Reference your AMG/200/27 of 20 December 1943, I have today discussed your suggestion with Lt. Col. Shields. We are agreed that Lt. Comdr. Musmanno will not be suitable for the purpose indicated, because he will already be fully employed as an Officer of AMG, 5th Army. It is felt that the suggestion of this Officer's name arises from a misapprehension as to the purpose with which the request for an officer was originally made. What is desired is an A.C.C. officer to act as Liaison Officer with AMG, 5th Army, more particularly with reference to Italian Courts, so as to ensure continuity of policy in view of the intended taking over of Rome by A.C.C. at an early date. It is requested that further consideration be given to the question whether Major Hannaford cannot be made available for this duty. Lt. Col. Shields attaches considerable importance to the problem of liaison with A.C.C., in view of the prospect of having to hand over to them at an early date.

 DATE: 3 December, 1943.

1. Reference your letter of 29 November 43.
2. It is my desire that the eventual placing of the legal officers now attached to AMG, 8th Army, should be as stated in my previous letter to you. It appears to me that their present placing by Lt Col Temperley must have been determined with this end in view. Meanwhile, I wish you to feel that, so long as these officers are attached to AMG, 8th Army, they are entirely at your disposal, to be used in such places and for such duties as you, in your discretion think most expedient. All I ask is, that should you see fit to vary their assignments, you will keep me informed.
3. I agree entirely with the views expressed by you as to the desirability of speedy justice in the forward areas. I feel sure you will find the legal officers concerned will be ready enough to cooperate in securing this. The matter of ~~records~~ of cases tried is one which, for the time being, is of more concern to you than to me, since, if I understand correctly the procedure laid down, all ~~records~~ of cases tried in areas administered by AMG, 8th Army, must be forwarded through you, and they will only be forwarded through me if and when any portion of the territory is handed over to Regional control.
4. I take no responsibility for Form J 1. I sent forward copies of the form because of the directive issued by AMG Headquarters, and because I thought that the idea behind the form was a good one and that its use was worth trying. Having seen your comments on the form and the alternative form designed by you, I find myself in general agreement with you. I think that only experience will show how this particular problem can best be handled. As you are at present the man in command on the spot, I have no doubt you will take ~~complete~~ note of how the procedure designed by you works in practice, and make any improvements that appear to be required. Please keep me informed about this.

1. With reference to your two d/o letters of 28th October and 1st November 1943, numbered AMG/207/3 and AMG/200/1 respectively and your letter AMG/201/1 of 29th October 1943, I wish to apologise for the delay in replying to them but during the last two days the impending change from Region III to 5th Army Mobile Group which is being worked out in this town has been crystallising and with new staff coming in I wanted to get matters cleared before writing to you.

2. Staff. At the date of arrival in Region III the staff was distributed as follows in addition to myself.

Legal Officer - Naples Town & Province, Lt. Col. Mc Clain.

" " Salerno, Lt. Barden.

" " Avellino & Benevento, Capt. Gold.

Liaison Officer With Italian Courts, Lt. Sabatino.

I attach a list of the present distribution.

Within the last few days there has been lent to me from Region IV - Lt. Col. Chapman, who is assisting Lt. Col. Mc Clain. Major Waugh, who I have sent to Salerno and Major Woodward who I have sent to Avellino both as temporary helpers. Two days ago a signal came from ATHQ intimating the imminent arrival by air of Major Ainslie and Holt for "temporary attachment to Region 3 Legal Division". They have arrived with no further explanation and so I have posted Major Ainslie to Naples Province to be with Mc Clain. This is done with a view to Mc Clain taking over from me as Regional Legal Officer and Ainslie taking over from Mc Clain. The situation is complicated however, as it is not settled yet whether Mc Clain will take over from me. There is a school of thought that he should be an S.C.A.O. but no decision has yet been reached as to his appointment. Major Holt will go to Avellino so that Capt. Gold may be Legal Officer in Benevento solely.

Up to date the 5th Army Mobile Group has not commenced to function as a separate entity to Region III and therefore I am acting as Regional Legal Officer until such time as the separation is effected and the rear boundary of the 5th Army is moved forward of Naples, when the Mobile Group will move out of Naples so far as I can understand.

4. The legal representation on the TO/WE for the 5th Army Mobile Group is one Officer Lt. Colonel to be filled by me.

5. At the moment therefor as R.S.L.O. & S.L.O. of 5th Army A.M.G. jointly I have control of all the legal officers in all Region III territory occupied. The legal officers in the provinces are responsible for the supervision of the Italian Courts the establishment of A.M.Courts and supervision of C.A.O.'s sitting as Summary Courts.
6. Proclamations. Group Captain Benson, Eight Army, was here yesterday. We discussed inter alia Proclamations he does not require any from me. We have reprinted 6000 of 1, 2 (Notice & Warning) 3, 4, 5, 8, 12, 13, General Orders Nos 1 & 2, 6 & 11 are being held up pending amendments, I was already reprinted.
7. G.O. Benson is anxious as are the S.F.O. Col. Barrett, who is going with 5th Army and myself to get some uniformity in regard to posting Proclamation 5, General Order 1 and an order opening banks and raising the moratorium. Col Barrett and I have proposed posting 5 and General Order 1 & carrying a General Order 3 similar to the one issued here for Naples Province a copy of which is enclosed, with suitable blanks for completion locally to post when Banks will be reopened.
8. Reports. Col. Chanler sent me a letter asking for a report for October. I had sent two reports up to 22nd October but I sent him copies of these with a further report to 31st October 1943 which I had to write in a hurry to catch the plane. I enclose a copy. I would draw your attention particularly to paragraph 2.
9. Merchant Seamen: I would be extremely grateful if you could let me know of any decision made as a result of discussions which took place in Palermo before I left as to the policy for the disciplining British Merchant seamen who commit unlawful acts on shore. No cases have arisen yet on this but I am sure they will. Col. Chanler suggested that the American counterpart would be dealt with by the commander of the area. I have not yet heard of any major offences committed by U.S. Merchant Seamen.
10. I am not altogether happy about the situation here. Political uncertainty has had its effect in co-operation with the National Officials and uncertainties in policy have affected our attitude towards them. I am looking forward to seeing you over here just as soon as you can manage, and I hope it is before we leave this town where we are moderately comfortable and take to tents in the snow of the Appennines.
