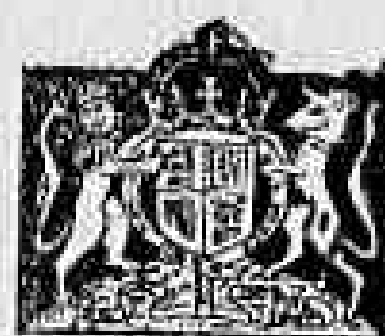

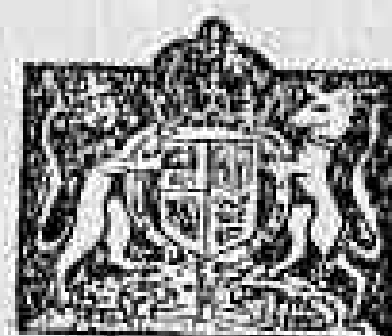

Registration of Births and Deaths of British Subjects in Tripolitania

GENERAL NOTICE No. 120

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs has authorized the Legal Adviser to the British Military Administration, or any person acting as his assistant or under his direction to register in the Consular Register births and deaths of British Subjects born or dying in Tripolitania.
2. The British Nationality and Status of Aliens Act 1943 gives to persons excluded from British Nationality under previous Acts another opportunity to acquire British Nationality by the registration of their births in the Consular Register.
3. The following persons born abroad of British fathers are British subjects without it being essential that their births should be registered in the Consular Register, although registration of such births is desirable:—

- (a) the child born legitimate of a British father who was himself born in British territory, or on a British ship, or in a country where His Majesty, The King exercised at the time of the birth jurisdiction over British subjects;
- (b) the child born legitimate of a British father in a country where His Majesty exercised at the time jurisdiction over British subjects, wherever the father was born;
- (c) the child born legitimate of a British father who is a person to whom a certificate of imperial naturalization has been granted;
- (d) the child born legitimate of a British father who was at the time of the birth in the service of the Crown.

4. (a) The birth of any child (not being a British subject in virtue of the foregoing paragraph) born legitimate on or after the 22nd April 1942, outside His Majesty's dominions of a father who was at the time of the child's birth a British subject may be registered, as of right, in the Consular Register of births of British subjects within one year of the date of the birth.
- (b) The birth of any such child whenever born may be registered at any time if the permission of the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs is obtained.

A child to whom either of the foregoing sub-paragraphs (a) or (b) applies whose birth has been registered at a British Consulate is thereafter deemed to be, and always to have been, a natural-born British subject. Subject to the exceptions mentioned below, any such person, however, ceases to be a British subject unless, on reaching the age of 21 and before attaining the age of 22, he or she makes a declaration of retention of British nationality before a British Consul or other appropriate authority. The exceptions to this rule are as follows:—

- (1) where a declaration is made, with the permission of the Secretary of State after the period specified above;
- (2) the person concerned had already attained the age of 21 when his birth was registered; or
- (3) he has at any time during the present war period been a member of His Majesty's forces; or
- (4) he is able to satisfy the Secretary of State that he was not a member of His Majesty's forces during the present war period owing to his being engaged on work of national importance or for some other cause beyond his control.

It is important that persons who claim exemption from the requirement of a declaration of retention of British nationality in virtue of (3) or (4) should carefully preserve such evidence as they may have of the service, or work of national importance, or circumstances on which their claim to exemption is based.

5. All persons desiring that the birth or death of a person of or claiming British nationality be registered, or persons wishing to make a declaration of retention of British nationality, should apply in person or in writing to the office of the Legal Adviser, B.M.A. Tripolitania, and should bring with them or send by post any available documents, such as birth and marriage certificates or passports, in order to establish the claim to British nationality in accordance with paragraph 3 and 4 hereof.

Registration of Births and Deaths of British Subjects in Tripolitania

GENERAL NOTICE No. 120

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs has authorized the Legal Adviser to the British Military Administration, or any person acting as his assistant or under his direction to register in the Consular Registers births and deaths of British Subjects born or dying in Tripolitania.
2. The British Nationality and Status of Aliens Act 1943 gives to persons excluded from British Nationality under previous Acts another opportunity to acquire British Nationality by the registration of their births in the Consular Register.
3. The following persons born abroad of British fathers are British subjects without it being essential that their births should be registered in the Consular Register, although registration of such births is desirable:—

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Military Administration of Tripolitania (Amendment)

PROCLAMATION No. 80

WHEREAS the Military Government of Tripolitania was by Warrant dated the 9th November 1944 under the hand of the Chief Civil Affairs Officer, Middle East Forces vested in me subject to his directions

NOW THEREFORE, I, TRAVERS ROBERT BLACKLEY, Brigadier, HEREBY PROCLAIM:—

Article 1. — The following Article is hereby substituted for Article 2 of Proclamation No. 29 which provided for the Military Administration of Tripolitania

« All legislative, executive, political and administrative functions necessary for the carrying on of the Military Government of the civil population of Tripolitania shall vest in and be exercised in accordance with the laws and usages of war by the Officer for the time being holding the appointment of Deputy Chief Civil Affairs Officer, Tripolitania, subject to the directions of the Chief Civil Affairs Officer, Middle East Forces.»

Article 2. — This proclamation shall come into force and take effect as from the 9th November 1944.
