SUBJECT : Publication of Demo Christian daily in NABES.

TO : H.E. The Minister of Justice.

1. The Head of the Public Relations Section of ACC to whom Your Excellency's observations have been communicated together with the letter of the Secretary of the Demo-Christian party, points out that the refusal of P.W.B. to allow the necessary newsprint for the publication of the party's daily is due to economic reasons and has no political character.

2. He further suggests that Lt. Col. Munro, of the Allied Publications Board (Office of ex-Messagero, via Tritone) be approached by the Secretary of the Demo Christian Party in order that a practical solution may be found in regard to the possibility of such daily publication taking place in NABES.

3. In the meantime the Secretary's letter has been forwarded to the Political Section whose comments shall be forwarded to Your Excellency in due course.

SUBJECT : Publication of Italian Journals.
TO : Public Relations Officer, HQ. ACC.

1. Reference your FRB 2 dated 22 July 1944.
2. This Sub-Commission has made enquiries from various sources in order to answer intelligently your question as to whether the three publications mentioned in your letter should be given permission to publish.
3. The first of the three "Corriere Giudiziario" was an old publication of good standing in professional quarters. Apparently it was suspended in 1925 as it did not subscribe to all fascist doctrines. If any permission is to be granted this would be the one to consider first from a favourable standpoint. The Minister of Justice approves this.
4. As to "Giustizia", I understand that this is a proposed new venture. If there was a wealth of paper available there would seem to be no reason against it being printed but I cannot see at this stage why a new publication of this nature should be necessary. Apparently the sponsors are satisfactory.
5. As to "Il Giornale dei Magistrati" - it was a small publication with limited circulation that suspended its publication during the war. There appears to be no objection to the re-commencement of its publication but I gather that not a great deal would be gained from its resumption.

1. Further to this office letter ACC/4139/L dated 8 May 1944.

2. At a conference with the Minister of Justice yesterday the status of the publications referred to in paras 3 and 4 of your letter were discussed, and the Italian official opinion expressed was to the effect that whilst the journals mentioned in para 4 could be regarded as essential and useful publications, the " Tribuna Forense " mentioned in para 3 had been correctly described by you.

3. In answer to the remaining points, such legal publications fall roughly into 3 classes viz official, statistical and particular. The latter representing the particular point of a section of professional interests. It is agreed that in regard to these the observations under para 5 of your letter are appropriate.

TO : Col. G. R. Upjohn,

Allied Control Commission,

1. A number of applications for permits to publish periodic journals with specialised interests concerning the professions have been submitted to the Central and Local Boards.
2. The Central Board has accordingly decided that appropriate Sub-Commissions of ACC, or other experts, should be invited to give their opinion on the advisability or not of granting such licenses. The aim of APB is to encourage the publication of one representative periodical in each publishing centre (Palermo, Bari, Naples, Catanzaro and Cagliari) rather than to grant permits to a number of small sheets.
3. The Board has therefore, assuming that you will be in favour of this endeavour, asked me to enclose an application, TRIBUNA FORENSE, for your opinion, although the Board itself is inclined to consider it non-representative.
4. For your information, I might mention that, before adopting the above mentioned plan, the Boards have already granted the following periodicals, concerned with the legal profession, licenses to publish:

TEMI LUCANA
FORO SICILIANO

Naples;
Potenza;
Palermo.

5. In the event of the local Italian Legal interests combining to have one representative periodical, the Board would then revise the isolated permits already granted, as long as that could be done fairly.
