SUBJECT: Cancellation of Administrative Order Number 38.

TO : Regional Commissioner, Region IV A.C.C.

1. The responsibility for defascination of the head of officer of para-statal institutions rests with A.C.C. Headquarters.
2. As previously pointed out, and emphasized in our letter of 25 June 1944 Ref/17/32/3, which comments on Executive Memorandum No. 30, it is particularly important that no decisions be made by Regional Commissioners about Utility Companies when their work affects military operations.
3. Before any action can be taken by Regional Commissioners, they must submit their case to Headquarters A.C.C. for decision.
4. Our letter of 20 July 1944 Ref/17/GA/46 requested the Regional Commissioner, Region IV to refer all orders and administrative instructions to Headquarters for approval before publication.
5. Since 20 July 1944 five Administrative Orders and Instructions, including Administrative Order No. 38, have been published by the Regional Commissioner, Region IV without submitting them to Headquarters A.C.C.
6. It is understood that Administrative Order No. 38 has been withdrawn by the Regional Commissioner, Region IV.
7. To avoid possible misunderstanding, it is requested that the Regional Commissioner follow the procedure of paragraph 4 of this letter.

MEMORANDUM TO: Acting Head, Admin Sec.

1. Enclosed herewith Administrative Order No. 34 Rome Region dated 21 July 1944, which I mentioned to you yesterday. I have had the examination made to determine exactly what the Istituto Coloniale Italiano is. I find that it was created in 1906 for the purpose of studying colonial problems and colonial propaganda. After the advent of fascism, it changed its name to Istituto Coloniale Fascista. In 1937 it again changed its name to Istituto Nazionale Fascista per l'Africa Italiana. After 25 July 1943 it changed its name again to Istituto Nazionale per l'Africa Italiana. In the period of the Fascist Republican regime, this institution was maintained under the name of Istituto per l'Africa Italiana but from practical purposes has not functioned further. L'Istituto which in the period of its greatest functioning (1937-1940) had 125,000 members, has always been an institution of national character in various cities of Italy and in the colonies there existed local sections. In Rome there naturally existed a local section in addition to the central seat of the Istituto.

2. From the foregoing information, it would appear that Colonel Poletti has again exercised extra-territorial jurisdiction. *Consequences are other implications.*

SUBJECT : Regional Orders.

TO : Regional Commissioner, ROME Region.

1. If you have occasion to issue any Regional Orders or any other instructions concerning the status, remuneration or treatment of Italian officials, such orders or instructions must make it quite clear that they only apply to officials whose sphere of duty is solely within your region and that they do not apply to national officials (such as Ministers or Judges of the Court of Cassation) or any other officials whose spheres of duty may extend beyond your Region.

Any action in respect of such national or other officials will be taken by this Hq.

2. Before issuing any Regional Order or any other public order or memorandum, you are required to submit a copy thereof to EC & MC Section and to the Legal Sub-Commission.
