examined their records without
success. Soon after I reached Reggio

on 2 Day (31/143) I passed on
several alleged internees to Field
Security Section at Reggio and
I rather think a WEINSTEIN
was amongst them (my office
Daily was flooded with callers
in early stages)

If Weinstein (Kaiser) ~~were~~
went through Reggio, they would
be evacuated to a camp at
Catania, hence to N/Africa.

May I suggest you try
SCAO of Catania if it is
important that you trace them.
