"We have received information about two people in Naples who are stated to be anti-Nazi, extremely capable and likely to be of use to us. The source of this information was a Miss Gabrielle Oppenheim, a young German. Her bona fides have been checked by the Security Service who know nothing against her. She is living in this country at present and working for the "Fight for Freedom" organisation.

As these people appear to be reliable I am sending you their names and addresses in case you should be able to use them.

With reference to AMG/409/28 of 29th November 43, I have now received a reply from No. 2 District that the daily rate to be paid in the category you mention ranges from 90 lire to a maximum of 110 lire a day. No civilian is employed initially at the higher rate and application has to be made to the DADL (Civil) for leave to upgrade after a period of two months.

I suggest therefore that Burdi should be employed at 90 lire a day and should be promised 100 lire a day at the end of the first month and 110 lire a day at the end of the second month, provided that his work is found to be satisfactory.




