

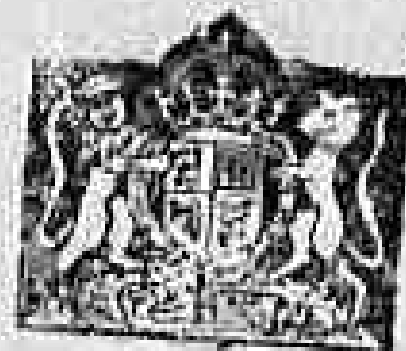

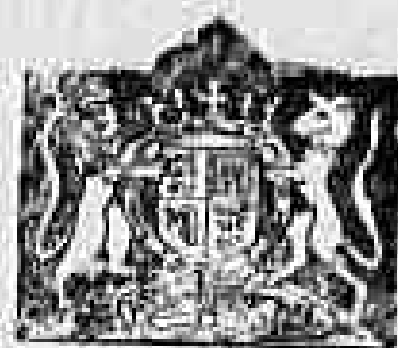

Members will be required to wear the prescribed uniform on duty. A free initial issue of uniform, equipment and other necessities will be made on enlistment. Free replacement will be made when required except when the article has been damaged or lost through the member's fault or neglect in which event he will be required to pay.

A plain clothes allowance will be paid to members required to perform duty in civilian clothes.

9. ACCOMMODATION.

Members will be required to occupy such quarters as the Commissioner may prescribe. Married members and their families may at the discretion of the Commissioner be allowed to occupy married quarters or to provide their own accommodation. Married quarters for members and their families will be made available when possible.

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10. LEAVE.

A member may, subject to the exigencies of the service, and at the discretion of the Commissioner be granted leave on full pay and allowances for not more than 21 days in any one year. The whole or part of such annual leave may be accumulated, provided the consent of the Commissioner is obtained.

In addition the Commissioner may grant compassionate leave at his discretion. Such leave will be without pay.

11. MEDICAL TREATMENT AND SICK LEAVE.

(a) Free medical treatment is provided.

(b) A member who is unfit to perform his duties owing to sickness or injury may in respect of each illness be granted leave with full pay and allowances up to one month as from the date of absence from duty.

(c) If at the end of such period he is still unfit for duty he may be granted any vacation leave for which he is eligible up to a maximum of 30 days.

(d) A member who has been granted the leave provided in paragraphs (b) and (c) and is still unfit to return to duty may then be granted leave on half pay and allowances provided that the total leave so granted shall not exceed one sixth of his service.

(e) A member who is unfit to perform his duties owing to sickness or injury which is certified by a medical officer to be due to the member's own fault or culpable neglect may be granted pay and allowances up to a maximum of 30 days from the date of absence from duty but shall be liable for such forfeiture of pay and allowances, not exceeding one half, as the Commissioner may think fit. Thereafter the member shall receive no pay or allowances and is liable to discharge from the Force forthwith.

12. RESIGNATION.

No member may resign unless he has obtained the consent of the Commissioner or has given three months notice in writing.

13. TERMINATION OF SERVICE.

The service of any member may be terminated at any time by the Chief Administrator in the case of an Inspector and by the Commissioner in the case of other ranks if such member is found to be mentally or physically unfit to carry out his duties or unlikely to become an efficient member of the Force. He may also be discharged on reduction of establishment or on conviction by a Military or Civil Court.

(c) If at the end of such period he is still unfit for duty he may be granted any vacation leave for which he is eligible up to a maximum of 30 days.

(d) A member who has been granted the leave provided in paragraphs (b) and (c) and is still unfit to return to duty may then be granted leave on half pay and allowances provided that the total leave so granted shall not exceed one sixth of his service.

(e) A member who is unfit to perform his duties owing to sickness or injury which is certified by a medical officer to be due to the member's own fault or culpable neglect may be granted pay and allowances up to a maximum of 30 days from the date of absence from duty but shall be liable for such forfeiture of pay and allowances, not exceeding one half, as the Commissioner may think fit. Thereafter the member shall receive no pay or allowances and is liable to discharge from the Force forthwith.

12. RESIGNATION.

No member may resign unless he has obtained the consent of the Commissioner or has given three months notice in writing.

13. TERMINATION OF SERVICE.

The service of any member may be terminated at any time by the Chief Administrator in the case of an Inspector and by the Commissioner in the case of other ranks if such member is found to be mentally or physically unfit to carry out his duties or unlikely to become an efficient member of the Force. He may also be discharged on reduction of establishment or on conviction by a Military or Civil Court.

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14. DISCIPLINE.

Members are subject to the Tripolitania Police Force Discipline Regulation No. 1.

They are also subject to British Military Law under Section 476 of the Army Act and liable to trial by Court Martial for offences under that Act. Members are also liable to trial by British Military Courts of the British Military Administration for criminal offences.

RULES OF PROCEDURE PRESCRIBED FOR USE IN MILITARY COURTS

GENERAL NOTICE No. 199

IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for public information that in exercise of the power contained in Article 18 of the Military Courts Proclamation No. 85, the Acting Chief Administrator has this day made the following amendments to existing rules and created the additional rule hereinafter specified:—

AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING RULES

Add to Rule 46 the words:—

« On charges admitted by the accused the Court may, if it is satisfied that the accused understands the nature of his admission, require the prosecution only to call such witnesses as it considers necessary for its own information as to the nature and circumstances of the case ».

Delete Rule 68 as at present worded and substitute therefor the words:

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« The Court may order the execution of the punishment, or where the punishment awarded is both imprisonment and fine, the execution of either part thereof to be conditional on the happening of any event ».

Add to Rule 69 the words:—

« But before any such committal order is executed the accused shall be brought before the Court to explain his default ».

CREATION OF ADDITIONAL RULE

Add new Rule 72 'A' « Written statement by accused »

« No statement in writing taken from the accused person shall be admitted in evidence unless

- (i) the statement has been made and taken down in the presence of an Officer of the Standing Military Court and an English translation thereof has been recorded at the time by that officer; the statement shall be taken down in the language in which the accused makes it unless such language is incapable of reproduction in written form;
- (ii) that Officer has satisfied himself before the statement is made that it is entirely voluntary and not induced by any form of threat or promise;
- (iii) the statement has, immediately after being recorded, been read by the accused, or if he cannot read, been read out to him in the language in which he made it and any correction which he desires has been inserted and he has been invited to sign or put his mark to the completed statement;
- (iv) the Court has satisfied itself at the hearing by (inter alia) giving the accused an opportunity to give evidence (or at his option to make an unsworn statement) as to the circumstances in which the statement was made, that the above conditions have been fulfilled. A Certificate to this effect by the officer before whom the statement was taken shall be prima facie evidence thereof but where the admissibility of the statement is challenged by the accused the Court shall require the attendance as witness of that Officer unless he is himself a member of the Court.

The above amendments and additional rule shall come into force on the 1st September, 1945.

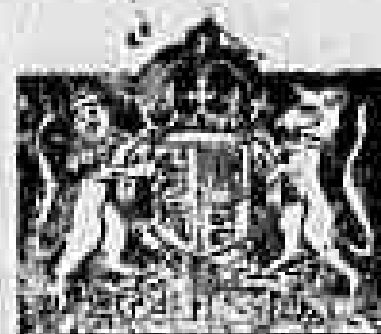

RULES OF PROCEDURE PRESCRIBED FOR USE IN MILITARY COURTS

GENERAL NOTICE No. 199

IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED for public information that in exercise of the power contained in Article 18 of the Military Courts Proclamation No. 85, the Acting Chief Administrator has this day made the following amendments to existing rules and created the additional rule hereinafter specified:—

AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING RULES

Add to Rule 46 the words:—

« On charges admitted by the accused the Court may, if it is satisfied that the accused understands the nature of his admission, require the prosecution only to call such witnesses as it considers necessary for its own information as to the nature and circumstances of the case ».

Delete Rule 68 as at present worded and substitute therefor the words:

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« The Court may order the execution of the punishment, or where the punishment awarded is both imprisonment and fine, the execution of either part thereof to be conditional on the happening of any event ».

Add to Rule 69 the words:—

« But before any such committal order is executed the accused shall be brought before the Court to explain his default ».

CREATION OF ADDITIONAL RULE

Add new Rule 72 'A' « Written statement by accused »

« No statement in writing taken from the accused person shall be admitted in evidence unless

- (i) the statement has been made and taken down in the presence of an Officer of the Standing Military Court and an English translation thereof has been recorded at the time by that officer; the statement shall be taken down in the language in which the accused makes it unless such language is incapable of reproduction in written form;
- (ii) that Officer has satisfied himself before the statement is made that it is entirely voluntary and not induced by any form of threat or promise;
- (iii) the statement has, immediately after being recorded, been read by the accused, or if he cannot read, been read out to him in the language in which he made it and any correction which he desires has been inserted and he has been invited to sign or put his mark to the completed statement;
- (iv) the Court has satisfied itself at the hearing by (inter alia) giving the accused an opportunity to give evidence (or at his option to make an unsworn statement) as to the circumstances in which the statement was made, that the above conditions have been fulfilled. A Certificate to this effect by the officer before whom the statement was taken shall be prima facie evidence thereof but where the admissibility of the statement is challenged by the accused the Court shall require the attendance as witness of that Officer unless he is himself a member of the Court.

The above amendments and additional rule shall come into force on the 1st September, 1945.

REGULATION No. 4

I, REGINALD FRANK ASHFORD, Captain, British Merchant Navy, Acting Port Manager in exercise of the powers conferred on the Port Manager by Article 7 (a) and (b) of Control of Waterborne Craft Proclamation No. 82 hereby make the following Regulation:—

1. Control of Waterborne Craft Regulations 1, 2 and 3 are hereby repealed but so that any person who has committed any offence thereunder prior to the date hereof may be convicted at any time.
2. No person shall anchor or beach or land fish from any waterborne craft, or attempt or assist anyone to do the same at any place other than
 - (a) the harbours of Tripoli, Misurata Marina, Homs and Zuara Marina.
 - (b) the beaches at Sirte, Zliten, Zanzur, Marsa Dila, Sabratha, Marsa Zuaga, Marsa Maraccan and Pisida.
3. No person shall land fish from waterborne craft at any place at Tripoli other than at the Fish Quay in Tripoli Port.
4. No person shall without a licence in writing from the Port Manager fish by line, net or trawl from any waterborne craft in any of the following areas of sea:—
 - (a) the area at Tripoli enclosed by a line drawn from Burg el Leila to the Ras el Zur Beacon and thence to Kaliyusha Beacon and Fort Hamidia;

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(b) the respective areas within 500 metres and beyond 5 kilometres of high water mark of the coast line of Tripolitania.

5. No person shall fish from any waterborne craft with the aid of lamps or flares between the 10th day of May and the 10th day of July (both days inclusive) in every year East of a line drawn due North from Tagiura Point and West of a line drawn due North from Tripoli Harbour Entrance.
