Subject: - Local Italian Legislation.

A.L.G. 8th Army, have raised the question of whether local Italian legislature in their area should be published under the endorsement "Published with the permission of the Allied Military Government".

2. The point is a small one but it raises the much larger one of whether General Administrative Instruction No. 19 (See copy at page 1 of this file) now requires amendment.

3. I have made no enquiry yet as to whether Councils of the Prefecture and Provincial Giuntas are operating generally in the occupied territory in Italy or as to whether they could be re-established if they are not so operating.

4. I never much liked the above administrative Instruction as it purported to suspend and alter the Italian Constitutional law, without leading to any new or better system for the future. As areas may soon be returned to the full sovereignty of the Italian Government, I think it is important that action should be taken to re-establish the Provincial administration in the form in which they will continue to operate after Military Government is withdrawn.

5. The matter would appear to be one of political policy to be discussed between A.L.G. and the Italian Government and whatever decision is come to will not concern us much so long as it does not interfere with Military Government. It is important though, I think, for this administration to re-establish the Italian local government system on the right basis so that the eventual hand-over is facilitated.

6. May I please have your directions as to whether I should raise this matter with Colonel Urquhart and as to any lines of policy you wish put forward.

GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION NO.19.

The following instructions have been issued :-

As from the date hereof until further notice, Regolamenti Comunali shall be made in accordance with the following procedure :-

1. Regolamenti Comunali will be submitted to the Prefect of the Province for approval after being made.
2. The Prefect will not submit Regolamenti Comunali to the Council of the Prefettura or to the Provincial Giunta for advice or to the Central Government for approval.
3. The Prefect will after considering Regolamenti Comunali received by him for approval submit the same to the Senior Civil Affairs Officer of the Province with his recommendations.
4. The Senior Civil Affairs Officer, after considering the Regolamenti Comunali together with the recommendations of the Prefect and of the Civil Affairs Officer (if any) for the Comune, issue directions to the Prefect to approve or refuse approval of the Regolamenti.
5. Regolamenti Comunali, after approval by the Prefect as abovementioned shall be of full force and effect.
