ATTEMPT TO CATCH PRESIDENT OF FASCIST COURT UNDER PROTECTION OF THE SPANISH EMBASSY.

On the 2nd of June I tried to catch the president of the fascist court who condemned me! Did not succeed though!!! His daughter was marrying and so I thought it might have been possible to have seen him and got hold of him, but even if he had been at the wedding, which was celebrated in the groom's home, it would have been very difficult to have caught him, as he was well under diplomatic protection. In fact the Spanish embassy lent him their car and it remained very near the door so that should anything have happened he could have made a dash for the car and been at once on neutral territory, or rather under extraterritorial protection!!!

The only thing that I could do was to write to the newspapers about it especially as the groom's family did not have a penny before 1935 and then move piles of money with ammunitions for the Abyssinian war and then the Spanish civil war. The bride's father has 16 death sentences on his conscience, and was always swanking about how many years imprisonment he had given, he kept a regular statistic of all that he had done!!!

He has been in Rome all the time and what astonished me was that there was some American officers at the wedding. I was there with 2 police officers but we were not able to do anything.
