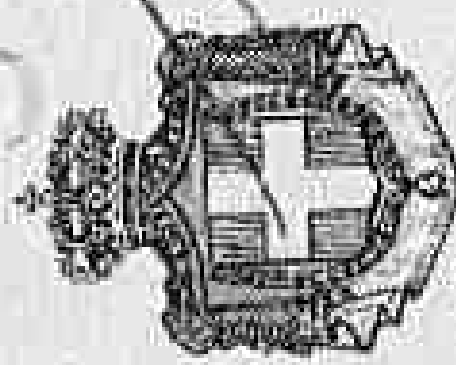

Ciannella Rocco was called up on the 1st of July 1940 and later on re-called again in Sept. 1942, mobilised and sent overseas. From that moment his allowances as a civilian were cashed by his father until August 1943.

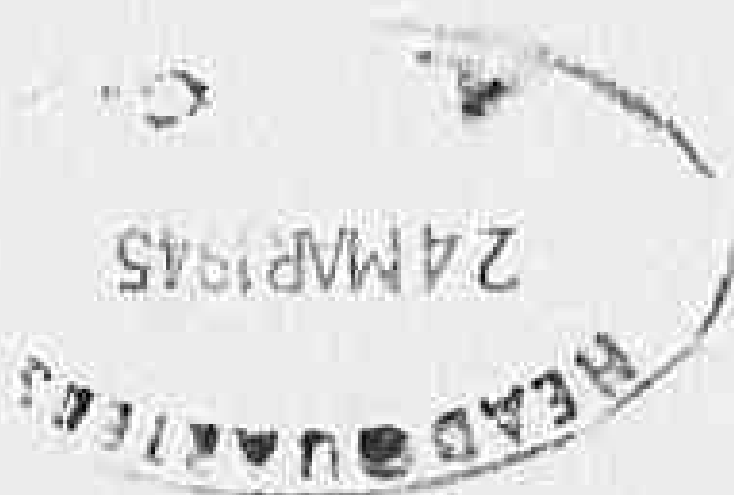

1. The procedure outlined in para 2 of Colonel LEADLEY's letter cannot be dispensed with and no Italian notary could validly accept the deposit of a power of attorney signed abroad, without the signature of the Consul being legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
2. It must be borne in mind that in this case the Consul does not execute the power but merely legalizes the American notary public's signature.
3. Some formalities may be avoided if the grantor signs a Consular power of attorney, however, the Consul's signature must always be legalized as stated above.

1. In connection with a request made by the sister of the above for the restoration of his property to her, a power of attorney in her favour was submitted to a notary for examination. He reports, however, that to have effect in Italy, this mandate, written in Italian, prepared in the U.S.A. and countersigned by the Italian Consul in New York as of 25 January 1940, requires to be regularized by the Stamp Office in Florence, to be sent to Rome so that the signature of the U.S. Consul may be confirmed at the Ministero degli Esteri and therefore deposited with a notary for registration.

2. May I please be advised whether these formalities are considered essential before the mandate can be recognised for the purpose of restoration ?

3. It should be borne in mind that the above will no doubt apply to new procuras now being executed and sent here via Consular channels.

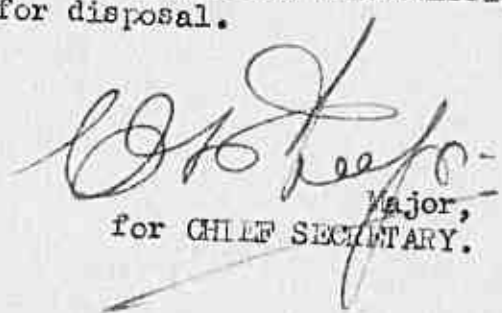
