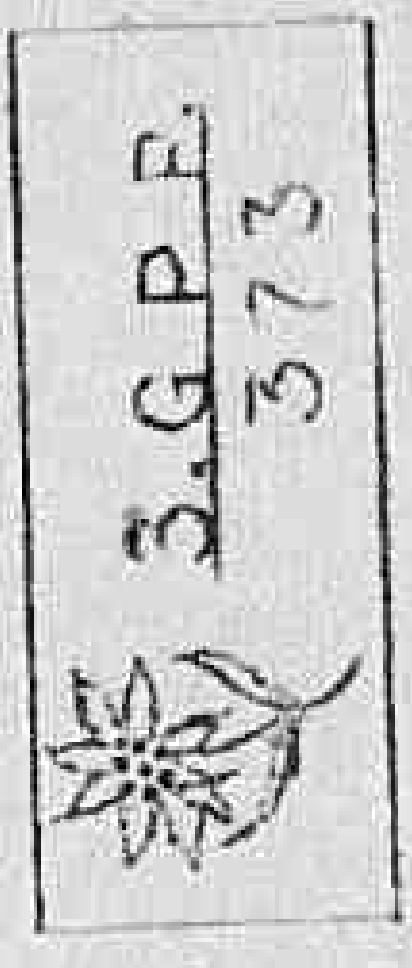

The orders were sent by the 'Capo della provincia di CUNEO' named ANTONIO GALARDO."

SUBJECT:- INVESTIGATION OF WAR CRIMES.

1. With reference to your letter dated the 23rd January, 1945, File LUR/49/PS, and AFHQ Memorandum dated the 11th January, 1945, File No. CR/15000/G-I(E), the attached copies of reports submitted on 6th and 21st July, 1944, through the R.P.S.O. for Legal Officer, Region 4, contain the substance of a serious and disgusting Offence committed against the body of a dead American Pilot.
2. Full statements of F.S.S. and further investigations by Questure, were included in the papers which are probably filed in the first Region 4 archives.
3. Owing to the difficulty of eye-witnesses of the offence not being found in Soriano, having dispersed to their homes in other Provinces, and the pronounced Fascist activities of the two subjects, they were sent to 37I P.W. Camp, where they are still interned.
4. Other cases which may fall within the categories of the Memorandum are under investigation, and when completed, reports will be forwarded.

1. Verbale in connection with above received through Provincial Legal Officer, Pesaro Urbino from the Procuratore del Regno of Pesaro is forwarded in terms of AFHQ, GHO No 697 dated 1 Sep. '44 for necessary action, please.

2. It will be seen that the alleged crimes are said to have taken place on the 6th 7th and 8th April 1944 in the village of CASTELDELCI in the Province of Pesaro Urbino (Sheet 14 1st Ed-AMS 2 5269). A number of old and young men women and children are said to have been shot down indiscriminately by the Germans during moppingup operations following upon local resistance by Patriots. It will be further be seen that no statements of witnesses are included in the Verbale and that there is no indication whether the German unit concerned or any individual members thereof can be identified.

1. This Sub-Commission is grateful for Your Excellency's communication concerning this case.

2. It is understood that Lt. AMORI is being tried "in absentia" and it is assumed that he is guilty of a specific offence under the Italian CPMG.

3. As far as the execution of the two British officers is concerned, if they were shot without judgment or in violation of the established and accepted International War Convention, this act would constitute a war crime.

4. As Your Excellency is no doubt aware such crimes fall under the jurisdiction of Courts especially established by the United Nations for that purpose, and the case of Lt. AMORI would therefore escape the competence of any other legal authority.

1. The Italian judicial authorities have reported to this Sub-Commission that on 8 Sept 1944 at Villa Pennolini, Bivigliano, Florence two farmers PIERACCINI Ottavio and PIERACCINI Francesco were murdered by a German soldier.
2. The German soldier was taken prisoner by British troops who arrived at the Villa Pennolini in the early hours 9 Sept 44.
3. The Italian judicial authorities have asked that steps may be taken to trace this prisoner and hand him over to them for trial. It appears to this HQ that even if the prisoner can be identified and traced it would be contrary to the Geneva Convention to hand him over for trial. Until his guilt is definitely established he is entitled to be treated as a prisoner of war and cannot therefore be handed over to a civilian court for the determination of his guilt.
4. It is thought therefore that the matter should be referred to you in the ordinary course as a war crime.
