NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following procedure will in future be adopted in respect of Powers of Attorney and other formal documents executed in Tripolitania and requiring to be validated for use outside the Territory:—

1. All such documents will be executed before a Notary Public or Kadi, whose signature will be legalised in the usual way by the Tribunale. They will then be sent to H.Q., B.M.A., for verification by the Legal Adviser of the signature of the Presidente of the Tribunale or of the Cancelliere Delegato.
2. Accompanying the document, when it is sent to H.Q., B.M.A., must be a letter giving the name and full address of the person outside the Territory to whom the document is ultimately to be sent.
3. All such documents require to be legalised by the British Consulate, CAIRO, unless intended for use in:—
 - (a) Those parts of Italy, occupied by the Allied Forces; or
 - (b) Cyrenaica, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Somalia, Somaliland or Madagascar; or
 - (c) Any other enemy territory occupied by the Allied Forces.
4. Whenever a document requiring legalisation by the British Consulate, CAIRO, is sent to H.Q., B.M.A., it must therefore also be accompanied by 240 M.A.L. in cash, to cover the consular fee of 9s. 6d. and the difference in exchange.
5. Any person desiring the document to be returned to him after legalisation by the British Consulate, CAIRO, so that he may himself send it to its final destination, should inform H.Q., B.M.A.
6. Documents intended for use in those parts of Italy occupied by the Allied Forces will be sent by H.Q., B.M.A., to Civil Affairs Branch, G.H.Q., M.E.F. for onward transmission to the Allied Control Commission, Italy, and will travel by air, provided they are not too heavy or bulky.

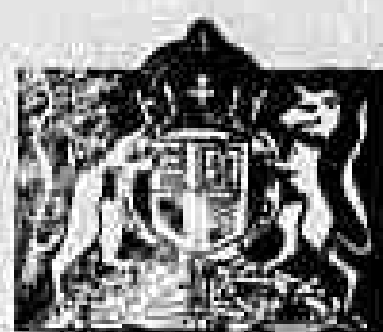

PROCLAMATION No. 73

Article 1. — The following article shall be substituted for Article 7 of the Military Authority Lire Notes Proclamation No. 46:—

« EXPORT OF BRITISH MILITARY AUTHORITY NOTES OR M.A. LIRE - Any person who exports or attempts to export British Military Authority notes or M.A. Lire out of the territory without a written permit from the Deputy Controller of Finance and Accounts or from an officer appointed by the Deputy Controller of Finance and Accounts for this purpose shall be guilty of an offence under this Proclamation. »
